**I-5 North** Exit 270, head right on the ramp for Birch Bay Lynden Rd toward Birch Bay / Lynden, Turn left onto Birch Bay Lynden Rd toward Birch Bay / Custer. Turn left onto Harborview Rd, turn left onto Birch Bay Dr, Arrive at Birch Bay Dr. The last intersection before your destination is Harborview Rd, (If you reach Club House Dr, you've gone too far) **I-5 South** Exit 270, head right on ramp for Birch Bay Lynden Road toward Birch Bay/Lynden, turn right onto Birch Bay Dr. The last

intersection before your destination is Harbor View Rd.

**Park across the street from Mariner's Cove (8026 Birch Bay Drive). (Porta-Potty .7k from walk start)**  
**5K/11K Walk**

- 1) Walk down the sidewalk on Birch Bay Drive keeping water to your right. **CONTINUE** pass the Bay Breeze Restaurant.
- 2) At stop sign, **STRAIGHT** onto Morrison Ave which **ANGLES RIGHT** into Wooldridge Ave.
- 3) **RIGHT** onto Jackson Rd.
- 4) **LEFT** onto Birch Bay Drive.

**5k turnaround is: 7403 Birch Bay Drive, (Cottrill Blvd on left) 5k walkers will continue to follow Birch Bay Drive and then go to #16.**

- 5) Enter Birch Bay State Park (there are restrooms further down in the park).
- 6) **LEFT** on Helwig Road (unmarked, first driveway into park).
- 7) **CROSS** bridge and continue through gate.
- 8) At the trail sign, **RIGHT** and walk on Terrel Marsh Trail Head, keeping **RIGHT**, at first fork following out and at next major fork, keep to **RIGHT**. You will come to a viewing area (Terrel Creek Eco System sign. Enjoy the beauty.
- 9) **TURN AROUND** and **RETRACE** your steps to last fork, veer **RIGHT** and follow trail around until you come to next major fork, **RIGHT** towards Helwig Road.(not marked)
- 10) Return on Helwig Rd to Campground Information sign.
- 11) **RIGHT** on road going to campground, continue on road with cabin on your right.
- 12) **LEFT** on asphalt trail to bridge and beach.
- 13) **CROSS** bridge to playground area beyond restroom (*restrooms open all year*).
- 14) **CROSS** and **RIGHT** on Birch Bay Drive facing traffic.
- 15) **CONTINUE** on Birch Bay Drive out of park entrance gate passing all houses.
- 16) **CROSS** bridge to stop sign (5K walkers will continue here).
- 17) **LEFT** continuing down Birch Bay Drive and back at your car.
