<b>Start Point / Driving Directions:</b>	16150 Pilot Knob Rd., Lakeville, MN 55044. Take I-35E South to Pilot Knob Rd exit 97A. Turn right on Pilot Knob Rd. Continue on Pilot Knob Rd. approximately 9 miles to Hy-Vee in Lakeville, MN.

<b>Comments:</b>	Parking and restrooms available at start point and parks along the route.

**WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT:** Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when they submit the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note however that the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days. Also note that an event registration expires after 30 days, but if your registrations lapses, you may re-register without cost.



## Lakeville Two Lakes Walk 5 & 10 km Walk

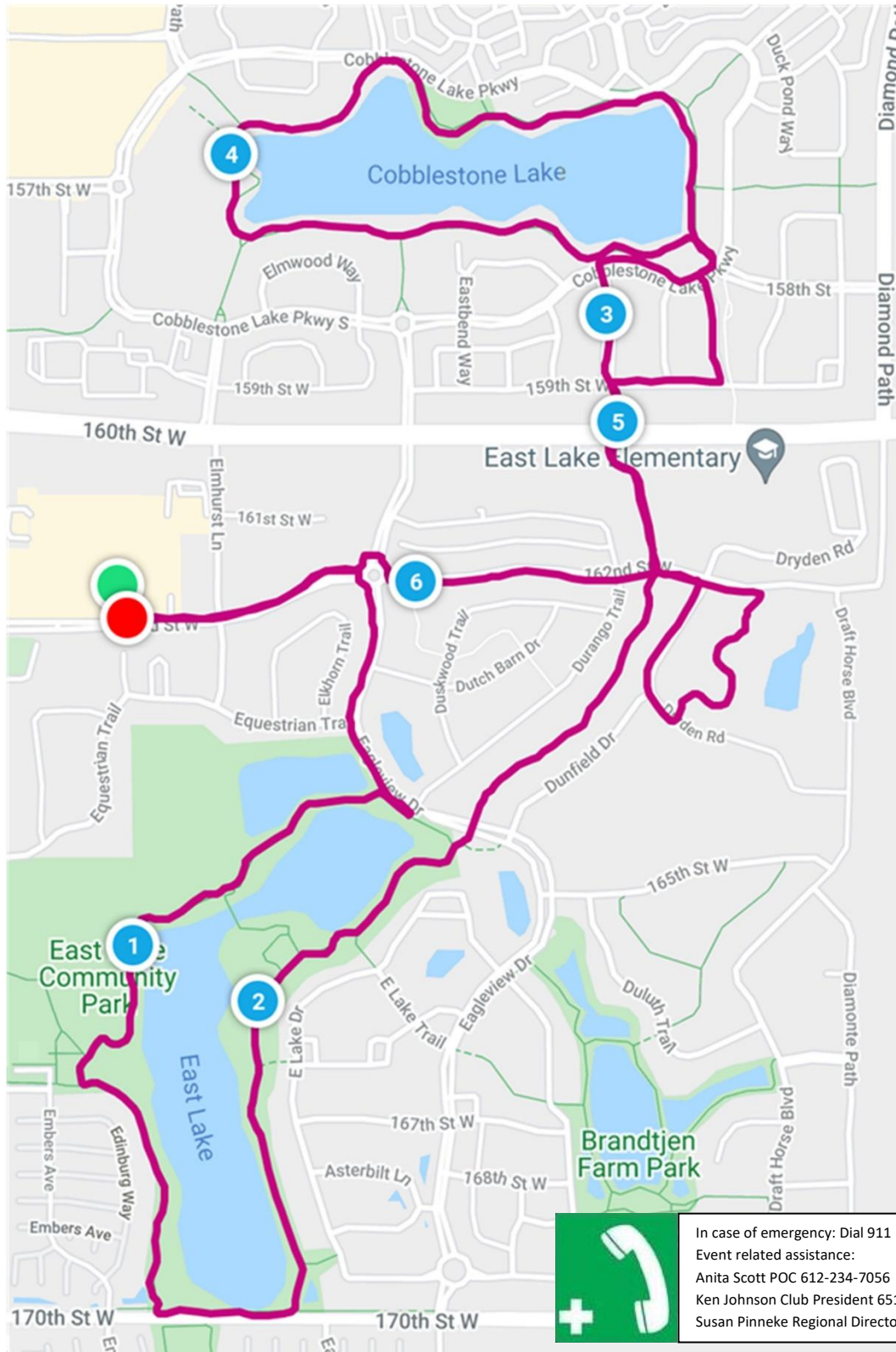
(Numbers on the attached map are mile markers)

1. Facing Hyvee turn **right** and walk out to 162nd St W
2. **Left** on 162nd St W (1 block) to cross Elmhurst Lane
3. **Continue** on 162nd St W to the traffic circle with statue of a horse and buggy
4. **Right** at the traffic circle onto Eagleview Dr Cross Equestrian Trail in 1 block
5. **Right** at Durango Trail (1 block) onto the East Lake walking path
6. **Right** on the walking path keeping the Lake on your left
7. Continue on the main walking path all the way around the Lake keeping the water on your left (Restroom at the playground 1.2 mi)
8. After circling the Lake, you will come to a tunnel (2.25 mi)
9. **Right** and go through the tunnel
10. Continue on the walking path to the crosswalk at 162nd St W (**5km go to #32**)
11. **Cross** 162nd St W to stay on the walking path (East Lake Elementary School on the right)
12. **Continue** on the walking path and go through a second tunnel
13. Exiting the tunnel continue **straight** crossing 159th St and stay on the walking path on Dutton Lane
14. At the end of the walking path **cross** Cobblestone Lake Pkwy to the sidewalk (3 mi)
15. **Right** on the sidewalk
16. **Continue** on the sidewalk to 158th St W
17. **On the left** you will see the entrance to the walking path to Cobblestone Lake
18. **Left** onto the walking path
19. **Right** at the Trail Crossing Sign
20. **Continue** on the pedestrian walkway all the way around the Lake keeping the water on your left (Restrooms at picnic shelter 3.8 mi on the right)
21. After circling the Lake go **right** to exit the walking path where you entered (there will be a large stone wall just before your exit point) and continue to Cobblestone Lake Pkwy
22. **Right** onto sidewalk
23. **First left** onto Dry Creek Lane
24. **Right** on 159th St W
25. **Cross** Dumont Lane
26. **Left** at Dutton Lane going back through the tunnel (4.8 mi)
27. **Cross** 162nd St at the crosswalk and turn left
28. **Right** on Dryden Road
29. **Cross** Dunfield Dr
30. **Left** on the walking path between houses 16286 and 16298 on the left
31. **Continue** on the walking path to the sidewalk at 162nd St
32. **Left** onto 162nd St (**5K GOTO #36**)
33. **Cross** Dryden Road
34. **Cross** Durango Trail
35. **Right** at the traffic circle and cross 162nd St
36. **Left** and cross Eagleview Drive
37. **Left** onto 162nd St and continue straight to return to the Hyvee
