



**The Texas County Walkers
2022 Borden County
10 km and 5 km Walks
GAIL, TEXAS**



The town and county are named for Gail Borden, inventor of condensed milk. You'll see the Courthouse, Post Office, school, and a church. The Borden County Museum, next to the courthouse, is open by reservation. 10 km walkers will reverse the 5 km route to get the distance.

Walk Completion and Credit:

When you finish your walk(s), be sure to log back in to the OSB System and enter your participation date, distances, and Special Programs (if applicable).

Start Point Address and Driving Directions:

The Start Point is next to the Borden County Courthouse in Gail, TX (Google Maps code: QH93+WR). East- or west-bound on US-180, turn south on Oak St. / Ranch Road 669 and park next to the Courthouse. Parking is free.

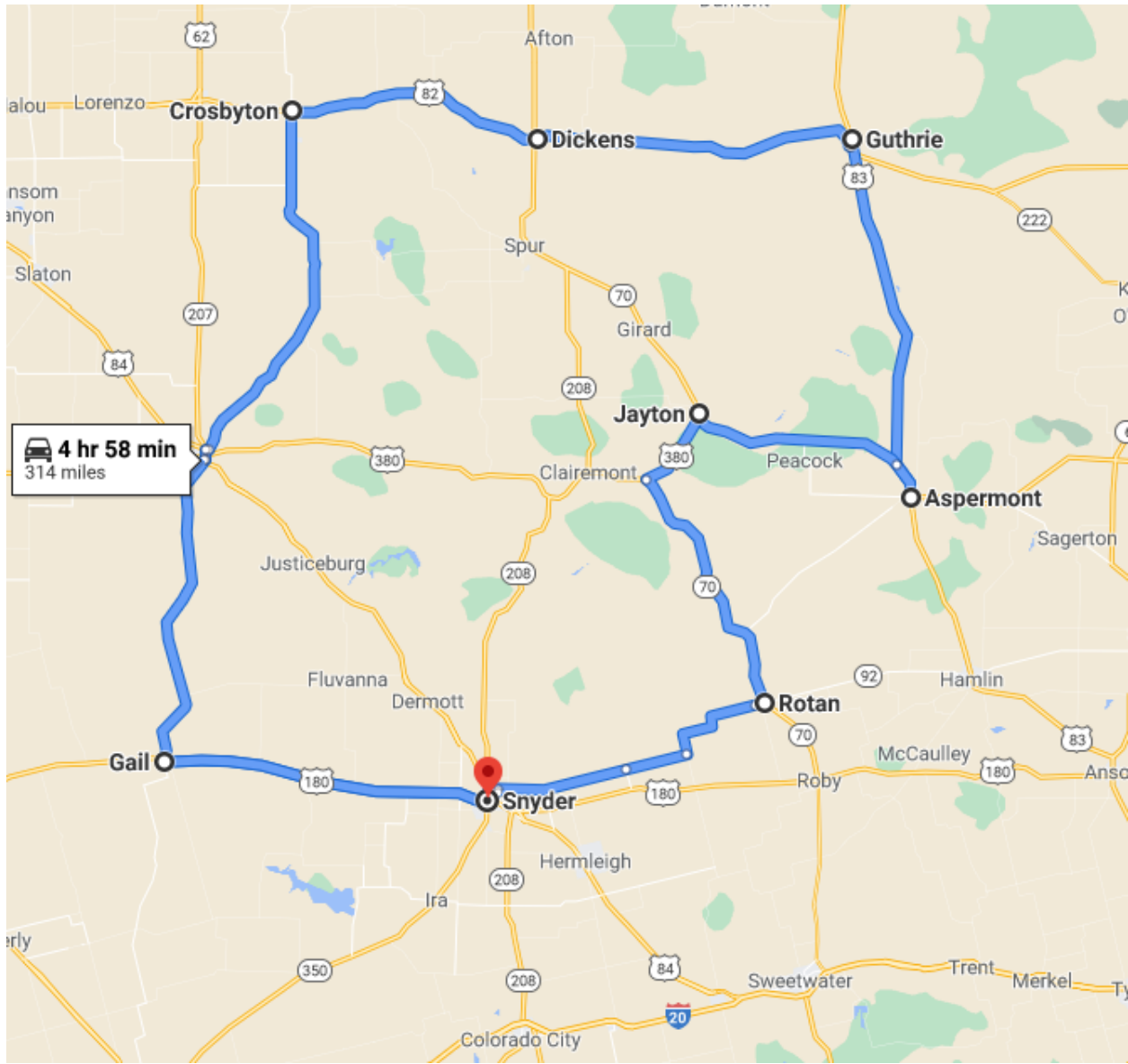
Restrooms:

TEXAS COUNTY WALKERS – BORDEN COUNTY 5 km and 10 km WALKS in GAIL, TX.

From US-180, east or west bound, turn south on Oak St. / Ranch Rd. 669 and park next to Courthouse.

5 KM

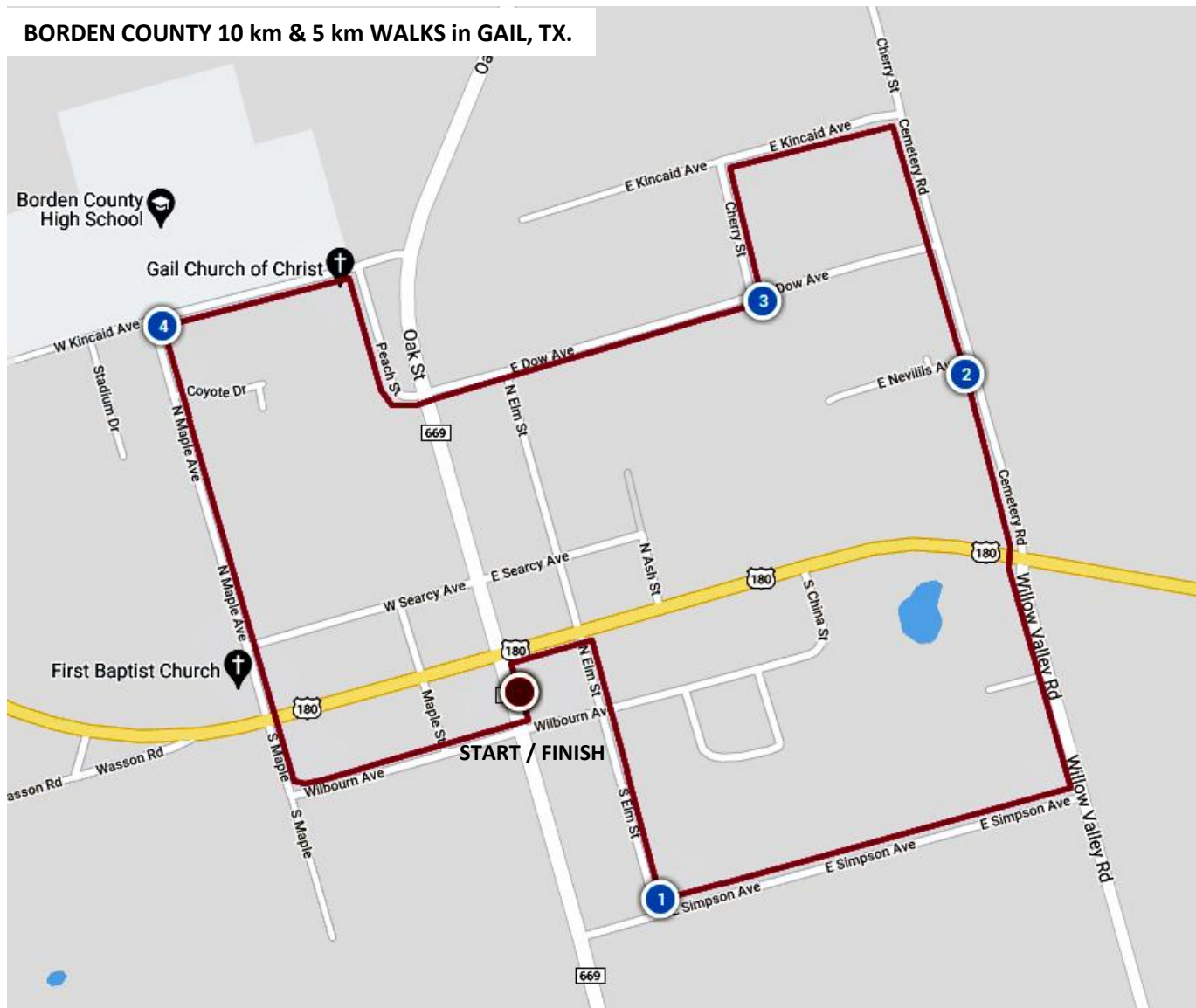
1. Walk around the front of the Courthouse on US-180 for 1 block to Elm Street.
2. Turn **RIGHT** on Elm for 2 blocks to end at Simpson Avenue.
3. **LEFT** on Simpson to end at Willow Valley Road.
4. **LEFT** on Willow Valley to the stop sign at US-180 / Wasson Ave.
5. **CAREFULLY CROSS** US-180 and continue straight (now Cemetery Road) for 3 blocks to E. Kincaid Avenue.
6. **LEFT** on E. Kincaid, passing the cemetery, for 1 block to Cherry Street (no street sign).
7. **LEFT** on Cherry St. for 1 block to E. Dow Avenue.
8. **RIGHT** on E. Dow to the stop sign at Oak Street / Ranch Road 669.
9. **CAREFULLY CROSS** Oak / RR 669 and **CONTINUE** on Peach Street around the curve to W. Kincaid Avenue.
10. **LEFT** on W. Kincaid to N. Maple Avenue.
11. **LEFT** on Maple Ave. to the stop sign at US-180 / W. Wasson Avenue.
12. **CROSS** US-180/Wasson and continue on Maple for 1 block to Wilburn Avenue.
13. **CURVE LEFT** on Wilburn to stop sign at Oak St. / RR-669.
14. **CROSS and LEFT on** Oak / FM-699 to **FINISH**.

FOR 10 KM, REVERSE ROUTE:

15. **RETURN** to Wilburn Avenue.
16. **CROSS** Oak St. / RR-669 to right and continue on Wilburn to end at S. Maple Ave.
17. **CURVE RIGHT** on Maple, cross US-180 / Wasson Ave, and continue on Maple to end at W. Kincaid Ave.
18. **RIGHT** on W. Kincaid to Peach Street.
19. **RIGHT** on Peach St. for 1 block to Oak St. / RR-669.
20. **CROSS** Oak St. / RR-669 and **CONTINUE STRAIGHT** on E. Dow Ave. to Cherry Street.
21. **LEFT** on Cherry St. for 1 block to E. Kincaid Ave.
22. **RIGHT** on E. Kincaid for 1 block to end at Cemetery Road.
23. **RIGHT** on Cemetery Rd. for 3 blocks to stop sign at US-180.
24. **CROSS US-180 and CONTINUE** straight (now on Willow Valley Road) to E. Simpson Ave. (you'll see the Willow Valley road sign on the right, near telephone pole).
25. **RIGHT** on Simpson to S. Elm Street (look for the Elm St. sign facing you on the right).
26. **RIGHT** on S. Elm for 2 blocks to US-180 / E. Wasson.
27. **LEFT** on US-180 / E. Wasson for 1 block to Oak St. / RR-669 and **FINISH**

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.
