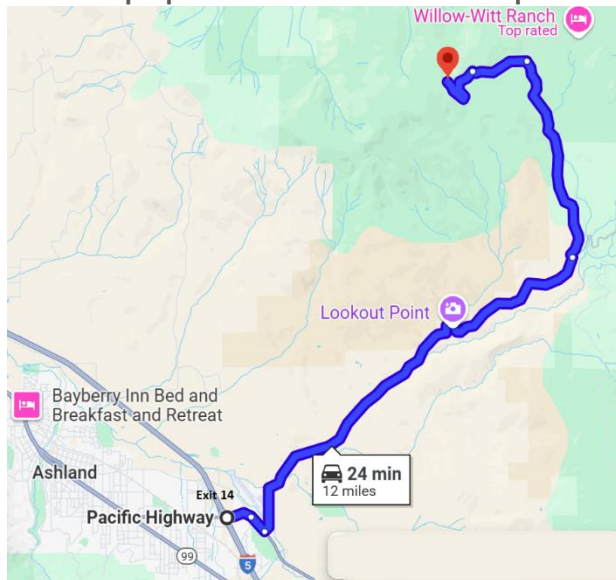
DESCRIPTION

Driving Directions: From Interstate 5, take exit 14. Turn east on Hwy 66. After .25 mile, turn left on Dead Indian Memorial Rd. Continue 6.7 miles then turn left on Shale City Rd (road #38-2E-27). Go 3 miles and turn left onto road #38-2E-9.2 drive 0.8 miles and keep straight at the 3-way fork and continue uphill 0.9 miles to the trailhead at the end of the road.

It is always advised to carry water and food while hiking. It can be hot during the summer and fall.

Please be prepared for the weather. The top of the Peak is 5,922 feet high.



Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including day the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when submitting the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

1. RIGHT after 1.7k from trailhead toward Grizzly Peak
2. STRAIGHT at 5.2k and complete short loop then return to trailhead (8k)
3. For 10k, walk 2k downhill on road to Road 38-2E-9.2 and arrange pickup
