

# Kirksville, MO (Cemetery and Osteopathic) 5K YRE 2968 WALK DIRECTIONS

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This map and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association (AVA) athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

In case of emergency: Dial 911

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**Start/Finish point** is at Casey’s General Store at 503 S. Franklin St, Kirksville, MO. Restrooms are available inside Casey’s. Restrooms are also available on the walk as noted in the directions. Please make sure NOT to park in the Casey’s parking lot. There is plenty of street parking on each side of, and behind, the store.

**Directions from Interstate 35 (towards Iowa):** Head northeast on I-35 N (towards Iowa). Take exit 54 for MO-110/US-36 toward Cameron/Hamilton. Turn right onto MO-110/US-36 E. Turn left onto Co Rd F. Turn right onto MO-11 S. Turn left onto State Hwy H. Continue onto S Boundary St. Turn right onto W Michigan St. Turn left onto S Osteopathy Ave. Turn right onto W Normal St. Turn left onto S Franklin St.

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Special Programs: Walking the USA A – Z (“K”); Walking Missouri Counties (Adair County); Town Halls/City Hall;; Walking With America’s Veterans

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1. Walk to the sidewalk in front of the Casey’s General Store.
2. RIGHT to the intersection of S. Franklin St. and Scott Streets.
3. Cross Franklin and continue walking on W. Scott Street to S. Main Street (National Guard Armory on left)
4. RIGHT on S. Main St. to Harrison St.
5. LEFT on Harrison St and walk to the entrance of Forest-Llewellyn Cemetery. You can find the graves of Jessie Kirk (Kirksville named after him). Andrew Still (Founder of Osteopathic Medicine). George Will Smith (Adair County’s last Civil War Soldier).
6. Enter cemetery and follow path to the end.
7. Turnaround and walk back to the cemetery entrance.
8. LEFT on Harrison St. to N. Main St.
9. RIGHT on N. Main St. to W. Jefferson St.
10. RIGHT on W. Jefferson St.
11. Follow the walkway through Centennial Park. Pass by the clock.
12. At the end of the walkway, turn RIGHT toward ATSU Tinning Education Center. The A.T. Still Museum of Osteopathic Medicine is inside the Education Center. Restrooms available inside.
13. From the ATSU Tinning Education Center follow the small walkway to a red brick path through the Medicinal Garden back to the street.
14. RIGHT and walk past the Gotensohn Osteopathic Health and Wellness Clinic and walk toward the Northeast Regional Heart Center.
15. LEFT on 5<sup>th</sup> St. (no sign) and walk to Normal St.
16. LEFT on Normal St to S. Halliburton St. The Ruth W. Towne Museum and Visitor Center is located at Normal and Franklin Streets. Restrooms available inside.
17. RIGHT on S. Halliburton St. The University Presidents house in on the right.
18. RIGHT on Randolph Street to S. Davis St.

19. RIGHT on S. Davis St to E. Scott St. You'll pass by university dormitories and fraternity houses.
20. LEFT on E. Scott St and walk 5 blocks to return back to Casey's General Store.

## Kirksville, MO (Town and University) 5K YRE 2968 WALK DIRECTIONS

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1. Walk to the sidewalk in front of the Casey’s General Store.
2. LEFT on S. Franklin St. to Stadium Drive (about .5 miles)
3. LEFT on Stadium Dr passing the football stadium on your left to St. Florence St. (“T” intersection – no sign.)
4. Cross Florence St and turn LEFT to E. Patterson St.
5. Cross Patterson St. and turn LEFT on walkway just past Dobson Hall.
6. RIGHT on walkway (flashing light at crosswalk). Violette Hall will be on your LEFT. Restrooms may be available in the public education buildings.
7. LEFT at 1<sup>st</sup> walkway. Curve RIGHT at end of walkway. Walk towards Clock Tower.
8. At Clock Tower, turn RIGHT and walk to steps on your left. Go down steps into the sunken garden. RIGHT on the grassy path. At end of garden turn LEFT and pass by the Gazebo. Go up the steps.
9. Follow the walkway to the Kirk Memorial.
10. Retrace your steps toward the campus emergency call box (Blue Light).
11. LEFT on the walkway with the campus commons on your left and Bell Wall on your RIGHT.
12. Continue on the walkway passing Ophelia Parrish School on your RIGHT.
13. At the end of the Commons, turn LEFT on the walkway and then immediately turn RIGHT and follow the walkway to the brick pillars.
14. Go through the pillars to Normal St.
15. LEFT and walk to the crosswalk in front of Baldwin Hall.
16. Cross Normal St and turn LEFT to S. Marion St.
17. RIGHT on S. Marion St to Washington St.
18. LEFT on Washington St to N. Franklin St.
19. At the light, cross Washington St, then LEFT crossing Franklin St. Continue on Washington St to E. Elson St.
20. RIGHT on E. Elson St. to W. Harrison St. In front of the Adair County Courthouse is a statue of Andrew Taylor Still –

founder of Osteopathic Medicine.  
Restrooms available inside the  
courthouse.

21. RIGHT on W. Harrison St. to N. Franklin St.
22. RIGHT on N. Franklin St to E. McPherson St.
23. LEFT on E. McPherson St to S. Mulanix St.
24. LEFT on S. Mulanix St to E. Harrison St.
25. LEFT on E. Harrison St to S. High St.
26. LEFT on S. High St to E. Washington St.
27. RIGHT on E. Washington St. to N. Franklin St.
28. LEFT on N. Franklin St to return back to Casey and the end of the walk.
