Driving directions to the walk start

From Snoqualmie Pass:

Drive east on I-90. Take Exit 84. Exit ramp will curve over I-90 to a stoplight. Go STRAIGHT through the stoplight and turn LEFT at the next street which is Pine Street. (*McDonalds on your right*). Go two blocks on Pine Street to Second Street. Turn RIGHT on Second and immediately park in the angled parking spaces on your right that are along 2nd Street at the Cle Elum City Park.

From Ellensburg:

Drive west on I-90. Take Exit 84. At the "T", Turn RIGHT on Oakes Avenue. CROSS the railroad tracks to the stoplight. Turn LEFT on First Street. Go up the hill and turn RIGHT on Pine Street (*McDonalds on your left*). Go two blocks on Pine Street to Second Street. Turn RIGHT on Second and immediately park in the angled parking spaces on your right that are along 2nd Street at the Cle Elum City Park.

Cle Elum City Park coordinates: N 47.19719 W 120.95097.

Restrooms:

In Cle Elum City Park (if they are open) and there is an outhouse at the Coal Mine Trailhead.

Words-to-the-Wise and Other Info:

During cold mornings in the early spring or late fall, there may be icy patches especially where temps are below freezing at night and where the sun hasn't shone on or melted ice on walk surfaces. In April, there may still be snow patches on the rail trail. During hot summer days, carry water and bring your own shade as some portions of the walk are unshaded.

Thanks for participating in our Cle Elum walk. There are walks nearby in Suncadia, South Cle Elum and Roslyn. There are also two walks in Ellensburg.

5K Directions

1. Standing on the sidewalk facing the park, turn **LEFT** on the sidewalk. Proceed downhill on **Second Street** to **Stafford St.** roundabout.
2. Carefully **CROSS** Stafford in crosswalk and just after Stafford, **ANGLE RIGHT** on concrete path with Flagpole Park on your right (*Walk w/ America's Vets Challenge sign behind fir tree*). Walk through parking lot to sidewalk on **1st Street.** (no sign).
3. Turn **LEFT** on sidewalk. (*City Hall at 1st and Oakes St*).
4. Turn **LEFT** on **Pennsylvania Ave.**
You will pass the city fire station.
5. Turn **LEFT** on **3rd St.** (may be unsigned)
Carpenter Museum along the way.
6. Turn **LEFT** on **Stafford Street.**
7. In 200 feet, **CROSS** Stafford and **ANGLE SHARP RIGHT** onto the gravel **Coal Mine Rail Trail.**
8. At the concrete ford (*creek overflow structure*) and bench on your right, turn **AROUND** and return to the trailhead.
9. Angle **RIGHT** on **Stafford St.** to roundabout.
10. Carefully **CROSS** **2nd St.** and turn **RIGHT** on the sidewalk back uphill to the park.
11. Continue past the park and **ANGLE LEFT** on **Ranger Station Rd.** (*Walk carefully on left edge of road - no sidewalk*).
12. Carefully **CROSS** **Douglas Munro Blvd** and turn **RIGHT** on the sidewalk. Blvd and sidewalk then **CURVES** to the **LEFT.**
13. At the end of the sidewalk, turn **RIGHT** through the entrance into **Laurel Hill Memorial Park (cemetery).**

No dogs allowed in cemetery. If walking a dog, simply turn AROUND at cemetery entrance and walk on left side of Munro Blvd back to Ranger Station Rd. Then continue with #19.

For those walking through the cemetery, go through the cemetery entrance and continue with #14.

14. Angle **RIGHT** at first gravel road "Y".
15. Turn **RIGHT** at second 4-way gravel road intersection and walk past the Cle Elum Serviceman's and Douglas Munro Memorial (*Local Man and Congressional Medal of Honor recipient*) on your left.
16. Continue **STRAIGHT** ahead on the gravel road to a "T" (no sign).
17. Turn **RIGHT** on the gravel road out of the cemetery back to **Munro Blvd** (no sign).
18. Turn **LEFT** on the shoulder of **Munro Blvd.**
19. Turn **LEFT** on **Ranger Station Road** and walk on left shoulder.
20. At **Second Street W.**, turn **RIGHT** and carefully cross **Ranger Station Road** in the crosswalk.
21. Continue **STRAIGHT** ahead along **Second St.** back to the park (*Along the way, see the wheelbarrow art in the tree across Second St.*)

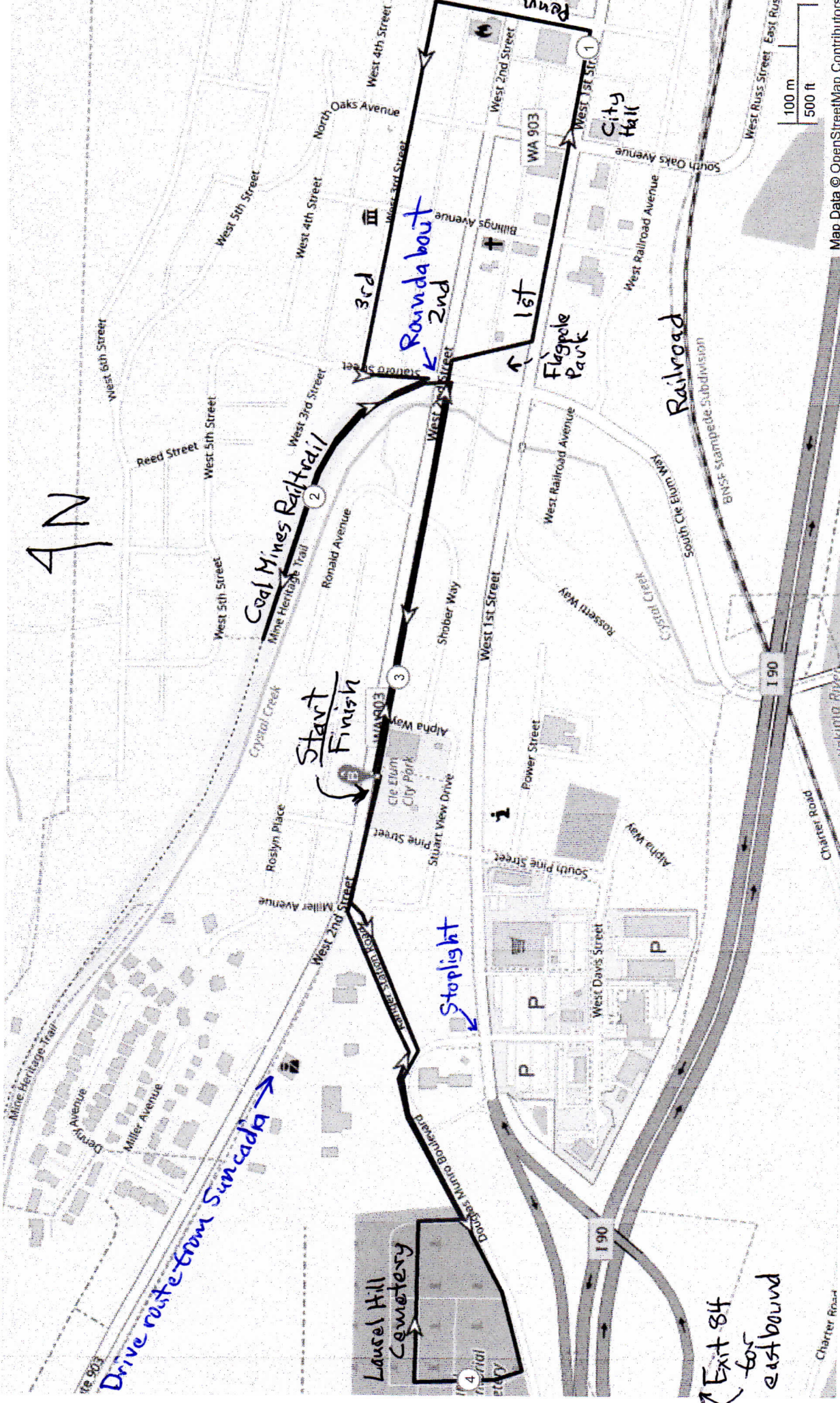
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These walking directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded pdf is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to a walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker.) The \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded pdf expires in 60 days.

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10K Directions

1. Standing on the sidewalk facing the park, turn **LEFT** on the sidewalk. Proceed downhill on 2nd Street to Stafford Street roundabout.
2. Carefully **CROSS** Stafford in crosswalk and just after Stafford, **ANGLE RIGHT** on concrete path with Flagpole Park on your right (*Walk w/ America's Vets Challenge sign behind fir tree*). Walk through parking lot to 1st St. (no sign).
3. Turn **LEFT** on sidewalk. You will walk 1K on 1st Street. (*City Hall at 1st and Oakes St. and the Phone Museum*).
4. Turn **LEFT** on Peoh Ave.
5. Turn **LEFT** on 2nd Street. Proceed to Pennsylvania Ave (no sign but it is a 4 way stop - city library across 2nd Street).
6. Turn **RIGHT** on Pennsylvania 1 block to 3rd Street. *You'll pass the fire station.*
7. Turn **LEFT** on 3rd St. (may be unsigned) *Carpenter Museum along the way.*
8. Turn **LEFT** on Stafford Street.
9. In 200 feet, **CROSS** Stafford and **ANGLE SHARP RIGHT** onto gravel Coal Mine Trail.
10. Proceed on the trail (*approx. 2 1/2 K*) to a paved asphalt cross road (no sign).
11. Turn **AROUND** and return on the trail to the trailhead on Stafford Street.
12. Angle **RIGHT** on Stafford St to roundabout.
13. Carefully **CROSS** 2nd St. and turn **RIGHT** on the sidewalk back uphill to the park.
14. Continue past the park and **ANGLE LEFT** on Ranger Station Rd. (*Walk carefully on left edge of road - no sidewalk*).
15. Carefully **CROSS** Douglas Munro Blvd and turn **RIGHT** on the sidewalk. Blvd and sidewalk then **CURVES** to the **LEFT**.
16. At the end of the sidewalk, turn **RIGHT** through the entrance into Laurel Hill Memorial Park (*cemetery*).

No dogs allowed in cemetery. If walking a dog, simply turn **AROUND** at cemetery entrance and walk on left side of Munro Blvd back to Ranger Station Rd. Then continue with #22.

For those walking through the cemetery, continue with #17.

17. Angle **RIGHT** at first gravel road "Y".
18. Turn **RIGHT** at second 4-way gravel road intersection and walk past the Cle Elum Serviceman's and Douglas Munro Memorial (*Local man and Congressional Medal of Honor recipient*) on your left.
19. Continue **STRAIGHT** ahead on the gravel road to a "T" (no sign).
20. Turn **RIGHT** on the gravel road out of the cemetery back to Munro Blvd (no sign).
21. Turn **LEFT** on the shoulder of Munro Blvd.
22. Turn **LEFT** on Ranger Station Road and walk on left shoulder.
23. At Second Street W., turn **RIGHT** and carefully cross Ranger Station Road in the crosswalk.
24. Continue **STRAIGHT** ahead along Second St. back to the park (*Along the way, see the wheelbarrow art in the tree across Second St.*)

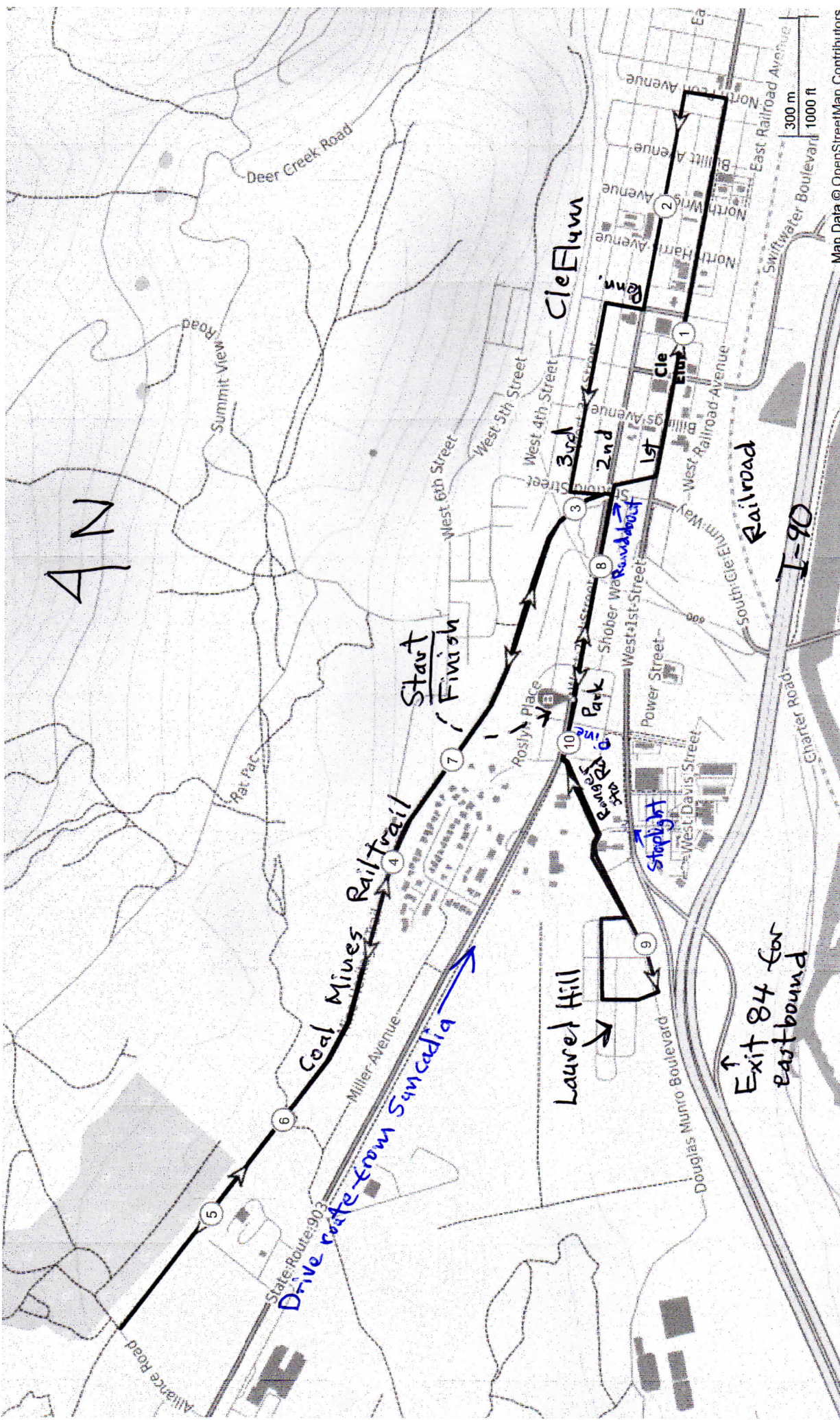
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Cle Elum 10K
