

Glenville Indian Hills Walks

A 6K and a 10K walk are available. Both walks are **rated 1A**

Parking is available at the church throughout the year. Rest rooms, water, and snacks are available at the nearby Stewart's Shop 411 Ballston Rd (Route 50) Scotia, one mile from the Start Point.

DIRECTIONS TO START POINT: Glenville is located approximately 18 miles northwest of Albany NY off of the NYS Thruway, I-90.

From Albany and Points South: NYS Thruway take Exit 25, I-890 West take Exit 4C, left at the traffic light, over the bridge to 2nd traffic light, right on Route 50 approximately 1.5 miles. Bear left on Swaggertown Rd. and the Trinity Presbyterian Church will be on your left approximately 1 mile.

From the North: I-87 (Northway) take Exit 9 toward Clifton Park onto Route 146 West. Follow this road 11 miles to the end (Swaggertown Rd.) through 2 roundabouts crossing Balltown Rd. and Route 50. Left on Swaggertown Rd. for approximately 1.5 miles. Trinity Presbyterian Church will be on your right.

From the West: NYS Thruway take Exit 26 to I-890 East, take Exit 4B, off the ramp bear to the left and follow sign to Scotia (Route 5). Continue into the village to the traffic light, left on Route 50 for approximately 1.5 miles. Bear left on Swaggertown Rd. and the Trinity Presbyterian Church will be on your left approximately 1 mile.

Course Description: The walk goes through quiet neighborhood streets suitable for strollers and for walking dogs on a leash.

The following maps & directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

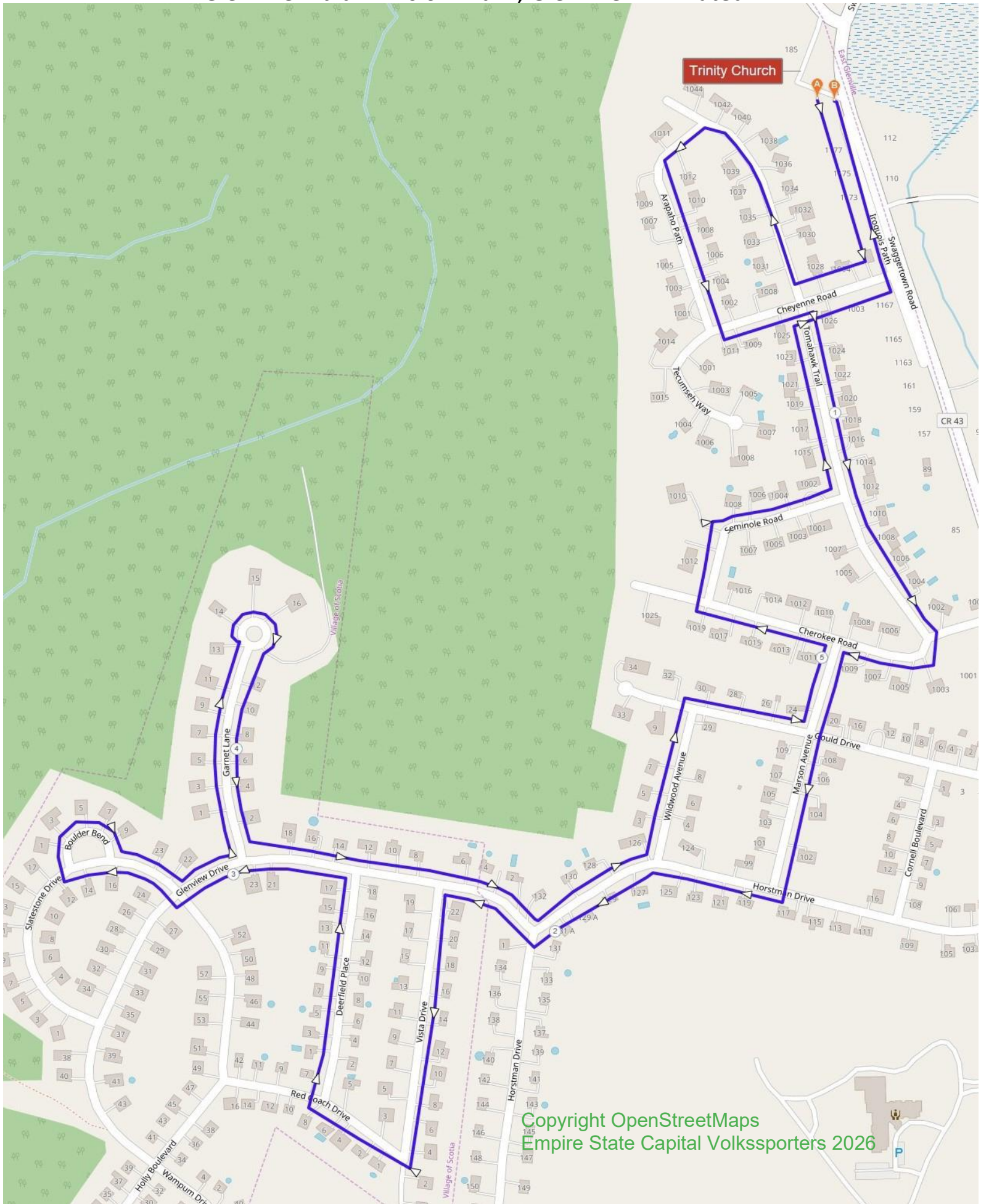
(Special Program: Step to the Beat)

1. **RIGHT** at the Swaggertown Road driveway entrance of the Trinity Presbyterian Church onto Iroquois Path. (right of the split rail fence)
2. **RIGHT** on Cheyenne Road to Tomahawk Trail.
3. **RIGHT** on Tomahawk Trail as it continues bearing left and becomes Arapaho Path.
4. **LEFT** on Cheyenne Road to Tomahawk Trail.
5. **RIGHT** on Tomahawk Trail to Cherokee Road.
6. **RIGHT** on Cherokee Road to Marson Avenue.
7. **LEFT** on Marson Ave crossing Gould Drive to Horstman Drive.
8. **RIGHT** on Horstman Drive.
9. **CAREFULLY CROSS** Horstman Drive and turn **RIGHT** on Glenview Drive.
10. **LEFT** on Vista Drive to Red Coach Drive.
11. **RIGHT** on Red Coach Drive to Deerfield Place.
12. **RIGHT** on Deerfield Place to Glenview Drive.
13. **LEFT** on Glenview Drive to Slatestone Drive.
14. **RIGHT** on Slatestone Drive to Bolder Bend.
15. **RIGHT** on Bolder Bend around the loop.
16. **LEFT** on Slatestone Drive to Glenview Drive.
17. **LEFT** on Glenview Drive to Garnet Lane.
18. **LEFT** on Garnet Lane to end and back.
19. **LEFT** on Glenview Drive to Horstman Drive.
20. **LEFT** on Horstman Drive to Wildwood Avenue.
21. **LEFT** on Wildwood Avenue to Gould Drive.
22. **RIGHT** on Gould Drive to Marson Avenue. Look for the gnome on the porch steps of 28 Gould Dr. (Walking with the Wild Things)
23. **LEFT** on Marson Avenue to Cherokee Road.
24. **LEFT** on Cherokee Road to Seminole Road.
25. **RIGHT** on Seminole Rd as it curves right to Tomahawk Trail.
26. **LEFT** on Tomahawk Trail to Cheyenne Road.
27. **RIGHT** on Cheyenne Road to Iroquois Path.
28. **LEFT** on Iroquois Path returning to the church.

1. **RIGHT** at the Swaggertown Road driveway entrance of the Trinity Presbyterian Church onto Iroquois Path. (right of the split rail fence)
2. **RIGHT** on Cheyenne Road to Tomahawk Trail.
3. **LEFT** on Tomahawk Trail to Cherokee Road.
4. **RIGHT** on Cherokee Road to Marson Avenue.
5. **LEFT** on Marson Avenue to Gould Drive.
6. **LEFT** on Gould Drive to Cornell Boulevard.
7. **RIGHT** on Cornell Boulevard to Horstman Dr.
8. **RIGHT** on Horstman Drive to Glenview Drive.
9. **CAREFULLY CROSS** Horstman Drive and turn **RIGHT** on Glenview Drive to Vista Drive.
10. **LEFT** on Vista Drive to Red Coach Drive.
11. **RIGHT** on Red Coach Drive to Deerfield Place.
12. **RIGHT** on Deerfield Place to Glenview Drive.
13. **LEFT** on Glenview Drive to Holly Boulevard.
14. **LEFT** on Holly Boulevard to Wampum Drive.
15. **LEFT** on Wampum Drive to Cartwheel Drive.
16. **RIGHT** on Cartwheel Drive to Bancker Avenue.
17. **LEFT** on Bancker Avenue which winds around to the right.
18. **RIGHT** on Uncas Drive to Parkland Avenue.
19. **LEFT** on Parkland Avenue to Market Street.
20. **RIGHT** on Market Street to Oakland Avenue.
21. **RIGHT** on Oakland Avenue to Bancker Avenue.
22. **LEFT** on Bancker Avenue to Red Oak Drive.
23. **LEFT** on Red Oak Drive to Oakhurst Drive.
24. **RIGHT** on Oakhurst Drive to Holly South/Holly Boulevard.
25. **RIGHT** on Holly South/Holly Boulevard to Glenview Drive.
26. **LEFT** on Glenview Drive to Slatestone Drive.
27. **LEFT** on Slatestone Drive to Bolder Bend.
28. **LEFT** on Bolder Bend around the loop to Slatestone Drive.
29. **LEFT** on Slatestone to Glenview Drive.
30. **LEFT** on Glenview Drive to Garnet Lane.
31. **LEFT** on Garnet Lane to end and back.
32. **LEFT** on Glenview Drive to Horstman Drive.
33. **LEFT** on Horstman Drive to Wildwood Avenue.
34. **LEFT** on Wildwood Avenue to Gould Drive.
35. **RIGHT** on Gould Drive to Marson Avenue. Look for the gnome on the porch steps of 28 Gould Dr. (Walking with the Wild Things)
36. **LEFT** on Marson Avenue to Cherokee Road.
37. **LEFT** on Cherokee Road to Seminole Road.
38. **RIGHT** on Seminole Road as it loops around to Tomahawk Road.
39. **LEFT** on Tomahawk Road to Cheyenne Drive.
40. **LEFT** on Cheyenne Drive bearing **LEFT** as it becomes Tecumseh Way around the cul-de-sac.
41. **BEAR LEFT** as you exit the cul-de-sac.
42. **LEFT** on Arapaho Path as it continues to loop around **RIGHT** becoming Tomahawk Trail.
43. **CONTINUE** on Tomahawk Trail to Cheyenne Road.
44. **LEFT** on Cheyenne Road to Iroquois Path.
45. **LEFT** on Iroquois to return to the church.
