

Instruction for Casey State Park Hike, Y-30, Rated  
NW Regional Conference  
Sponsored by: Oregon Trail State Volkssport Assn

This event is part of NW Regional Conference to be held in Ashland, OR on 16-19 June 2022 after two COVID delays. The event will be available by OSB from 12 June to 30 September.

**Hike Start Location:** Casey State Park 9.4 miles east of Shady Cove OR on OR-62.

**GPS:** 42.65977, -122.69934

**Restrooms** Available at trail parking lot.

**Driving Directions:** **Right** on Ashland St then **Right** on I-5 to Crater Lake Hw/OR-62 toward Shady Cove. From Shady Cove drive approximately 9.4 miles on OR-62 to Casey SP Recreation Area on right. Drive time approximately 1 hours.

**Hike Completion and Credit:** Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or the Regional Conference registration table (16-19 June) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the conference registration table nor signing the conference log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

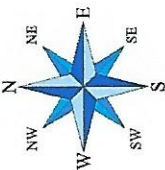

**Casey State Park**  
**5/10K, Rated 1B; Y-3022**

**L=LEFT      R=RIGHT      C=CROSS      S=STRAIGHT      RN=RETURN**

1. Facing restrooms, take the path on the **L** side of the building.
2. **L** and stay on path through parking lot.
3. Take the dirt track on the **L**.
4. **L** on first path through the trees.
5. **R** at split. **USE CAUTION** under the OR-62 bridge. The path is uneven.
  - 5a. Walk past parking lot on **L**, river on **R**.
  - 5b. At end of guardrail section, path curves **R**.
  - 5c. **S** on main path past sign for Visitor Center.
  - 5d. **C** bridge, short distance to Visitor Center.
6. **L** on first path past Visitor Center (brown bldg.) on left. No sign (1km) to kiosk.
7. **R** at kiosk to sidewalk.
8. **R** on sidewalk to path.
9. **R** on path into the woods.
  
10. **R** at the "T" to the bridge.
11. **C** bridge and pass beaver pond.
12. **L** at "T" to salmon viewing area.
13. **RN** to "T" and turn **R** at rail fence, following path to Cole M Rivers Rd.
14. **C** road and walk, facing traffic, to top of slope (2km at "No Parking" sign just before the spillway)
15. **C** road carefully to right side of spillway.
16. **L** on sidewalk and **R** onto Fish Hatchery Viewing Deck. (Camera viewing room and **restrooms** are down the first set of stairs directly under the Viewing Deck)
17. **R** to sidewalk. Notice white stencils of fish on pavement. (Some are faint or missing).
18. **R** to second set of stairs on the dam.
19. **FOLLOW** the white salmon stencils down the stairs and to the **L** of the holding tanks. (Cole M Rivers Hatchery Bldg on left {no sign} **restrooms** may be open Fri & Sat.)
20. **R** between holding tanks following salmon stencils.
21. **R** through holding tanks. -.25¢ to feed fish.
  
22. **R** at end of both rows of fish tanks, follow to end.
23. **R** and then **L** to go upstairs (3km)
24. **L** to end of diagonal parking then **C & R** carefully to grass triangle.  
**5km Walkers:** **L** to end of spillway. **L** across Cole M Rivers Rd. Skip to #33.
25. **10KM Walkers:** **R** on "Rogue River Trail" path, keeping river on your left.
26. Stay **L** on dirt path through the woods (4km at playground). Walk carefully on rocky areas, staying on main path.
27. **L** at parking lot to viewing area at William L Jess Dam.
28. **RN** to parking lot. (5km)
29. **R** on path at trail split, keeping river on right, back to Checkpoint (Checkpoint only on Sunday)
  
30. **R** to end of spillway, walking carefully. No sidewalk.
31. **R** at next road into Rivers Edge Park past large rock barrier to viewpoint. River is on the right.
32. **RN** to Cole M Rivers Rd. **C** carefully.
33. **R** along road (river on left), carefully **C** spillway's lower parking lot entrance.
34. **L** on first path, just before guardrail.
35. **R** on first path.
36. **L** onto wooden boardwalk. (**Restrooms** to right, if needed).
37. **L** at end of boardwalk.
38. **R** on path along river toward Visitor Center. (9km at visitor center - closed)
39. **STAY** on path, passing Visitor Center.
40. **C** a rusted bridge, continuing on path.
41. **C** a wooden bridge, and go under overpass.
42. **R** at restrooms to finish at parking lot.
