---

**Start/Finish point** is at the trailhead of the Cameron Reservoir walking path. Review directions below for the location of the parking lot where the trailhead begins. Portable toilets are available at the start point. There is another restroom located at the half-way point of the walk.

**Directions from Interstate 35 Northbound (From Kansas City):** Head northeast on I-35 N (towards Iowa). Take exit 54 for MO-110/US-36 toward Cameron/Hamilton. Sharp left onto US-36 W/Chicago–Kansas City Expy/Missouri 110. About a mile on US-36, turn right onto McElwain Rd (also called US-36 BUS). Trailhead parking lot will be on your left about 500’ from the turn on McElwain Rd.

**Directions from Interstate 35 Southbound:** Head southwest on I-35 S (from Iowa). Take exit 54 for US-36/I-35 toward Hamilton/Cameron. Turn right onto I-35BL S/US-36 W. About a mile on US-36, turn right onto McElwain Rd (also called US-36 BUS). Trailhead parking lot will be on your left about 500’ from the turn on McElwain Rd.

Special Programs: Walking the USA A – Z (“C”); Walking Missouri Counties (DeKalb County)

---

1. Park in the trailhead parking lot.  
Portable restrooms are available at the parking area.
2. With your back to the parking lot, turn LEFT and begin walking on the trail.
3. Continue on the paved walking trail for the next 1.3 Miles. The reservoir will be on your left.
4. After walking across the bridge, turn LEFT at the public fishing dock.  
Restrooms are available in the parking lot.
5. Continue on the trail for .3 miles until you reach the end of the trail.
6. Turn around and walk back to the public fishing dock.
7. RIGHT at the public fishing dock and continue on the paved trail until you reach your vehicle back at the parking lot of the walking path.

## WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT

Be sure to log back into the OSB system to “finish/complete” your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant’s Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user’s Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user’s Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.).

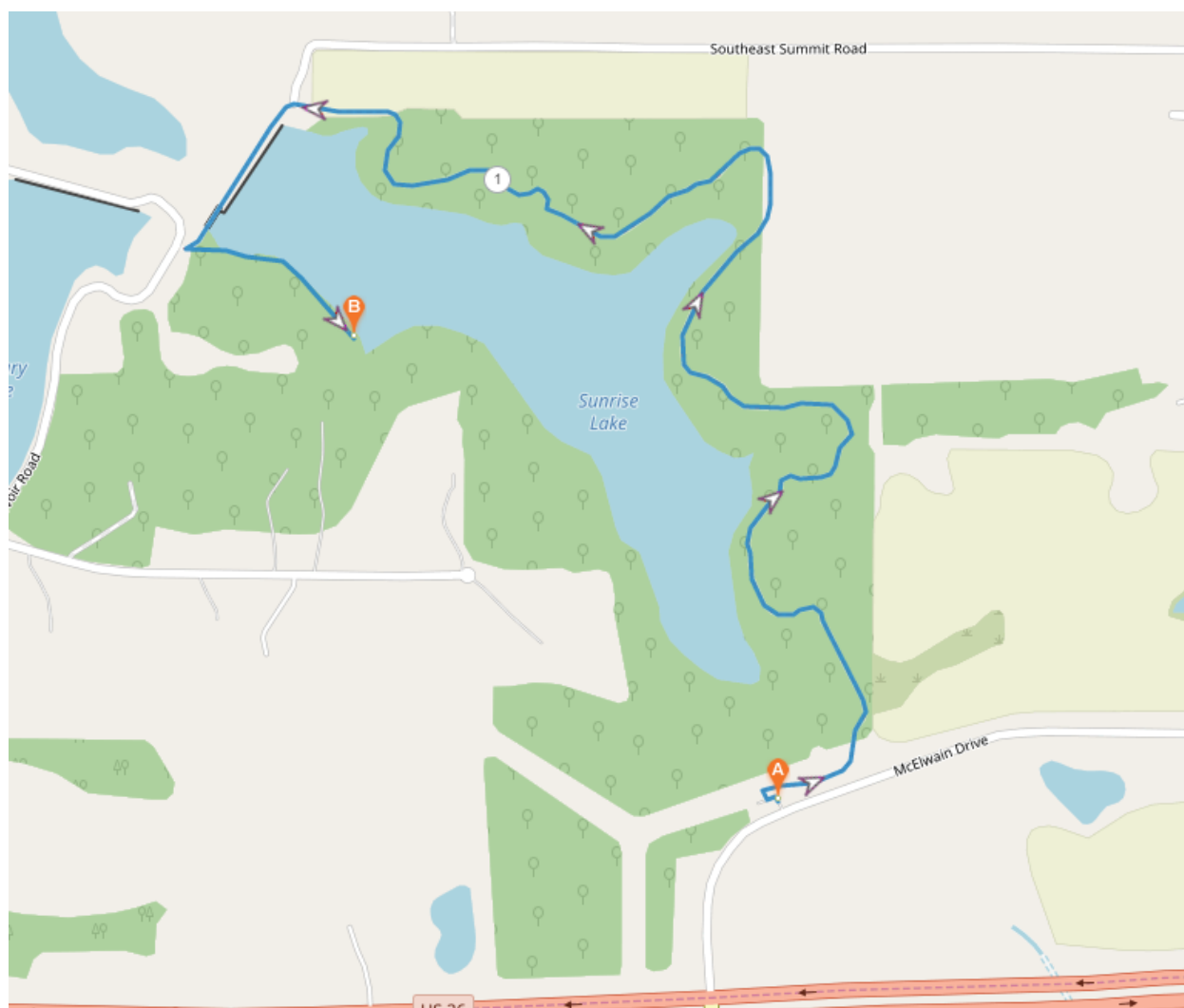

**Directions from Interstate 35 Northbound (From Kansas City):** Head northeast on I-35 N (towards Iowa). Take exit 54 for MO-110/US-36 toward Cameron/Hamilton. Sharp left onto US-36 W/Chicago–Kansas City Expy/Missouri 110. About a mile on US-36, turn right onto McElwain Rd (also called US-36 BUS). Trailhead parking lot will be on your left about 500’ from the turn on McElwain Rd.

**Directions from Interstate 35 Southbound:** Head southwest on I-35 S (from Iowa). Take exit 54 for US-36/I-35 toward Hamilton/Cameron. Turn right onto I-35BL S/US-36 W. About a mile on US-36, turn right onto McElwain Rd (also called US-36 BUS). Trailhead parking lot will be on your left about 500’ from the turn on McElwain Rd.

Special Programs: Walking the USA A – Z (“C”); Walking Missouri Counties (DeKalb County)

---

1. Park in the trailhead parking lot.  
Portable restrooms are available at the parking area.
2. With your back to the parking lot, turn LEFT and begin walking on the trail.
3. Continue on the paved walking trail for the next 1.3 Miles. The reservoir will be on your left.
4. After walking across the bridge, turn LEFT at the public fishing dock.  
Restrooms are available in the parking lot.
5. Continue on the trail for .3 miles until you reach the end of the trail.
6. Turn around and walk back to the public fishing dock.
7. RIGHT at the public fishing dock and continue on the paved trail until you reach your vehicle back at the parking lot of the walking path.
8. To complete a 10K, repeat steps 1-7
