

SPRINGFIELD SEQUIOTA PARK WALK

5/10 KM

This walk starts at SEQUIOTA PARK, 3500 So. Lone Pine Avenue . Exit at Battlefield Road from US Hwy 65. West to South Lone Pine Avenue. **LEFT** (south) on South Lone Pine Avenue for 8/10 mile. Park entrance on your **LEFT**.

1. From the parking lot and facing the park, turn **RIGHT** (south) onto the *Galloway Creek Greenway Trail* near the signboard telling about *Sequoiota*. Restrooms on your **RIGHT**.
2. At Barton Street (no sign) cross Lone Pine and then turn **LEFT** continuing south following the trail along Lone Pine to Republic Road. You will pass the Galloway Village Shops on your left.
3. Cross Republic Road and follow the trail behind the Galloway Station, At *Lakeland Pet Cemetery*, when the trail curves, go through to boulders to the upright monument on your left.
4. **5 KM walkers**, Turn around and follow the trail back to the park.
5. **10 KM walkers** continue to follow the trail going under US Highway 60.
6. At 4.0 marker near the first junction, leave the blacktop path and turn **RIGHT** onto gravel/dirt path.
7. Cross the railroad tracks and enter the *Springfield Nature Center Park*. **NO PETS IN PARK**
8. At the **Y**, there is a sign for the *Greenways Trail*. Turn **LEFT** on the *Nature Center Park Trail* and cross the wooden bridge over Lake Springfield. Look for fish, turtles, waterfowl and deer in the woods.
9. At the end of the bridge, turn **RIGHT** on *Sycamore Cut-off Trail*.
10. At the Boardwalk, turn **RIGHT** and follow it to the paved path.
11. Follow the paved path, staying to the **RIGHT** and follow signs uphill to the *Nature Center Visitors Center*. Go up the steps for restrooms and water available in the Center. A Restroom is also at the amphitheater next to the Center.
12. At the top of the hill by the amphitheater, follow signs to the *Savanna Ridge Trail* on your **RIGHT**. At the first sign, stay to the **RIGHT** until you come to a path that goes to the **RIGHT** and downhill. Take this path.
13. You are now on the *Long Trail*. Follow it through a wooded area on gravel path onto a boardwalk, across two wooden bridges and out into a meadow.
14. Halfway through the meadow, you come to a trail junction. Turn **LEFT** onto the path on which you entered the park. Sign says return to **SEQUIOTA PARK**.
15. Cross railroad track and exit the park on the gravel path and return to the blacktop trail. Turn **LEFT** onto blacktop *Greenways Trail*.
16. You will pass under US Highway 60 and go through the *Pet Cemetery*. Continue on trail returning to **SEQUIOTA PARK** and your vehicle.
