Burlington, IA is south of Davenport, IA along the Mississippi River at the intersection of Hwy 163/34 and Hwy 61. From US-34 travel East to High Street. Take exit 262B. Continue East High Street to N 4th Street. Right onto N 4th Street to Columbia Street. Turn left onto Columbia Street and continue to N Front Street. Large parking area and the Welcome Center will be in front of you.

RESTROOMS: Available at Welcome Center when open. Currently Thursday – Monday 10 AM – 4 PM

PARKING: Large parking area along the river front at the Welcome Center.

With your back to the Welcome Center/River

1. Left one block to Jefferson Street.
2. Right onto Jefferson
3. Carefully cross railroad tracks and Front Street
4. Right onto Main Street
5. Left onto Columbia; Restrooms available at Circle K; uphill four blocks.
6. Left onto N 6th Street walking down Snake Alley. Continue straight across Washington.
7. Left onto Jefferson for 5 blocks
8. Cross North Street and railroad tracks and continue to the River.
9. Left along the Riverfront, pass boat ramp and under highway and continue to the Bluff Harbor Marina
10. Gazebo is on your right enjoy the view of the Mississippi River.
11. Retrace steps along the Riverfront.
12. Back to the Burlington Welcome Center - Start/Finish

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.
