

**Fort Harrison State Park
Indianapolis. Indiana

The trails are mostly on natural paths and some park road surfaces. It wanders through rolling wooded terrain and past a picturesque reservoir.

The start point is located at the Delaware Lake parking lot off Clark Road, Indianapolis, IN, GPS Coordinates 39.872667, -86.018844. and is open during the normal park visiting hours (7 a.m. to 8 p.m.)

From I -465 on east side of Indianapolis take exit 40 (56th Street). Follow 56th Street east to Post Road for approximately 2 1/4 miles. Turn left at 59th Street. Enter the park and stop to pay the daily fee or show your annual pass at the gatehouse. Continue to the first road (Clark Road) and turn right to the Delaware Lake parking lot and park on the north side. Rest rooms are available at that location.

AWARD AND FEES:

Park Fee: All participants must pay the current admission fee at the park gate on most days of the year. An annual pass to all DNR properties is available for both in and out-of-state visitors

Award: A special 2 1/4 inch die cast medal header with a state park bar for Ft Harrison State Park attached is shown above. These awards are available at the traditional start box. Additional bars for other state parks, recreation areas and lakes may be added to form a chain. The award fees are:

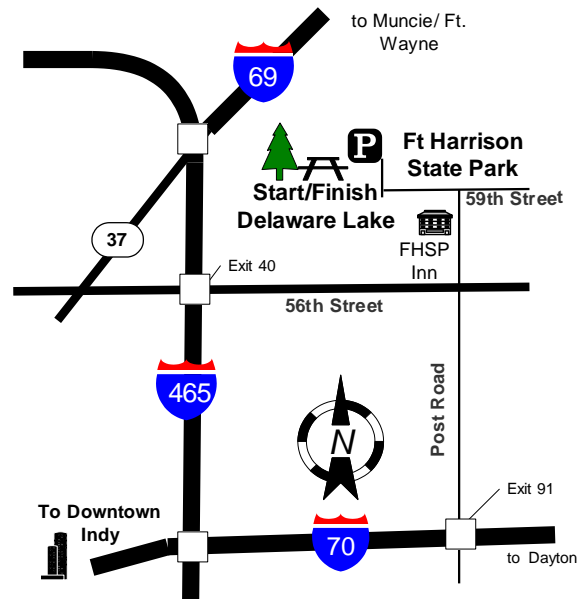
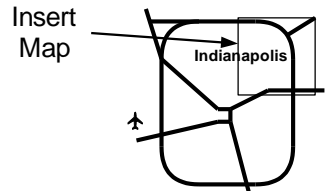
Medal with bar	\$10.00

Note: There is a traditional start box nearby at the Fort Harrison State Park Inn, 5830 North Post Road, Indianapolis, IN 46216. Since you have initiated your registration in OSB for this event, please stay with the OSB process. **Do not register at the Inn unless you want to purchase an award. Complete the event by logging back into OSB (see walk instructions)**

To purchase an award, visit the traditional start point at the Inn and pay separately (see trail map for location). Register in the logbook and indicate **“OSB Registration”** in the signature column. Pay the amounts listed on the opposite page which do not include your IVV fee which you already paid for in the OSB process. Use the envelopes in the start box to make your payment (check preferred) and take the appropriate award.





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Walk Instructions
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Welcome to Fort Harrison State Park, site of our beautiful year-round event. There are rest rooms available at the start point and stations along the trail

5 and 10 K trails

1. Exit parking lot on foot going towards the lake to the Fall Creek Trail sign. Follow the Fall Creek Trail (gravel and dirt trail) to the overlook and then continue to the Harrison Trace (paved trail).
2. Turn left on Harrison Trace and follow this paved trail past the Duck Pond and back to Delaware Lake
3. At the trail split, just after passing the lake, **5 K** walkers turn right going on the paved trail returning to the parking area and finish. **10 K** walkers stay to the left and continue on Harrison Trace crossing the main park road to the west boundary of the Park
4. At the end of the Harrison Trace, turn around and walk back to the paved path on the right leading to the Walnut Trailhead parking lot. Cross the road to the parking lot and the Lawrence Creek trail.
5. Follow the Lawrence Creek Trail going to your left, around the trail loop, to the Lawrence Creek Trailhead parking lot. ***Be careful of dirt bike traveling in the opposite direction on this trail.***
6. Exit the parking lot, turning left on the paved road. At the "T" turn right on the road and stay left at the next crossing returning to the Delaware Lake parking lot on your left.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT

Be sure to log back into the OSB system to "finish/complete" your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)
