This walk is composed of a 5k and 10k routes. The routes are rated 1A and are along city streets. Visit historic Grapevine churches and parks, the Nash Farm, museums, statues and winery tasting rooms and so much more. Grapevine is also known as the Christmas Capital of Texas with the town going all out for the holiday season.

OSB or PSB Walk Registration:

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match. For example, do not register using the OSB, then complete your event using the PSB (nor sign the PSB log sheet). The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

When you finish your walk(s), be sure to log back in to the OSB System and enter your participation date, distances, and Special Programs (if applicable).

Start Point Address and Driving Directions:

The walk starts at Jakes Burgers & Beer 520 S Main St., Grapevine. From TX-121 (just north of DFW Airport), turn north on Main St. toward the Historic District. Continue 2 blocks north of the Visitor Center to the parking lot on the right just beyond College St. Jakes is across the street from the parking lot.

Restrooms: Restrooms available at the Visitor Center and some businesses along the route.

Parking: Parking is available on the street and in parking lots along Main St. and on the streets parallel to Main. Parking is free.

DALLAS TREKKERS YEAR ROUND WALK IN GRAPEVINE

Jakes Burgers & Beer 520 S Main St., Grapevine. From TX-121, turn north on Main St. toward the Historic District. Continue 2 blocks north of the Visitor Center to the parking lot on the right just beyond College St. Jakes is across the street.

5 km and 10 km INSTRUCTIONS

1. **From Jake's, RIGHT** on Main St to the arch between Bingham's Tasting Room and the Visitor Center.
2. **RIGHT** thru the arch to the Settlement to City Museum, exploring the buildings. Circle back to the rear entrance to the Visitor Center (red brick building).
3. Enter the Visitor Center (if open) for restrooms, information and changing displays, then exit the Visitor Center thru the front door (If the center is closed, take the sidewalk back to Main St.
4. Carefully cross Main and Hudgins streets (**animated gunfight above Visitor Center tower at 10, 2, 4, 6, and 8**).
5. **LEFT** on Hudgins to the restored log cabin, then **RIGHT** at the cabin to the Train Depot area.
6. **RIGHT** thru the train depot and shops. Continue pass shops returning to Main St.
7. **LEFT** on Main St crossing the railroad tracks to the Peace Circle display featuring Sam Houston and his meeting with representatives of 10 tribes native to Texas. Continue to Dallas St.
8. **RIGHT** on Dallas St to the Grapevine Vintage Railroad Museum. Right thru the museum area passing the round table and locomotive. (**Model train display in RR car \$2 admission**). Return to Dallas.
9. **RIGHT** on Dallas to Bell St, then **RIGHT** on Bell to Hudgins/Homestead.
10. **LEFT** on Hudgins/Homestead to the entrance to the Nash Family Farm. **RIGHT** into the farm (explore the house if open), then circle the farm clockwise to check out the displays returning to the front of the house.
11. Exit the farm, then **RIGHT** on Homestead as it curves to the right to College St, then **RIGHT** on College 1 block to Bell St.
12. Carefully cross Bell, then **LEFT** on Bell to the parking lot for the Heritage Park and Arboretum.
13. **RIGHT** thru the parking lot to entrance, then **RIGHT** along the sidewalks and circle around the arboretum and continue to the fountain.
14. **RIGHT** after the fountain to the parking lot exiting the park. Continue on Bell St to Wall St.
15. **CROSS and RIGHT** on Wall 1 block to Scribner, then **LEFT** on Scribner 1 block to Northwest Hwy.
16. **RIGHT** on Northwest Hwy 1 long block to Main St. (**Note 'A Wilderness Welcome' sculpture in the median.**)
17. **RIGHT** on Main 1 short block to Wall St, then **CROSS** Wall St to the left side of the street.
18. **10k ONLY: SKIP to STEP 21.**
19. **5k ONLY: RIGHT** on Main St 3 blocks, passing Liberty Park and shops to Franklin.
20. **RIGHT** on Franklin (crossing Main St) to the hoosegaw, an early jail, then **LEFT** on Main returning to the start. **END of 5k.**
21. **10k ONLY: LEFT** on Wall St about ½ mile to the back of Chicken Express.
22. **LEFT** thru the parking lot to Northwest Hwy, then **RIGHT** on Northwest Hwy to Texan Trail and the 9/11 memorial.
23. **RIGHT** on Texan Trail 1 block to Wall St, then **RIGHT** on Wall to Eckley St (on left only).
24. **LEFT** on Eckley 1 block to Texas St.
25. **RIGHT** on Texas 1 block to Ruth, then jog **LEFT and RIGHT** to continue on Texas. Continue 1 block to Wood St.
26. **RIGHT** on Wood 1 block to Estill.
27. **LEFT** on Estill 1 block to Austin, then **LEFT** on Austin 3 blocks to Franklin.
28. **RIGHT** on Franklin 1 block to Dooley, then **RIGHT** on Dooley 2 blocks to Texas.
29. **LEFT** on Texas 1 block to Smith, then **LEFT** on Smith 2 blocks to Franklin.
30. **LEFT** on Franklin 1 block to Dooley, then **RIGHT** on Dooley 1 block to College.
31. **RIGHT** on College 1 block to Smith, then **RIGHT** on Smith 1 block to Franklin.
32. **LEFT** on Franklin to Jenkins (just before Main), then **RIGHT** on Jenkins 2 ½ blocks to Liberty Park.
33. **LEFT** thru the park to Main, then **LEFT** on Main 1 ½ blocks to Worth.
34. **RIGHT** on Worth 1 block to Church St, then **LEFT** on Church 1 block to Franklin.
35. **LEFT** on Franklin to Main St passing the hoosegaw, an early jail.
36. **RIGHT** on Main and return to the start. **END of 10k.**

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.
