

# The Olympic Peninsula Explorers Volkssport Club Welcomes You to the 'Forks – Revisited' Walk

The walk is 6k and 10K (1A) and are almost entirely on pavement with very small hills or very little stair climbing. Strollers: Yes, Wheelchairs: Yes, Pets: Yes, Restroom: Yes, Pass Required: No.

Walk on city streets and parks through residential areas and retrace the locations made famous by Stephenie Meyer in her "Twilight Saga" books and movies: the Police Station, Forks High School, and Forks Hospital. Pets are permitted; owners are responsible for leash and clean-up laws

Walks start and end at the Forks (Clallam) Transit Center, 161 East E St., Forks, WA 98331. The transit center is on the corner of Fork Ave (US 101) and East E St near the high school. From Port Angeles, continue on US 101 west for 57 miles. The transit station will be on your left.

## **Walk Registration:**

Registration takes place online using the AVA Online Start Box, on <http://my.ava.org>. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

## **Walk Completion and Walk Credit:**

Once you have physically completed the Walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your Walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Free parking and restroom facilities are available at the transit center (start/end).

1. Leaving the Transit Center, walk to Forks Ave (US 101), turn **RIGHT** to E St./Forks Ave. Cross Forks Ave. at the CROSSWALK, turn **LEFT**
2. Walk to G St., turn **RIGHT** onto G St.
3. Continue on G St. to 5th, **LEFT** on 5th
4. Immediate **RIGHT** on G St. to 7th
5. **LEFT** on 7th, continue as it curves right, becomes K St.
6. **RIGHT** on 8th St. to G St., **RIGHT** on G St.
7. **LEFT** on 7th until a **RIGHT** onto F St.
8. **LEFT** on 6th one block to Bogachiel Way, turn **RIGHT** (NOTE: hospital on right), one block on Bogachiel to 5th
9. **RIGHT** on 5th Ave., **LEFT** on E St.
10. Continue on E St. to Forks Ave., use CROSSWALK to cross Forks Ave.
11. Continue to Spartan, cross Spartan, turn **LEFT** on Spartan passing Forks High School.
12. Second Stop Sign – Division (unmarked) Continue STRAIGHT AHEAD to Calawah
13. Using CROSSWALK cross Calawah. Turn **RIGHT** to Blackberry, turn **LEFT** and walk down Blackberry to Tillicum Park
14. From Parking Area turn **LEFT** crossing Tillicum Park to locomotive [used to haul logs to Port Angeles]. (Building nearby with restrooms when open.)
15. Turn **LEFT** on Forks Ave.
16. Continue to Forks Ave. to E St. and the Transit Center just beyond on your left to the FINISH!

NOTE: If you want to visit the Rainforest Art Center to view the Twilight Collection, sign up early for a slot so you can still catch the bus back later.

Be sure to log back into the OSB system ([my.ava.org](http://my.ava.org)) to “finish/complete” your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker’s Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded pdf is deducted from the user’s Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to a walker’s Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker.) Note however that the \$2 “coupon” for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.
