This walk is composed of 6 and 11km routes and will be available in 2022 only. Clovis is the county seat of Curry County. The walk passes the historic downtown area, churches, schools, city parks, and other historic buildings.

Walk Registration:

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event or contact the POC for remote registration. The directions and stamps will be available at the La Quinta Hotel at 26147 US-70E in Ruidoso during the Sun Country Striders Week of Walking April 20-25, 2022. If wishing to do the walk on the way to the events, contact the POC.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start Point:

The walk starts at Clovis-Carter Library at 701 N Main St. From US-60, turn north on Main St and continue to the library on the right which is across the street from the county courthouse. Park in the library's parking lot. Restrooms available at the library and local businesses along the route.

CLOVIS – CURRY COUNTY – 6k

Special Programs: Town Hall

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

1. With your back to the library, **LEFT** on Main St 3 ½ blocks to 4th St.
2. **LEFT** on 4th 2 blocks to Giddings St.
3. **RIGHT** on Giddings 1 block to Grand Ave.
4. **RIGHT** on Grand 2 blocks to Main St.
5. **LEFT** on Main St to the end of the street and the Santa Fe sign.
6. **RIGHT** into the parking lot and proceed thru it passing the BNSF building. Continue to the next building, then right to 1st St.
7. **LEFT** on 1st St 1 block Connelly St passing the railroad engine.
8. **RIGHT** on Connelly St 2 blocks to Grand Ave.
9. **RIGHT** on Grand 1 block to Mitchell.
10. **LEFT** on Mitchell 1 block to 4th St. Note the building on northeast corner of the intersection, the old post office built during the depression (now a church). There is a WPA mural in the building. You might check to see if the building is open.
11. **LEFT** on 4th St 6 blocks to Thornton passing the fire department and the Clovis City Hall.
12. **LEFT** on Thornton 1 block to Grand.
13. **RIGHT** on Grand 2 blocks to Davis St.
14. **LEFT** on Davis 1 block to 2nd St and Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church.
15. **RIGHT** on 2nd 1 block to Edwards St.
16. **RIGHT** on Edwards 2 blocks to 4th St.
17. **RIGHT** on 4th 1 block to Davis passing the La Casita Elementary School
18. **LEFT** on Davis 5 blocks to 9th St.
19. **RIGHT** on 9th St 6 blocks to Rencher St .
20. **RIGHT** on Rencher 2 blocks to 7th St.
21. **LEFT** on 7th 2 blocks to Mitchell St.
22. **LEFT** on Mitchell 2 blocks to 9th St.
23. **RIGHT** on 9th St 1 block to Main St.
24. **RIGHT** on Main St 1 ½ blocks returning to the library and your car. **End of 6k.**

CLOVIS – CURRY COUNTY – 11k

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

1. With your back to the library, **LEFT** on Main St 3 ½ blocks to 4th St.
2. **LEFT** on 4th 2 blocks to Giddings St.
3. **RIGHT** on Giddings 1 block to Grand Ave.
1. **RIGHT** on Grand 2 blocks to Main St.
2. **LEFT** on Main St to the end of the street and the Santa Fe sign.
3. **RIGHT** into the parking lot and proceed thru it passing the BNSF building. Continue to the next building, then right to 1st St.
4. **LEFT** on 1st St 1 block Connelly St passing the railroad engine.
5. **RIGHT** on Connelly St 2 blocks to Grand Ave.
6. **RIGHT** on Grand 1 block to Mitchell.
7. **LEFT** on Mitchell 1 block to 4th St. Note the building on northeast corner of the intersection, the old post office built during the depression (now a church). There is a WPA mural in the building. You might check to see if the building is open.
8. **LEFT** on 4th St 6 blocks to Thornton passing the fire department and the Clovis City Hall.
9. **LEFT** on Thornton 1 block to Grand.
10. **RIGHT** on Grand 2 blocks to Davis St.
11. **LEFT** on Davis 1 block to 2nd St and Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church.
12. **RIGHT** on 2nd 1 block to Edwards St.
13. **RIGHT** on Edwards 2 blocks to 4th St.
14. **LEFT** on 4th 2 blocks to Hull St passing the La Casita Elementary School.
15. **LEFT** on 4th 2 blocks to Hull St passing the La Casita Elementary School.
16. **RIGHT** on Hull St 9 blocks to 13th St.
17. **LEFT** on 13th 2 blocks to Cameo St.
18. **RIGHT** on Cameo 3-4 blocks to Purdue St passing the Freshmen Academy and Cameo Elementary School.
19. **RIGHT** on Purdue about 7 blocks to Thornton passing the Clovis high school stadium and Clovis High School.
20. **LEFT** on Thornton 1 long block to 21st St.
21. **RIGHT** on 21st 1 long block to Mitchell St and Green Acres Park.
22. **RIGHT** diagonally thru the park to Main St.
23. **CONTINUE** on Main several blocks to 14th St.
24. **RIGHT** on 14th 5 short blocks to Hinkle St.
25. **LEFT** on Hinkle 4 blocks to 10th St.
26. **LEFT** on 10th 2 blocks to Rencher St .
27. **RIGHT** on Rencher 3 blocks to 7th St.
28. **LEFT** on 7th 2 blocks to Mitchell St.
29. **LEFT** on Mitchell 3 blocks to 10th St.
30. **RIGHT** on 10th St 1 block to Main St.
31. **RIGHT** on Main St 2 ½ blocks returning to the library and your car. **End of 11k.**
