The Walk

Enjoy the beautiful San Jose Rose Garden and the Rose Garden neighborhood on this pleasant residential walk. The route takes you to Santa Clara University, the site of Mission Santa Clara which is still in use, and back through the lovely gardens of the famous Rosicrucian Museum.

We hope you enjoy this historical walk through Santa Clara.

- Distance is 10K (5K option)
- Difficulty is 1A
- Restrooms available
- No dogs allowed in Rose Garden or Rosicrucian Museum areas.

Walk Options

- #1. 10K - the complete walk
- #2. 5K - with no university
- #3. 5K - university only

Drive to the Start - option #1 & #2

1970 Naglee Ave, San Jose, CA 95126. From I-280 northbound, take the Stevens Creek/West

San Carlos exit 5C. Stay in Right lane to turn Right at the light. Drive to Bascom Ave, and turn Left.. Drive 1 block, then Right onto Naglee at the next light. Zanotto's is on your immediate Right.

From I-880 north or southbound, take the Bascom Ave exit. Continue south on Bascom to Naglee. Left on Naglee. Zanotto's is on your immediate Right.

PLEASE Do NOT park in Zanotto's parking lot, but use Naglee or side streets.

Drive to the Start - option #3

From I-880 north or southbound, take The Alameda Ave exit NORTH. Go a 1/3 of a mile to the second or third light. The Alameda becomes Hwy 82 and will curve right at the traffic light. See the "Santa Clara University" sign on the low wall. Turn LEFT at the light to stay on The Alameda.

There is 4 hour parking on The Alameda, or turn around in the Safeway lot to find 2 hour parking on the other side.

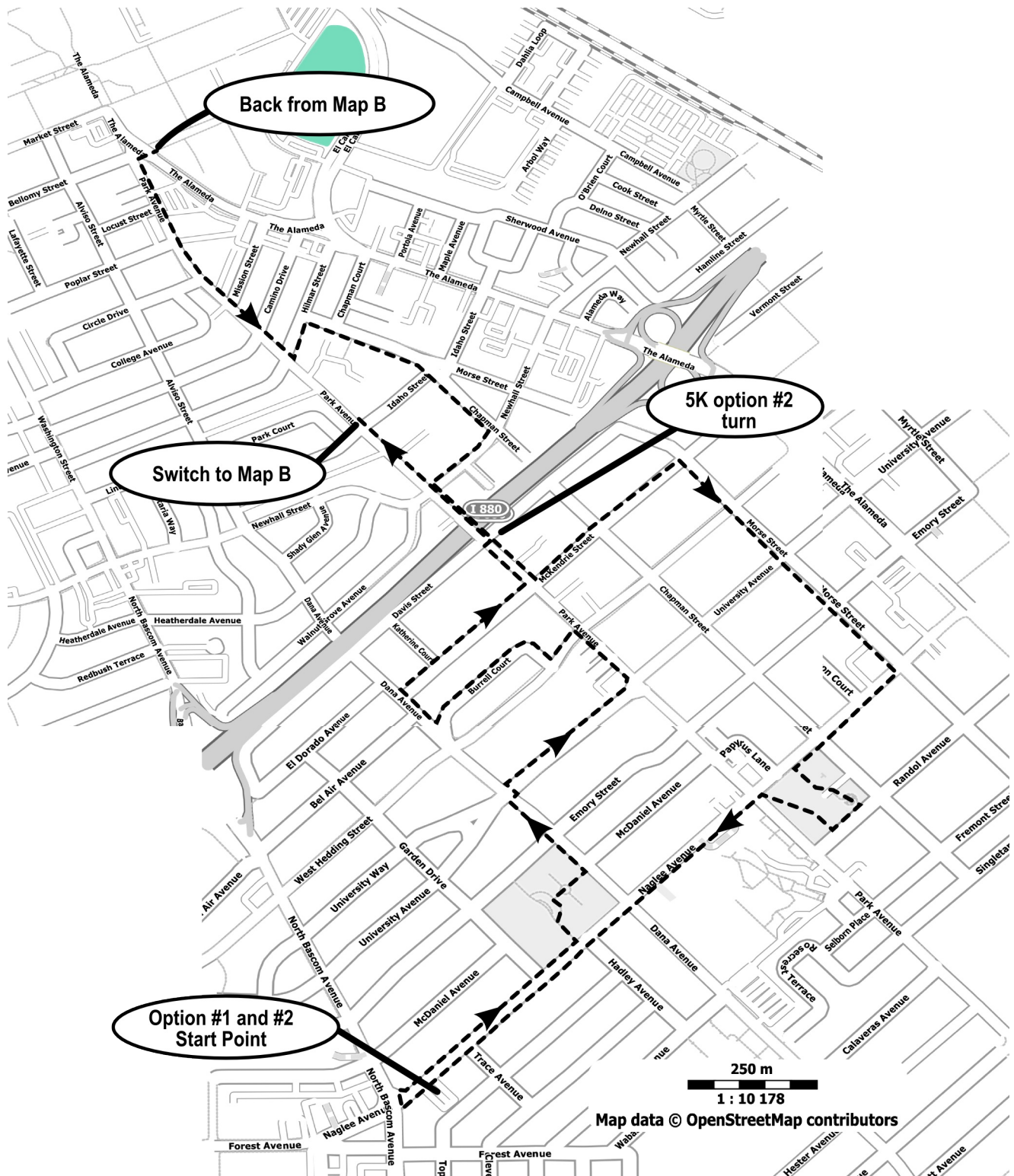
Walk Directions

- 10K OPTION #1 and 5K OPTION #2 - Refer to Map A for the route and start point. The 10K will also use Map B.
 - 5K OPTION #3 (University only) - Skip to step #13. Refer to Map B for the route and start point.
 - NOTE: You may have parked across the street from Zanotto's, in which case step 1 will become your last step as you return from your walk.
1. Facing Zanotto's from the street, go RIGHT on Naglee Ave. and walk to the traffic light on Bascom Ave. Cross Naglee Ave. at the light. Turn RIGHT and walk on Naglee Ave. opposite of Zanotto's.
 2. Cross Garden Dr. and enter the Rose Garden through the gates on your left half way down the block.
 3. Walk past the small grove of giant redwood trees and take the walkway to your RIGHT that leads you to the center of the rose garden and the fountain. Walk around the fountain and enjoy the roses in all directions.
 4. Exit the garden by walking beneath the arbor of wild climbing roses. At the sidewalk turn LEFT; you are on Dana Ave.

5. Stay on Dana Ave. to University Ave; RIGHT to cross Dana Ave. and LEFT to cross University Ave.
6. Turn RIGHT to walk on the left side of University Ave .
7. At Park Ave., turn LEFT and proceed to West Hedding St.
8. Cross W. Hedding St. at the traffic light and turn LEFT, one block to Burrell Ct.
9. RIGHT on Burrell Ct., staying on the right side, back to Dana Ave. (stop sign, street sign is hidden in tree) Turn RIGHT.
10. Go one block to McKendrie St. Cross and turn RIGHT.
11. At Park Ave. turn LEFT, go one block to Davis St. Cross Park Ave. in the crosswalk.
 - 5K - OPTION #2 (No university) - Turn RIGHT and skip to step #47
12. Turn LEFT crossing Davis St. Continue on the right side of Park Ave., crossing freeway, for 2 blocks. This will be Idaho St. Cross it.
 - 10K - OPTION #1 - Skip to step #15
13. (5K university only) From the Start Point at Chapman / The Alameda, walk down Chapman Ct., away from The Alameda. Go to the end of the block and turn LEFT on Morse St. Go to Idaho St. and turn RIGHT.
14. Go one block to Park Ave. Turn RIGHT on Park Ave.
15. (10K continues) Continue on the right side of Park Ave. about 7 blocks to Poplar St. (on left side only) Cross in the wide cross walk. Turn RIGHT, to continue walking on Park Ave., passing Rocko's Ice Cream Tacos (Ice Cream Parlor).
16. Continue another block to stoplight (Bellomy St. - no sign), turn LEFT in front of Pizza My Heart, go one block to Alviso St. Turn RIGHT on Alviso St. one block to Market St.
17. Cross Market St. in the crosswalk and enter the Santa Clara University campus. Bldg #307 is on your left and Bldg #301 is on your right. Go straight along the wide walkway.
18. At Bldg #305, cross street in cross walk, go LEFT. Walk beside a wall with spanish tile on top, look for an entrance with a brick walkway (¾ way down).
19. Turn RIGHT entering the Santa Clara Mission Historical Area.
20. Past the observatory on your right, take the diagonal walkway (angle right) to an intersection at the corner of Bldg #106.
21. Go LEFT and walk with Bldg #106 on your left to the white adobe wall in front of you. Go under the ramada and through the wall, turn LEFT and follow the walkway as it turns right, under another ramada, alongside Bldg #108 on your left.
22. Stay on the walkway towards the Mayer Theatre front doors. Look for a sidewalk to your right near the theatre (not down ramp). Turn RIGHT on this walkway. It will curve and at the end you are facing the cemetery. (It now looks more like a rose garden). While facing the cemetery, go LEFT.
23. Cross the brick paved street and turn LEFT.
24. RIGHT at the next walkway, going through the metal posts and walking with Bldg #207 on your left. Continue roughly straight to the Edward Daly Science Center reflection pool. Angle RIGHT at the pool and continue around side of Bldg #210.
25. Angle left to enter the dirt pathway to a small garden with a bronze statue in the center.
 - CHECKPOINT #1 This is a statue of _____?
26. Continue on, making your way to a large round fountain on the broad pedestrian walkway.
27. Turn LEFT, staying left, following the line of palm trees, past Botto Vari Hall. Cross the next street following the line of palm trees.
28. Read the Historical Plaques along the sidewalk.
 - Ohlone People of the Santa Clara Valley, Anza Trail of the Santa Clara Valley, further on, Life at the 3rd Santa Clara Mission
29. Continue on and angle to the left to the large cross where Father Junipero Serra blessed the third site of the Santa Clara mission in 1784. Note that you are near the historical El Camino Real.
30. Return to the main sidewalk and turn RIGHT, returning to the campus the way you came. Enter the Abby Sobrato Mall, continue straight on the right side walkway, passing the de Saisset Art Gallery and Museum on your right.
31. Just past the museum. Read the historic plaque.

- **CHECKPOINT #2** *How many sites did this mission have?* _____
32. Crossing the tiled roadway, the mission cemetery gates are straight ahead. Turn LEFT and walk along the front of the mission, turning RIGHT at the flower lined walkway. Go through the garden entrance and walk into the wisteria arbor.
 33. Halfway through the arbor, (25-30 paces), take the second walkway to the LEFT and walk to the adobe wall.
 34. Before the wall turn LEFT. At the building, turn RIGHT and then LEFT at the small, blue tile, drinking fountain. Pass Bldg #103 on your right. Go a bit left to cross the street and turn RIGHT.
 35. Walk through the Memorial Entrance and turn LEFT to walk diagonally to your right and towards a large fountain in front of Bldg #301. Using the plaque on the left side of the fountain, answer Checkpoint #3.
- **CHECKPOINT #3** *What is the name of this fountain?* _____
36. Facing the fountain, turn LEFT and walk to the construction site. At the green construction "fence" turn RIGHT.
 37. Pass the Learning Commons and Library on your left and continue towards the bronze horse. Pass this statue with Bldg #504 on your left, taking the sidewalk as it curves onto The Alameda.
 38. At the first traffic light, use the crosswalk to safely cross The Alameda.
 - 10K - OPTION #1 - Skip to instruction #40
 39. Go LEFT, continuing on The Alameda back to your car.
 - 5K - OPTION #3 - End of instructions
 40. (10K continues) Do not turn left onto The Alameda, instead go a few more paces to Park Ave. (Pizza My Heart across street)
 41. Turn LEFT to walk on the left side of Park Ave.
 42. Go about 5 blocks to Hilmar St. Cross Hilmar St. and turn LEFT.
 43. Go one block to Morse St. Turn RIGHT.
 44. Go to the "Y"; stay to the right, now Chapman St. and continue to Newhall St.
 45. Cross Newhall St. and turn RIGHT proceeding back to Park Ave.
 46. LEFT on Park Ave., crossing the freeway, to McKendrie St.
 47. (5K continues) LEFT on McKendrie St. Two blocks to Morse St. Cross and RIGHT on Morse St. staying on the left side.
 - USE CAUTION CROSSING McKENDRIE, HEDDING, UNIVERSITY AND NAGLEE STREETS .
 48. After crossing Naglee Ave. in the crosswalk, turn RIGHT to cross Morse St., continuing one block to the Rosicrucian Museum.
 49. At the corner of Chapman and Naglee, enter the Rosicrucian museum grounds and walk to the statue visible from the corner. Return to Naglee and turn LEFT. Proceed ½ block to the 2nd pathway just before a white building. Turn LEFT to enter the complex and walk to the fountain.
 - PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF THOSE WHO ARE MEDITATING ON THE GROUNDS. You are welcome to pay and enter this world class Egyptian museum. You will traverse the grounds twice to see much of the outside, but feel free to explore further.
 50. Pass the fountain area, up the stairs closest to the building, then veer LEFT with the building on your right. Follow the path to a sidewalk, turn RIGHT and follow it out to a parking lot. Cross the one lane parking lot and enter the black gates, the entrance to the labyrinth garden.
 51. Enter the garden and walk to the labyrinth. Walk the labyrinth if you wish. You will exit the grounds by taking the 2nd LEFT while walking around the left side of the labyrinth and out to Randol Ave. (Notice the bird statues to your right just before you exit). Turn RIGHT.
 52. Walk past the building with 6 brown and white stone pillars. Re-enter the grounds at the next pathway to the RIGHT. Go to the end of this divided pathway staying to the left. (a rose garden to your left)
 53. To the left of the building in front of you is a narrow, winding brick pathway through the trees. Continue, roughly straight, to the Obelisk on the other side of the grounds. Pass the Obelisk and continue to the exit between the sphynxes at the corner of Naglee Ave. and Park Ave.
 54. Cross Park Ave. to walk on the left side of Naglee Ave.
 55. At 1830 Naglee Ave find a Little Free Library. Continue on Naglee Ave. to the Start Point.
