



LEON CREEK GREENWAY – Y2960 MAINLAND TRAILHEAD WALK

San Antonio Pathfinders

This walk is composed of 10K and 5K routes. The trail is rated 1A. The Leon Creek Greenway is part of the Howard W. Peak Greenway Trail System, which is a growing network of developed multi-use and accessible trails. The Leon Creek Greenway consists of concrete and asphalt surfaces and is currently 32K (20 miles) in length, with several connector trails linking other parks together in the trail system. Much of Leon Creek Greenway trail is within the Leon Creek Flood plain with numerous creek crossings.

Walk Registration:

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish and complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion information indicating the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion information as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.) Also note that an event registration expires after 30 days, but if your registrations lapses, you may re-register without cost.

Driving Directions to Start Point:

The start point for the Leon Creek Greenway event is Leon Creek Greenway, Mainland Trailhead, 8241 Mainland Dr., San Antonio, TX 78240.

From Loop 410 take Exit-13A and go north on Bandera Rd. for 3.2 miles. Turn RIGHT onto Mainland Dr. until it dead ends at the parking lot for the Mainland Trailhead. Portable restrooms are located at the trailheads.

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MAINLAND TRAILHEAD WALK

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The Leon Creek Greenway at the Mainland Trailhead is a very popular paved walk/bike trail along Leon Creek. It is well-shaded in most areas. Walkers will see limestone bluffs, wildflower fields, stands of Cottonwood and Live Oaks and other heritage trees. Wildlife may be seen in the meadows. Leon Creek is normally dry but can fill rapidly during heavy rains. The trail will be temporarily closed when flooded.

1. From the Mainland Trailhead parking lot, turn **RIGHT** on the paved trail and go under Bandera Rd.
2. Pass milepost 6.50, cross a dirt road, passing mileposts 6.25, 6.00, 5.75 and 5.50. Stop at mile post 5.25.
3. **TURN AROUND** and return to the start at Mainland Trailhead to complete 5K.
4. For 10K walk **CONTINUE** north on the pathway passing mileposts 5.25, 5.00, 4.75, 4.50, 4.25, two metal bridges and milepost 4.00.
5. At intersection of trail and Grissom Road, turn **RIGHT** and cross the pedestrian bridge over Leon Creek to the Grissom Trailhead at milepost 3.75.
6. **TURN AROUND** and return to the start at Mainland Trailhead to complete 10K walk.

Alternate Route

1. Turn **LEFT** on paved trail passing mile marker 6.75.
2. **CONTINUE** on the trail until reaching mile marker 8.25. **TURN AROUND** and return to the start at Mainland Trailhead for 5K.
3. For the 10K walk continue on the trail until mile marker 9.75.
4. **TURN AROUND** and return to start at Mainland Trailhead.

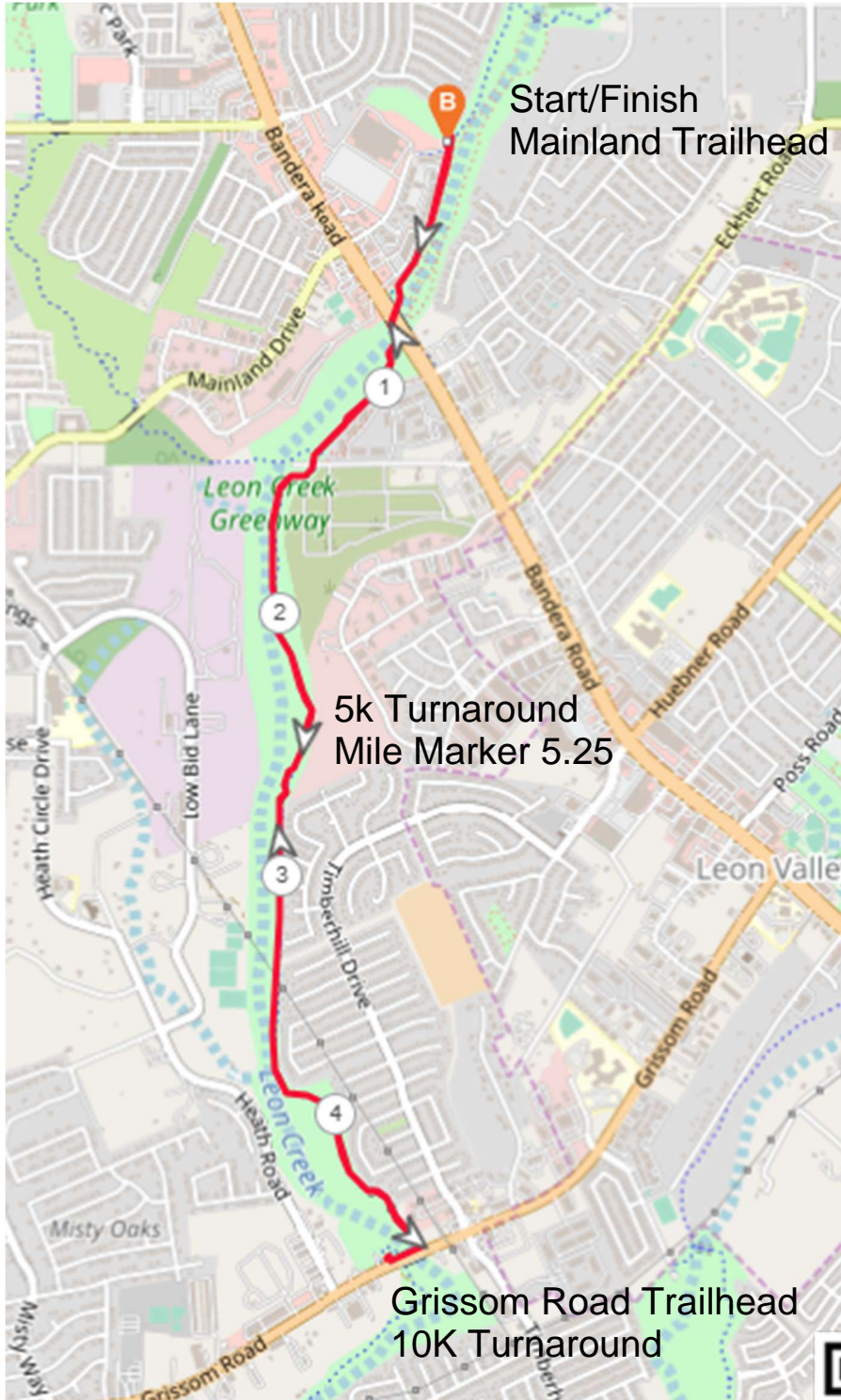

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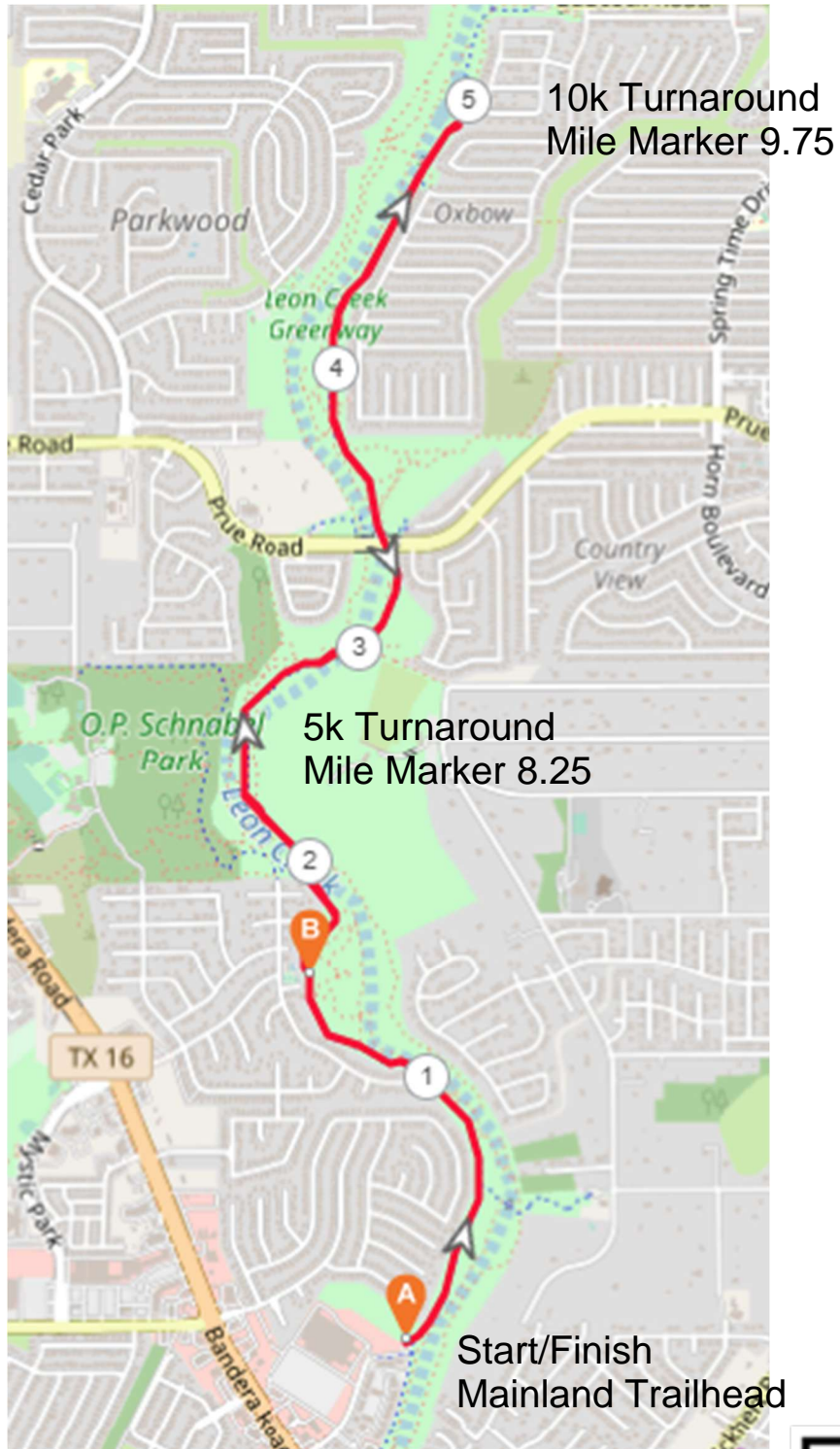
Mainland Trailhead to Grissom Trailhead
