**Quitman - Wood County**  
AVA Sanctioned Year Round Event



This walk is composed of 5km and 10km routes. The walk is rated 1A and is along city sidewalks with some natural trails thru the arboretum. The walk explores Quitman, the county seat of Wood County and home of actress Sissy Spacek.

The walk goes by historic sites, visits the Gov Jim Hogg Park, and the town's athletic complex. Gov Hogg was Texas's first native born governor of the state.

### **Walk Registration:**

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event or the PSB located at the Speakeasy Coffeehouse at 103 N Main St. The coffeehouse is closed on Sundays. Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

### **Walk Completion and Walk Credit:**

Once you have physically completed the walk, login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

### **Driving Directions to Start Point:**

From I-20, take US-69 north toward Mineola, then veer right on TX-37 to Quitman. TX-37 becomes Main St once in Quitman. Free parking is available on the courthouse square. Restrooms available at the Speakeasy and the courthouse during the week and at various business along the route. The walk starts at the Speakeasy Coffeehouse at 103 N Main St across the street from the Wood County Courthouse.

**Quitman – Wood County**

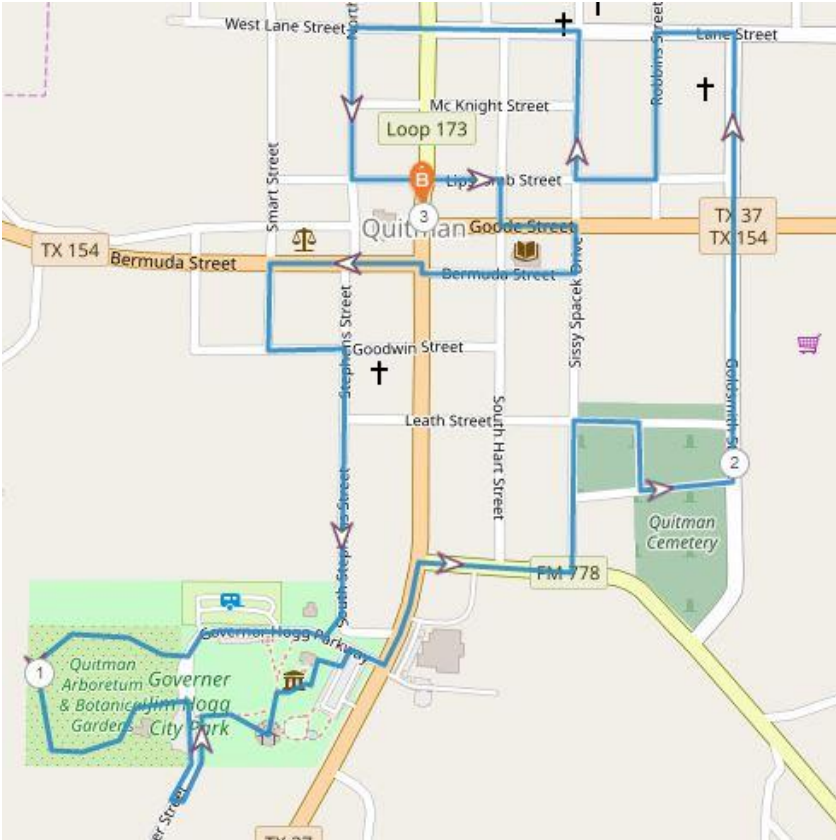
**Start point is the Speakeasy Coffeehouse at 103 N Main St (TX-37) across from the Wood County Courthouse. Free parking available on the courthouse square.**

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

1. **LEAVING** the coffee shop, **RIGHT** to Lipscomb.
2. **RIGHT** on Lipscomb 1 block to Hart, then **RIGHT** on Hart 1 block to Goode.
3. **LEFT** on Goode 1 block to Sissy Spacek (College), then **RIGHT** on Sissy Spaced 1 block to Bermuda.
4. **RIGHT** on Bermuda 4 blocks to Smart St.
5. **LEFT** on Smart 1 block to Goodwin.
6. **LEFT** on Goodwin 1 block to Stephens.
7. **RIGHT** on Stephens 2+ blocks to the Jim Hogg Park. Angle across the grass to the park road.
8. **RIGHT** on park road toward the back of the park. Look for a small bridge and the Arboretum & Botanical Garden.
9. Cross the bridge and follow the nature trail around to the back of a house. Exit the nature trail to the front of the Stinson House.
10. **RIGHT** in front of the Stinson House and continue to the front of the Civic Center.
11. **U-TURN** back to the Stinson House, then angle **RIGHT** to the pavilion and the playground. Circle around the playground, then angle **RIGHT** to museum.
12. **CONTINUE** to the park road, then **RIGHT to exit the park.**
13. **LEFT** on Main St 1 block to FM-778 (Horton St).
14. **RIGHT** on Horton 2 short blocks to Sissy Spacek St, then **LEFT** on Sissy Spacek to the 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance to the Cemetery.
15. **RIGHT** into the cemetery to the first road, then **RIGHT** to the next road, then **LEFT** on road to exit the cemetery.
16. **LEFT** on Goldsmith to Goode St. Carefully cross the highway to continue on Goldsmith 2 blocks to Lane St.
17. **10K ONLY: Go to Step 22.**
18. **5K ONLY: LEFT** on Lane 1 block to Robbins, then **LEFT** on Robbins 1 block to Lipscomb.
19. **RIGHT** on Lipscomb 1 block to College, then **RIGHT** on College 1 block to Lane St.
20. **LEFT** on Lane 3 blocks to Stephens, then **LEFT** on Stephens 2 blocks to Lipscomb.
21. **RIGHT** on Lipscomb 1 block to Main, then **RIGHT** on Main returning to the coffee shop. **END of 5k.**
22. **10K ONLY: RIGHT** on Lane a short way to Puckett St, then **LEFT** on Puckett and follow it around the Bud Moody Stadium and parking lots. Continue to Walker St
23. **LEFT** on Walker 2 short blocks to East Side, then **LEFT** on East Side 1 long block to Cliff St.
24. **RIGHT** on Cliff 2 blocks to TX-7 (Winnsboro). **RIGHT** on Winnsboro a short way to Highland, then **CROSS** TX-37 to Highland.
25. **CONTINUE** on Highland 1 block to Richard St, then **RIGHT** on Richard 1 short block to FM-2088.
26. **LEFT** on FM-2088 1 block (on right) to Beulah St (city park and pool).
27. **RIGHT** on Beulah and continue to the pool. Circle the park around the pool, then return to FM-2088.
28. **LEFT** on FM-2088 to Winnsboro, then **CROSS and LEFT** on Winnsboro a couple of blocks to Morris.
29. **RIGHT** on Morris 2 blocks to Conger, then **LEFT** on Conger 1+ blocks to Lane.
30. **RIGHT** on Lane 6 short blocks to Stephens St, then **LEFT** on Stephens 2 blocks to Lipscomb.

31. **RIGHT** on Lipscomb 1 block to Main, then **RIGHT** on Main returning to the coffee shop. **END of 10K.**
