This walk is composed of a 5km and a 11km routes. The walk is rated 1A and is along city sidewalks and passes and the parish courthouse and historic homes. The 11k route also goes thru to the city recreational facilities. The start/end point is Pointe Coupee Parish Courthouse at 201 Main St in New Roads. Restrooms are available at the parish courthouse during the work week and at various businesses along the route.

Walk Registration:

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) or contact the POC register remotely. If using the OSB, then complete the walk online as indicated below. If registering remotely, insert cards will be mailed to you. Directions and stamp will be available during the MLK weekend events Jan 13-17 from the POC.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start Point:

The walk starts at parish courthouse parking lot at 201 Main St in New Roads. From LA-10, turn south on the Ferry Road/New Roads St. Continue to Main St (parallels the False River), then turn left on Main St to the courthouse on the left.

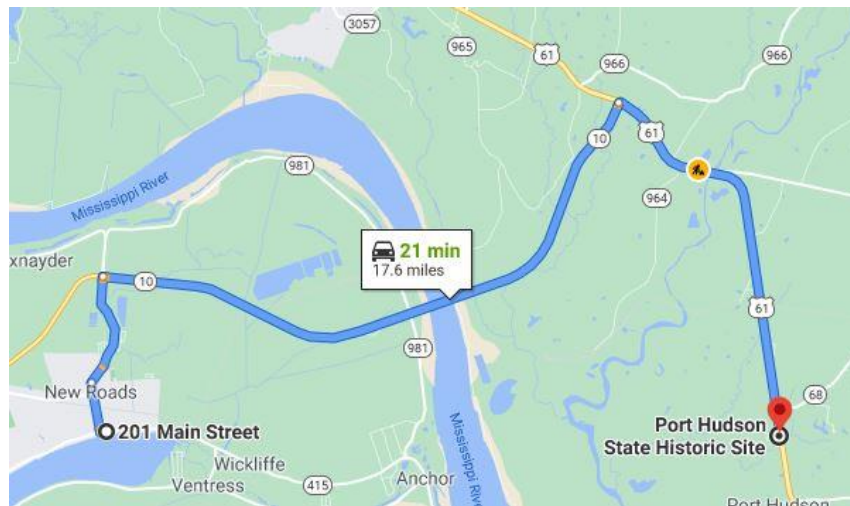

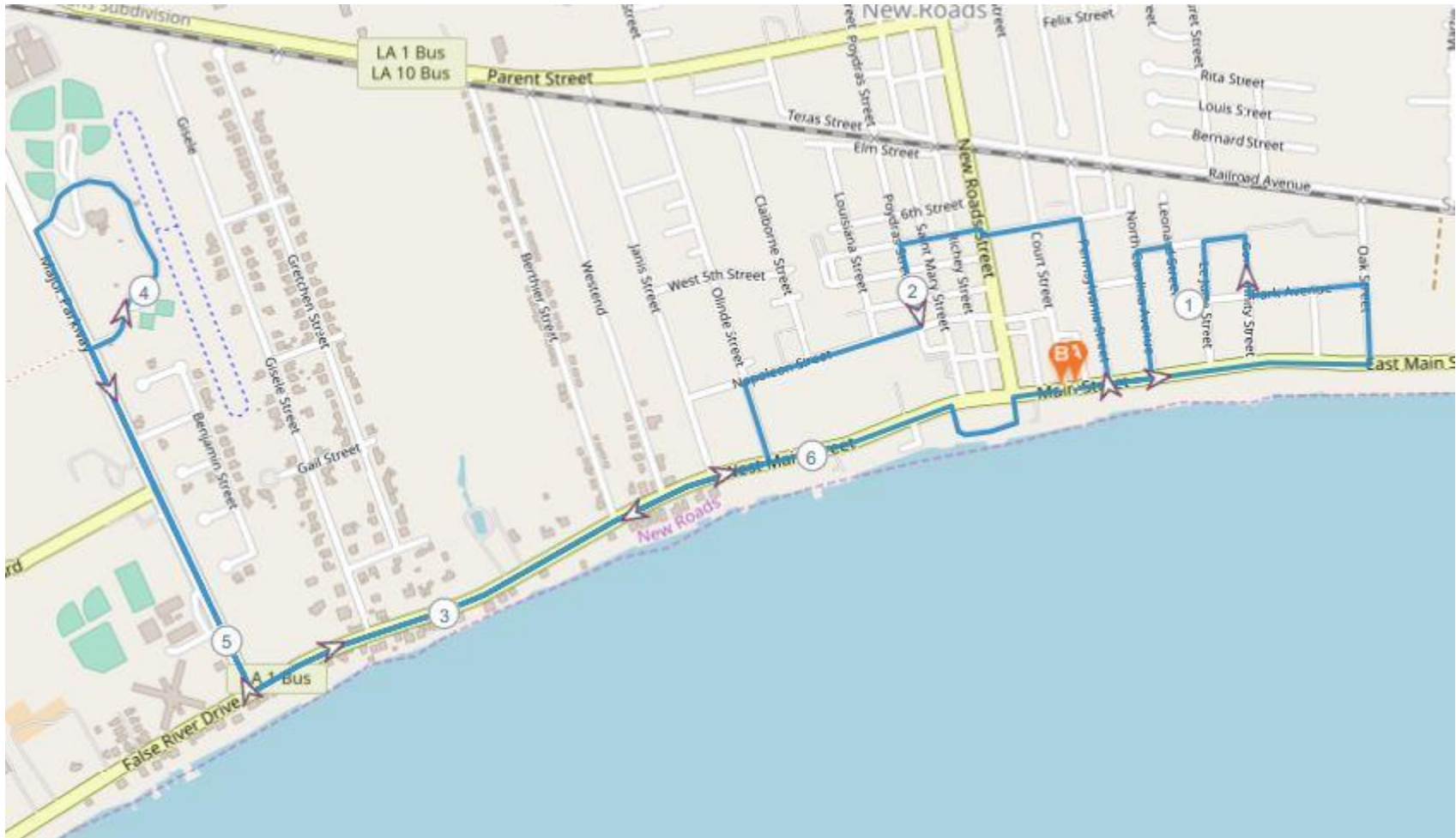
Drive to the Parish Courthouse in downtown New Roads at 201 Main St. From US-61, take LA-10 west to Ferry Road/New Roads St, then left on street to Main St. **LEFT** on Main St a short distance to the courthouse on the left.

**Special Programs: Rockin' Around the Clock, Walking with America's Veterans**

1. **Note** statue of Lt Gen John Lejeune (born in Pointe Coupee Parish), the 13th commandant of the Marine Corps who served during WWI.
2. **With your back to the courthouse, LEFT** on Main St about 6 blocks to Oak St.
3. **LEFT** on Oak 1 block to Park, then **LEFT** on Park 2 blocks to Community
4. **RIGHT** on Community 1 block to Mill, then **LEFT** on Mill 1 block to Lejeune.
5. **LEFT** on Lejeune 1 block to Park, then **RIGHT** on Park 1 block to Leonard.
6. **RIGHT** on Leonard 1 block to Mill, then **LEFT** on Mill 1 block to North Carolina.
7. **LEFT** on North Carolina 1 block to Main St, then **RIGHT** on Main 1 block to Pennsylvania.
8. **RIGHT** on Pennsylvania 2 blocks to 5th St, then **LEFT** on 5th 2 blocks to New Roads St.
9. **Carefully Cross and JOG RIGHT** a short distance to continue on 5th St 3 short blocks to Poydras.
10. **LEFT** on Poydras 3 short blocks to 2nd St, then **RIGHT** on 2nd St 3 blocks to Olinde St. (2nd St becomes Napoleon St)
11. **LEFT** on Olinde 1 block to Main St.
12. **5K ONLY: LEFT** on Main, then **SKIP to Step 15.**
13. **11K ONLY: RIGHT** on Main about 1k to Major Parkway, then **RIGHT** on Major about 1 mile to the False River Park on the right.
14. **RIGHT** into the park and follow the park road left and returning to Major Blvd.
15. **LEFT** on Major Pkwy back to Main St, then **LEFT** on Main about 1k to Olinde St.
16. **5K REJOINS Here:** Continue on Main a short and a long block to St Mary (on left).
17. **Look** for Morrison on right just before St Mary.
18. **RIGHT** on Morrison toward the docks, then left thru the parking area and a street (restrooms).
19. **LEFT** on street (New Roads) 1 block to Main. Visit the New Roads Visitor Center (Mon-Fri) and its big alligator across Main St and to the left.
20. **RIGHT** on Main returning to the start point.
