

Instructions for
Scappoose City Parks & Crown Zellerbach Trail, Y-2732
Scappoose, OR
5/10 Km, rated 1A
6 Km Trail, rated 1B

Scappoose City Parks Start Location: Chief Concomly Park, 33306 SW Seely Lane, Scappoose, OR, which is west of Portland, OR on Hwy 30 along the Columbia River.

GPS Coords: 45.75849, -122.88122 (Chief Concomly Park)
45.82504, -122.96662 (Ruley Trailhead)

Driving Directions For 5/10Km City Parks Walks: Hwy 30W: Turn Left onto SW JP Rd West (at the corner is a Chevron Gas Station). Right on Seeley Lane (sign for Chief Concomly Park). Left into Chief Concomly City Park. **Hwy 30E:** Turn Right onto SW JP Rd West (at corner is a Chevron Gas Station). Continue as above.

Park: Chief Concomly Park lot or nearby streets and Ruley Trailhead lot.

Restrooms available year round at Chief Concomly Park and trailhead.

When you walk past the skatepark on the City walk you'll notice a fountain to your left. It is the Columbia County Rotary Children's Fountain. I have a link here to see a video and read about the fountain. <https://beyondtheburbs.com/new-to-scappoose-columbia-county-rotary-childrens-fountain/>

Driving Directions To Ruley Trailhead: From Hwy 30W turn left from west bound or right from east bound onto **Scappoose Vernonia Hwy** and drive 6.6 miles to trailhead on the left.

Crown Zellerbach Trail Walk:

Ruley Trailhead has a bathroom, parking and a shelter area.

For an all day adventure filled with walking I also have a walk in St Helens (5km or 10 km). There is also a 5km or 10km walk in Rainier. The distance along this stretch of Hwy 30 from Portland to Rainier is about 44 miles in one direction. You could, for example do the 5km walk in Scappoose, relax and drive to St Helens and do a 5km or 10km walk and perhaps have lunch at one of the fine restaurants or pubs in the old downtown area. When the Roof Restaurant is open I highly recommend it. It is a restaurant on the fourth floor of an old building. Yes they have an elevator! The food is

sandwiches and good beer and other offerings but it is the view that makes it worthwhile.

Then drive to Rainier, OR to do another 5km or 10km walk. Maybe check out the Cornerstone Café.

Trojan Park (owned by PGE), which used to be a nuclear facility is a great park to walk around and view birds. Between St Helens and Rainier, OR.

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

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These directions may be used only upon registration at a currently sanctioned IVV/AVA event. For emergencies contact 911. Walk owner is Pat Jewett and she can be reached at 503-453-6018.

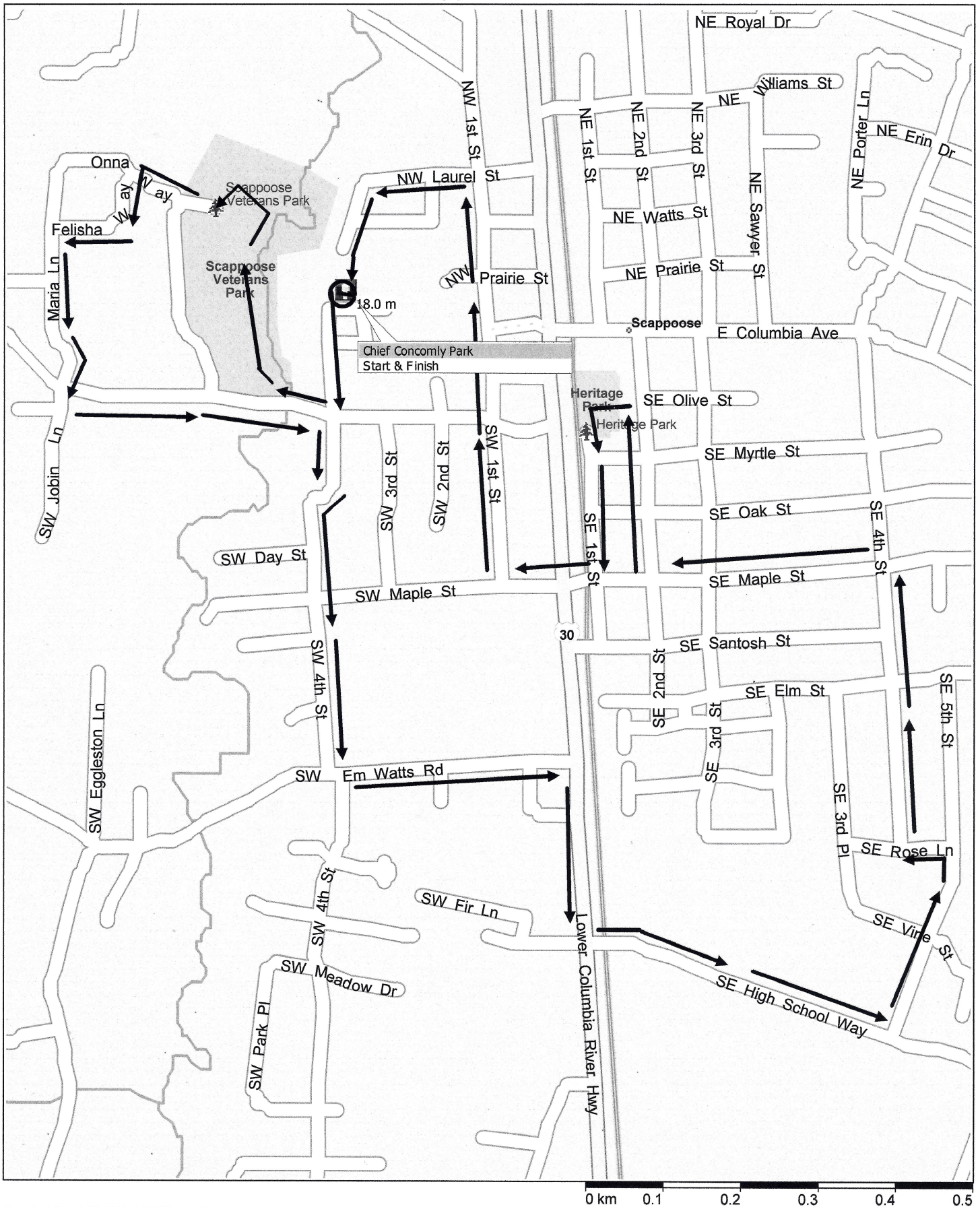


1. Facing away from the Restroom, **LEFT** on path follow loop past shelter to SW 4th St.
2. Remain on SW 4th St.
3. **RIGHT** on SW JP West Rd.
4. **RIGHT** on path after bridge.
5. **CONTINUE** on main path past the first baseball field.
6. At the second baseball field at the Y take the path to the **RIGHT** that loops around the playground area.
7. Walk around the loop to parking lot by the 2nd baseball field.
8. **RIGHT** at the baseball field on the path by the parking lot going straight onto NW Onna Way.
9. **LEFT** on NW Felisha Way (uphill).
10. **LEFT** on NW Maria Lane.
11. **LEFT** on SW JP West Rd.
12. **RIGHT** on SW 4th St.
13. **LEFT** on SW EM Watts Rd.
14. **RIGHT** on Columbia River Hwy (HWY 30).
15. **LEFT** at Walnut St crossing Columbia River Highway at light and **CONTINUE** straight on SE High School Way going inside the chain link fence till the concrete sidewalk ends.
16. **RIGHT** crossing SE High School Way and then **LEFT**.
17. **LEFT** on SE 5th St.
18. **LEFT** on Rose Ln very short distance.
19. **RIGHT** on SE 4th St.
20. **LEFT** on SE Maple St.
21. **RIGHT** on SE 2nd St.
22. **LEFT** on E Columbia Ave.
23. **LEFT** on sidewalk path that goes past the skatepark.
24. Path continues to SE First St. (Continue on SE First St.)
25. **Right** on SE Maple St.
26. **CROSS** HWY 30 at signal light.
27. **RIGHT** on SW 1st St.
28. **LEFT** on NW Laurel St.
29. **LEFT** on NW 4th St into Chief Concomly Park.
30. Follow the sidewalk back to the restrooms.

1. From the Restroom, **LEFT** on path follow loop to SW 4th St.
2. Remain on SW 4th St.
3. **RIGHT** on SW JP West Rd.
4. **RIGHT** on path.
5. **CONTINUE** on main path past the first baseball field.
6. At the second baseball field at the Y take the path to the **RIGHT** that loops around the playground area.
7. Walk around the loop to parking lot by the 2nd baseball field.
8. Exit parking lot straight onto NW Onna Way.
9. **LEFT** on Felisha Way (uphill).
10. **LEFT** on NW Maria Lane.
11. **LEFT** on SW JP West Rd.
12. **RIGHT** on SW 4th St.
13. **LEFT** on SW Sequoia.
14. **RIGHT** on SW Old Portland.
15. **RIGHT** on SW Havlik Rd.
16. **RIGHT** on SW 5th St.
17. **RIGHT** on SW Jenny Lane.
18. **LEFT** on SW 3rd St.
19. **LEFT** on path (part of church property.)
20. Follow path to the covered shelter area.
21. Walk across the basketball court and turn **RIGHT** onto gravel path to the church parking lot.
22. Walk down the church driveway to SW Old Portland Rd.
23. **LEFT** on Old Portland Rd walking past the Memorial & Totem Pole.
24. **LEFT** on Hwy 30 to Walnut St.
25. **CROSS** Hwy 30 at the signal light onto SE High School Way.
26. **LEFT** on SE 6th St.
27. **LEFT** on SE Elm.
28. **RIGHT** on SE 4th St.
29. **LEFT** on SE Maple.
30. **RIGHT** on SE 2nd St.
31. **LEFT** on E Columbia Ave.
32. **LEFT** on sidewalk path that goes past the skatepark.
33. Path continues to SE First St. (Continue on SE First St.)
34. **RIGHT** on SE Maple St.
35. **CROSS** Hwy 30 at signal light.
36. **RIGHT** on SW 1st St.
37. **LEFT** on NW Laurel St.
38. **LEFT** on 4th St into Chief Concomly Park.
39. Follow the sidewalk back to the park. Finished.

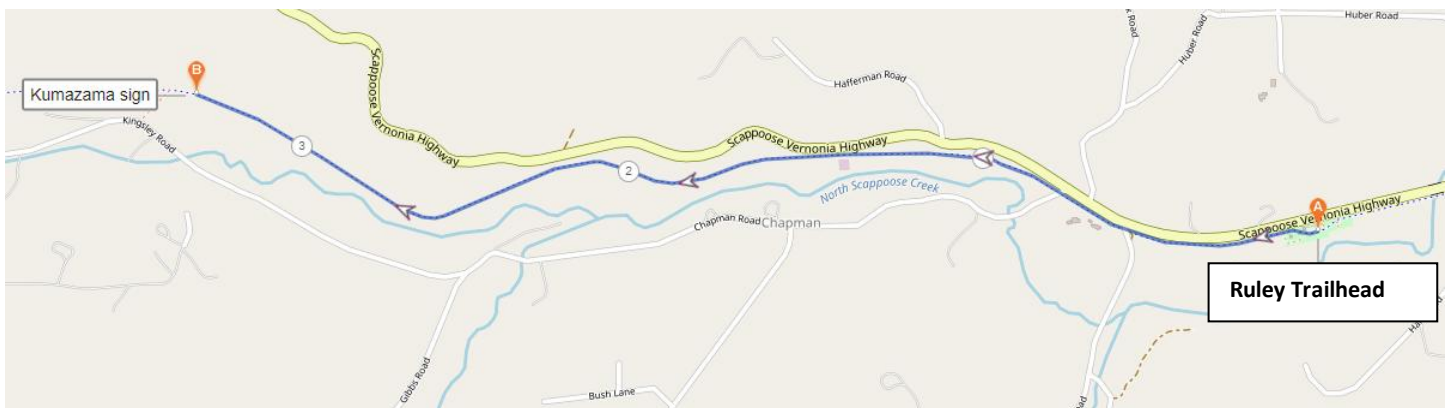
Directions to the Ruley Trailhead: From Hwy 30 West travel to Scappoose, OR. Turn left on the Scappoose Vernonia Hwy. Drive 6.6 miles and turn left into the parking lot of the Ruley Trailhead. (Bathroom and parking available) From Hwy 30 East turn right onto Scappoose Vernonia Hwy. Same as above to the trailhead.

Walk Directions:

1. There are some signs with historical information about the history of the Crown Zellerbach Trail at the trail head.
2. Facing the parking lot and the fields turn right onto the trail. You'll walk by the bathroom and shelter.
3. 1km at the bend in North Scappoose Creek.
4. The turn around point on the walk is at the Kumazama historical trail sign.
5. Turn around and walk back the way you came to the Ruley Trailhead.

The Crown Zellerbach Trail is a Rails to Trails trail. The trail begins at the Columbia River (Chapman's Landing) to Vernonia and is 22 miles long. This trail has historical signs along the trail. It has mileage markers and is well maintained. It is open to bike riders and horses. I would encourage you to come back and enjoy other portions of the trail. I hope you enjoyed this section of the trail.

This trail also connects to the Banks Vernonia Trail in Vernonia.
