



# LAND BRIDGE – HARDBERGER PARK – Y2884

## San Antonio Pathfinders

This walk is composed of 10K and 5K routes. Both routes are rated 1B. The walk explores the 330-acre Hardberger Park and will take you to the Land Bridge that opened in December 2020. This bridge sits 25 feet over the parkway and is 150 feet wide to facilitate the crossing of people and animals to the other side of the park. At the top of the bridge there are blinds to sit and rest or to watch for wildlife and to relax.

### Walk Registration:

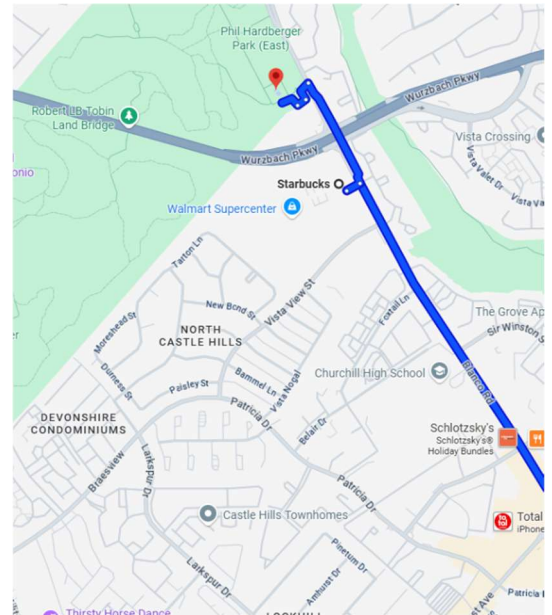
Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event.

### Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish and complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion information indicating the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion information as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.) Also note that an event registration expires after 30 days, but if your registrations lapses, you may re-register without cost.

### Driving Directions to Start Point:

The walk starts at 12711 Blanco Road, San Antonio, TX 78216 in a Starbucks parking lot. From the north side of San Antonio on Loop 410, turn north on Blanco Road about 3 miles to the Walmart Supercenter on the left and the Starbucks in the same parking area.

# HARDBERGER Park 5k - Y2884

## San Antonio Pathfinders

1. **Start From** the parking lot at 12711 Blanco Road.
2. **Walk** to Blanco Road and turn **LEFT**.
3. **CONTINUE** on Blanco Road to intersection with Wurzbach Parkway and cross with the walk signs.
4. After CVS, pass two crosswalks to the side-by-side entrance/exit to the park.
5. **LEFT** into the park keeping the dog park on right. Continue to the paved Water Loop Trail.
6. **CONTINUE** to end of paved path to the intersection with Geology Trail (no sign).
7. **Sharp LEFT** onto the gravel path.
8. **PASS** Skywalk and continue straight to the land bridge.
9. **LEFT** at entrance of Tobin Land Bridge over the bridge towards the NW Military entrance and sign that points to Blanco Road entrance.
10. **RIGHT** on Stone Place passing between the buildings to Pacific.
11. **U-TURN** back over the bridge and pass 2 wildlife blinds.
12. **RIGHT** on Skywalk.
13. **LEFT** at end of skywalk and continue on Water Loop to Site Line A. **LEFT** on Site Line A to the Salado Outdoor Classroom (restrooms available).
14. **RIGHT** at the Salado Outdoor Classroom and **CONTINUE** on trail by parking lot on left and playgrounds on right.
15. **LEFT** at T-intersection and continue through parking lot to Blanco Road.
16. **RIGHT** on Blanco Road (CVS on right).
17. **Carefully CROSS** Wurzbach Parkway and continue to finish.

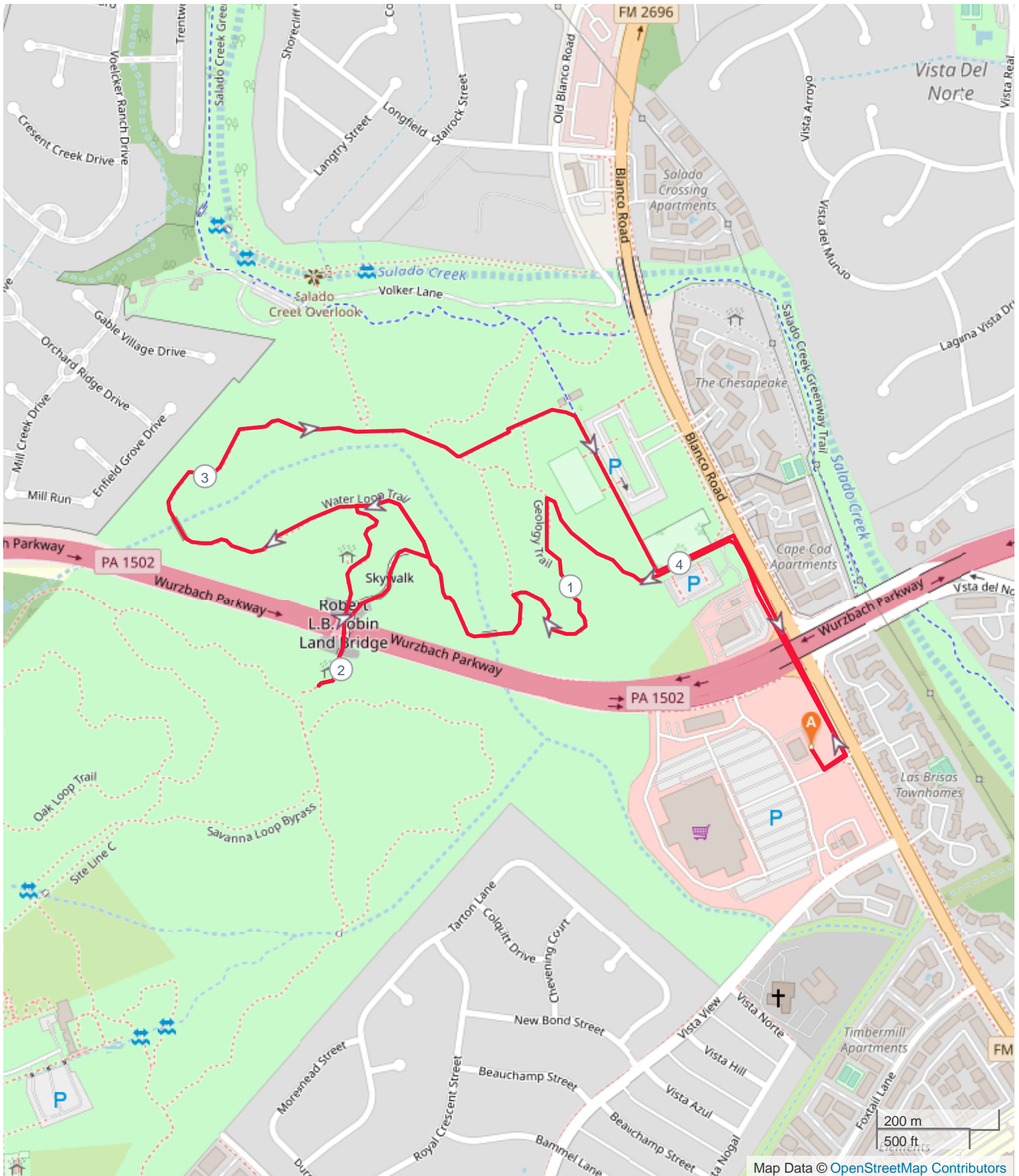

# HARDBERGER Park 10k - Y2884

## San Antonio Pathfinders

1. **Start From** the parking lot at 12711 Blanco Road.
2. **Walk** to Blanco Road and turn **LEFT**.
3. **CONTINUE** on Blanco Road to intersection with Wurzbach Parkway and cross with the walk signs.
4. After CVS, pass two crosswalks to the side-by-side entrance/exit to the park.
5. **LEFT** into the park keeping the dog park on right. Continue to the paved Water Loop Trail.
6. **CONTINUE** to end of paved path to the intersection with Geology Trail (no sign).
7. **Sharp LEFT** onto the gravel path. Continue to limestone blocks.
8. **LEFT** after the blocks walking away from the exit.
9. **LEFT** onto the Skywalk, an elevated walkway (trash receptacle on right).
10. **LEFT** onto the Tobin Land Bridge at end of Skywalk and towards the NW Military entrance.
11. **LEFT** on Savanna Loop Trail. **STAY TO THE LEFT AND CONTINUE STRAIGHT** on trail into the woods.
12. **STAY LEFT** at Savanna Loop Bypass and continue towards the Urban Ecology Center.
13. **LEFT** onto trail to playfields, parking and playground.
14. Continue **STRAIGHT (DO NOT** turn left to the exit).
15. **RIGHT** at the bike rack onto the crushed rock trail between the parking lot and the playground keeping the fence and playground on right.
16. **CONTINUE STRAIGHT** on trail into the woods.
17. **RIGHT** on concrete trail just before the street passing a low wall on right.
18. **CROSS** the parking lot to the Urban Ecology Center, walk under the awning, and **TURN LEFT** on the concrete porch at the back of the Center (restrooms available).
19. **RIGHT and GO DOWN** the ramp near the end of the porch, then **DOWN** the steps.
20. **LEFT** on the Savanna Loop crushed rock trail.
21. **LEFT** at the next T-intersection.
22. **RIGHT** at the first right onto the Oak Loop (trail name in concrete on ground).
23. **LEFT** at Oak Loop sign and trash recycle receptacle to continue along the rocky Oak Loop trail staying to the right until the intersection with the Savanna Loop.
24. **SHARP LEFT** onto the rocky Savanna Loop.

## San Antonio Pathfinders

25. **STAY TO THE RIGHT** on the Savanna Loop trail with traffic noise and view of Tobin Land Bridge on left.
26. **LEFT** onto the Tobin Land Bridge and walk to the Blanco Road Entrance. **DO NOT USE** the Skywalk.
27. **LEFT** on the Water Loop trail at the T-intersection at the end of the land bridge.
28. **STAY TO THE RIGHT** at the first trail to the left.
29. **LEFT** onto the Site Line B Trail (2<sup>nd</sup> trail to the left) towards the Overlook.
30. **CONTINUE STRAIGHT** crossing the Salado Creek Greenway trail and Voelcker Lane to the Salado Creek Overlook.
31. **U-TURN** back to the Salado Creek Greenway trail, the **LEFT** onto the concrete Greenway trail.
32. **STAY TO THE RIGHT** at the T-intersection.
33. **LEFT** at the next left to continue along the Salado Creek Greenway trail.
34. **LEFT** at the 2 trash cans onto the Geology Loop concrete trail following the trail as it circles and then crosses the Salado Creek Greenway trail becoming a crushed rock trail.
35. **LEFT** at the first paved trail walking through the Salado Outdoor Classroom (restrooms available) and passing the parking lot on left, the playground on right and then the dog park on left.
36. At end of the dog park, **LEFT** onto the sidewalk to Blanco Road.
37. **RIGHT** on Blanco Road passing CVS on right and **carefully CROSS** Wurzbach Parkway to finish.
