THE MANCHESTER 6K & 11K
 Brenda Weirich Memorial Walk
 An AVA Sanctioned Year-Round Event



This walk is composed of a 6km loop rated at 1A. 11km walkers will add on a 5KM loop and is rated at a 2A. Both walks take you through Manchester PA, with the 11KM walk taking you through Mt. Wolf. The trail is not suitable for wheelchairs due to the lack of cut outs on sidewalks along busy roads. The trail is suitable for strollers with large wheels but expect to have some difficulty

The walk starts and ends at the Brooks Huff Tire store, directly behind the McDonalds. Bathrooms are available at the McDonald's or Sheetz gas station directly across the street. Park off to the side of the building when out walking on the trail.

Manchester Township was originally laid out in 1742 by English Quakers and German immigrants. Settled in 1814, the village of Liverpool (now Manchester) was incorporated in 1869 in the eastern section of Manchester Township. During the Gettysburg Campaign of the American Civil War, Liverpool's merchants were raided by the 17th Virginia Cavalry.

In 1751, the 185 acres of what is now Mt Wolf Borough was purchased at a Sheriff's sale. The Wolf General Store moved to the area in 1852 by brothers William and George. George become the postmaster and train agent and the town was named after him. The business stayed in family hands until Tom Wolf resigned from the Wolf Organization in 2013 to run and become Governor of Pennsylvania

Walk Registration:

Registration takes place online using that AVA Online Start Box, on my.ava.org. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

6K and 11K Walking Directions for the Manchester Town Walk

Starting Point Location:

Brooks Huff Tire & Auto Center:

95 Sunset Drive, Manchester, PA 17345

From I-83 (north of York), take the PA-238 E exit (exit 24) towards Emigsville. Take a right off the exit and proceed to the 2nd left. Turn left on N George Street/PA-181. Go 2.4 miles to Sunset Drive (McDonald's is on the corner.) Turn right and make a right into the Brooks Huff Tire parking lot just behind McDonald's

Restrooms:

McDonalds or Sheetz near the start point.

Walking Instructions:

Abbreviations used:

ns – No Sign. There is no street sign.

C&P – Cross and/or Pass. Usage – {C&P: 1st St and 2nd St.}

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

Walk Directions:

All Walkers:

1. Start at Brooks Huff Tire. Go through McDonald's parking lot to traffic light on the SW corner of Sunset Dr & George St.
2. C&P George at crosswalk. Continue on Sunset Dr. C&P Cottage Dr.
3. Turn right on Rosedale Dr. C&P Loucks St. (Rosedale becomes Cloverlane Dr.) Walk 1 long block to T intersection at Musser St (ns).
4. Turn left on Musser. C&P Buttermint Ln. Go to end of sidewalk.

5. Turn right and C&P Musser. Continue on York St. C&P Sunset Dr, then Roosevelt Ave. Pass Union Fire Company No 1.
6. Turn right on Church St. P- Christ Lutheran Church.
7. Turn left on S Main St, staying on left side of sidewalk. C&P York St and continue on left side of N Main.
8. Pass T intersection of Main and Maple (Rte 921). Continue on N Main, C&P- Manchester St, Manchester Post Office on left, and Park St.
9. Turn right at Parkview Rd (see sign for Manchester Auto Body Shop) and C&P N Main St (see sign for Northeastern High School). Continue on Parkview Rd. C&P Haverford Circle, twice.

11K walkers: Continue at (10)

6KM walkers only:

- C&P High St, turn right, go up slight hill.
- C&P Manchester St.
- Turn left at Cooper St and go to Union St.
- Turn right onto Union, go to Maple St.
- C&P Maple to lefthand sidewalk.
- Continue at (20).

10. Turn left on High St (stop sign). P- Northeastern High School on right. (High St becomes Board Rd.) C&P Fenwick Dr.
11. P- Northeastern Middle School on right. C&P- Meeting House Rd, Becky Ln, Lynne Dr. When sidewalk ends, continue in bike lane until sidewalk resumes. When sidewalk ends again, Northeastern Regional Police Dept is on left side of road. (Restroom may be available).

12. Exit Police Dept lot. Turn right on Board Rd and immediately turn left on Riviera St. Go 1/2 block and turn right on Pebble Beach Rd. *C&P*- Payne and Lynne Dr.
13. At stop sign, *Cross* and turn right onto Torrey Pines. Go 1/2 block to stop sign. Turn left at T intersection onto Chestnut St (*ns*).
14. Go downhill, cross RR tracks, enter Mt Wolf. After crossing tracks, cross over to sidewalk on right side of road.
15. At stop sign, cross Main St and turn right on Main St. Go 1 long block, turn left onto Center St. Pass Otterbein United Methodist Church (built in 1871) on left. Pass Eagle Fire Co on right.
16. *C&P* Second St and walk to corner of Third St and Center St. St John Lutheran Church is on the corner (build in 1916). *C&P* Third, Fourth, and Fifth.
17. At corner of Center and Sixth, turn right and *C&P* Center to walk on Sixth. Go 1 block to stop sign, turn right onto Maple. (On corner is old Mt Wolf Movie Theater, now a church.) Across street is Mt Wolf Elementary School.
18. Continue on Maple. *C&P* Fifth. Mt Wolf Park is on left. *C&P* Fourth St. Mt Wolf Post Office is on corner. *C&P* Third, Second, and Main. At Main and Maple is Diehl's Funeral Home.
19. Continue on Maple St, *C&P* RR tracks. Reenter Manchester, staying on Maple. *C&P* Plane Tree Ave, Hartman (signal light here) and South St.

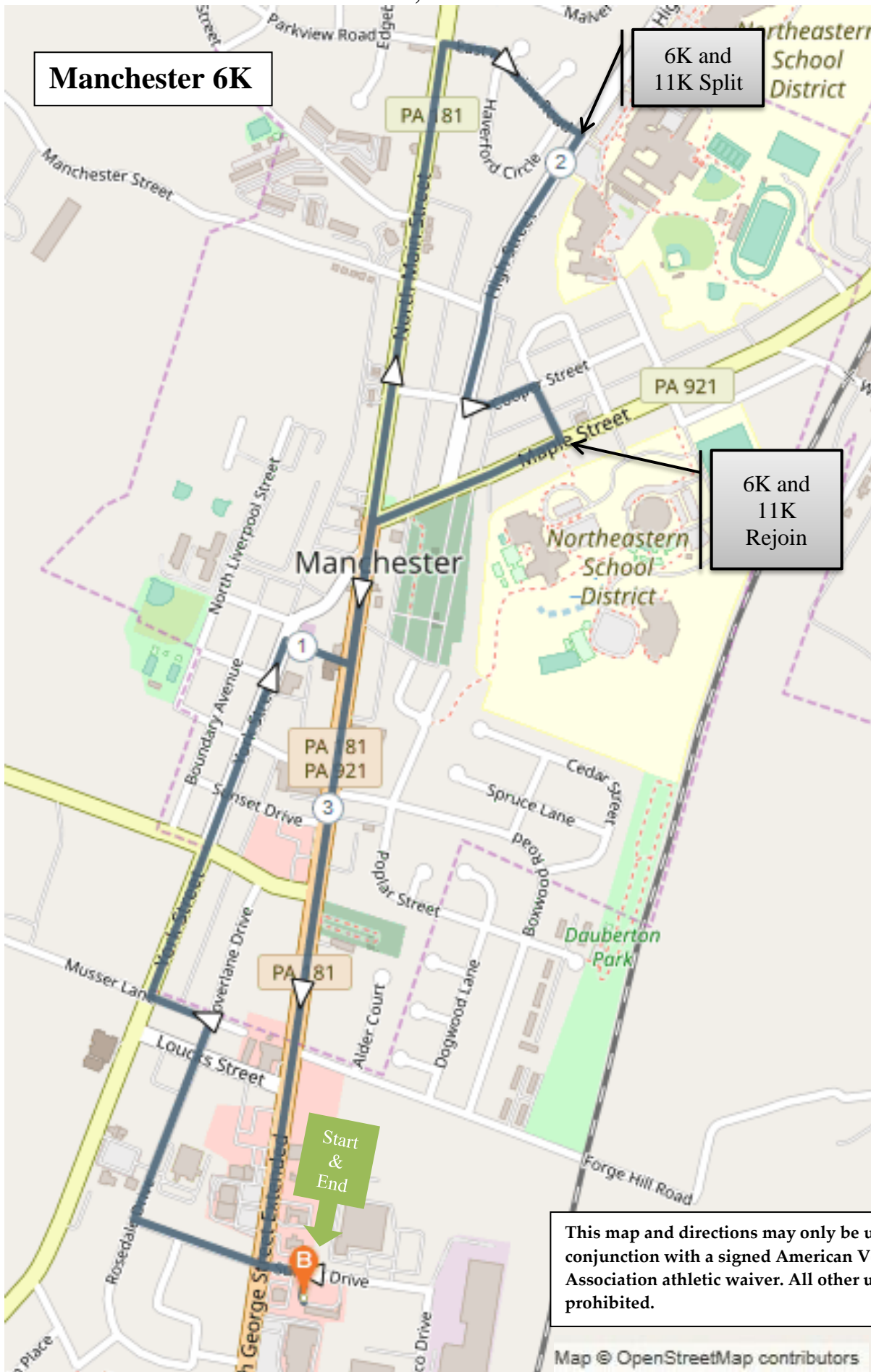
6K Rejoins Walk Here

20. Continue on Maple St. At Union St, *Cross* to sidewalk on left side. Go uphill on grass path to Union Cemetery. *Pass* cemetery and iron gateway at top of hill. Veterans Memorial (Special Program) is on left at flagpole.
21. Continue on Maple St to T- intersection of Maple and Main (traffic light, Rutters on corner).
22. Stay on lefthand sidewalk, turn left around corner, onto Main St. *Pass* Little's Funeral Home and Christ Lutheran Church on right. *Pass* Bobcat Creamery on left.
23. *C&P* Boxwood Rd. *Pass* Thorton's Chevrolet on right, Manchester Lutheran Cemetery and Love's Pizza on left.
24. *C&P* Forge Hill Rd. Beshore & Koller Ford is on right. *Pass* Sunoco, Ace Hardware, and Sheetz on left, and return through McDonald's to Start location at Brooks Huff Tire.

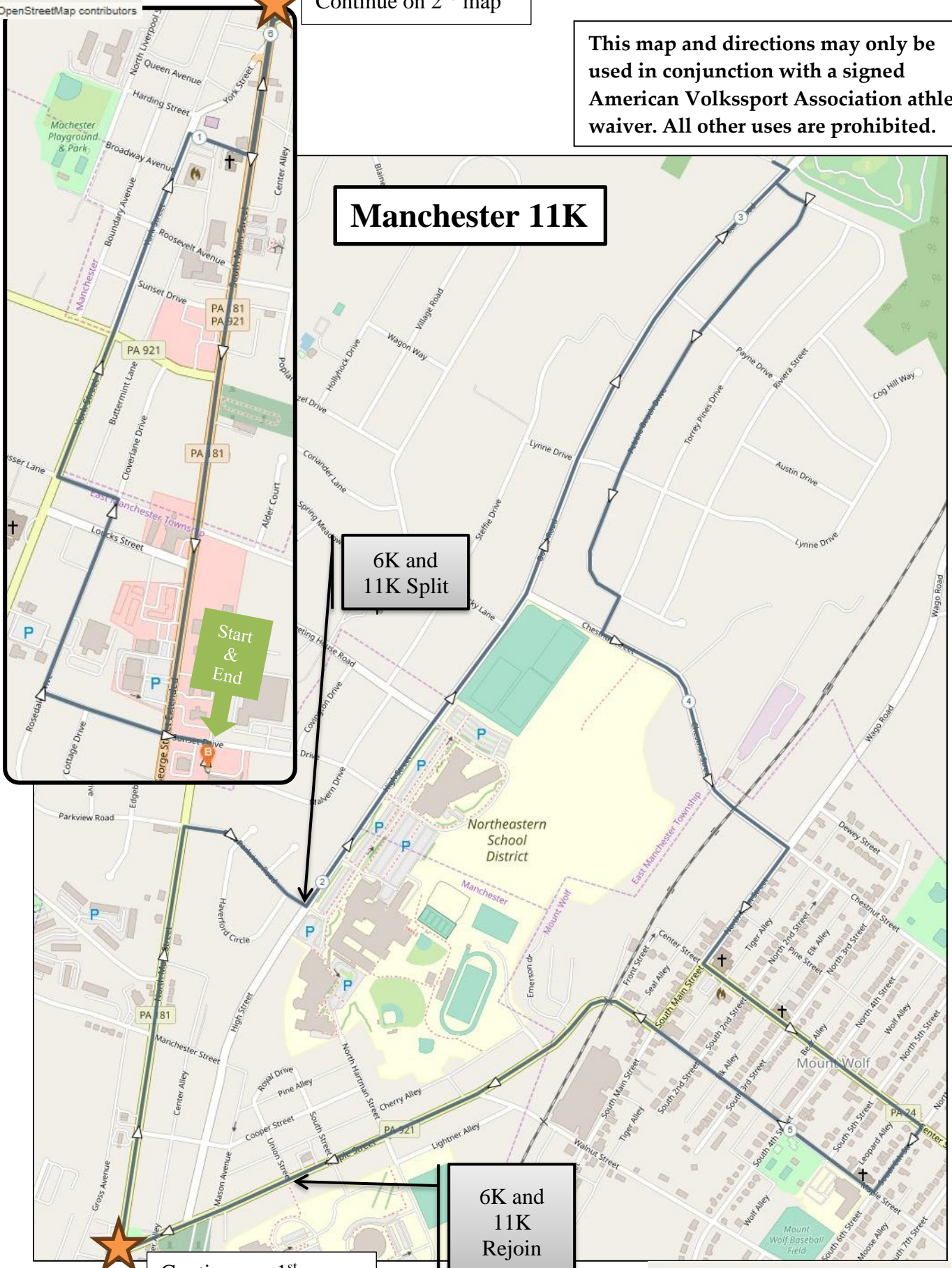
