Driving Directions: From US2 Eastbound. Left just before bridge in Sultan. About 9 miles from Monroe. Westbound US2, right just after crossing the bridge, into the park.

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participants Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the users Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 day

Restrooms: At walk Start, Osprey Park (3K)

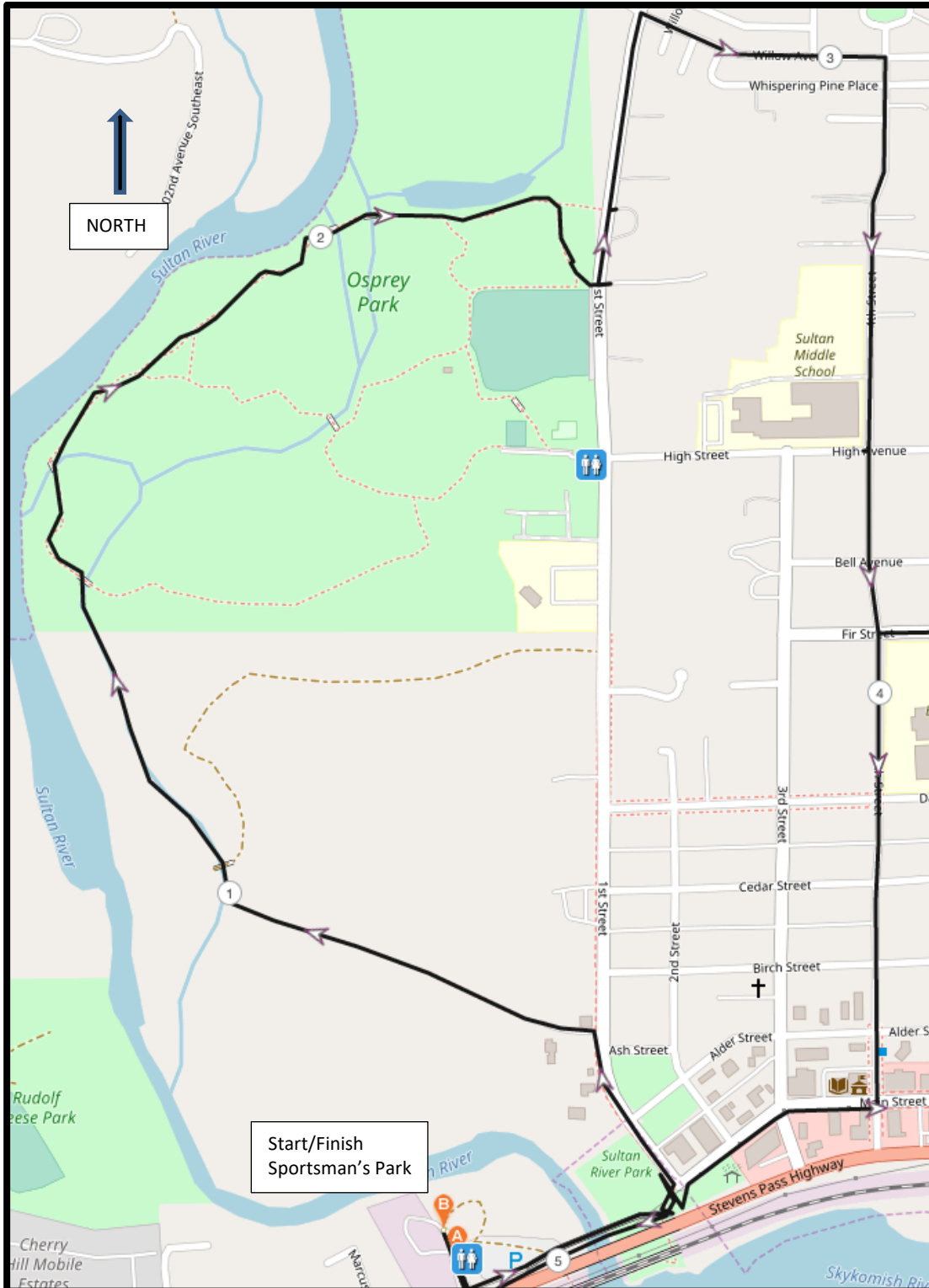

1. Exit the park, **LEFT** to the paved trail at Hwy 2.
2. **LEFT** on paved trail to cross footbridge towards town.
3. **RIGHT** on first Y to view the 13' Tall Man with Fish (*Indian Sultan John, Tribal Chief, died in 1906*).
4. Return to path, **RIGHT** downhill towards town. On right is the Veteran's Memorial (view at end of walk).
5. **LEFT** at sign for Susie's trail (street on right is Alder St) following trail towards Sultan River.
6. **RIGHT** at T, entering Osprey Park trails (not marked).
7. **STRAIGHT** after crossing bridge over the creek.
8. Slight **LEFT** at Y past E4 Big Rock sign at Sultan River.
9. **LEFT** at E3 Nature viewing sign.
10. **CONTINUE** just past Winters Creek onto Bob Knuckey Memorial Trail.
11. **RIGHT** on trail before the yellow gate and continue to trail end at kiosk map for the trail system. (2.5K)
12. **LEFT** to street. (First St, not marked here) (For Restrooms turn right, passing playground to Gray Block building and return)
13. **CROSS** and **LEFT** on First St.
14. **RIGHT** on Willow at first stop sign.
15. **RIGHT** on Fourth Street.
16. **LEFT** on Fir St one block to 5th St. (*Note the Little Library, Bird houses and home on corner*).
17. **RETURN** to 4th St on Fir St. (4K)
18. **LEFT** on 4th St to Main St.
19. **CROSS** and **RIGHT** on Main St, passing Restaurants, Bars, Shops and the City Hall at 318 Main. (*On your left is historic pink bell at Post Office including the history of the bell*)
20. Main St ends past the Park Grandstand and just beyond is the entrance to the Veteran's Memorial Park at First St.
21. **RIGHT** on First Street a short distance to end of white fencing
22. **LEFT** at the paved trail going back across the foot bridge returning to Sportsman's Park. (5.2K)

1. Exit the park, **LEFT** to the paved trail at Hwy 2.
 2. **LEFT** on paved trail to cross footbridge towards town.
 3. **RIGHT** on first Y to view the 13' Tall Man with Fish (*Indian Sultan John, Tribal Chief, died in 1906*).
 4. Return to path, **RIGHT** downhill towards town. On right is the Veteran's Memorial (view at end of walk).
 5. **LEFT** at sign for Susie's trail (street on right is Alder St) following trail towards Sultan River.
 6. **LEFT** at T, trail goes to the river. (*Rudolf Reese Park is across the Sultan River*)
 7. Circle the tree and follow trail back veering slight **LEFT** at the T (Right is Susie's Trail).
 8. **LEFT** at next Y, entering Osprey Park trails (not marked).
 9. **STRAIGHT** after crossing bridge over the creek.
 10. Slight **LEFT** at Y past E4 Big Rock sign at Sultan River.
 11. **LEFT** at E3 Nature viewing sign.
 12. **CONTINUE** just past Winters Creek onto Bob Knuckey Memorial Trail.
 13. **RIGHT** on trail before the yellow gate and continue to trail end at kiosk map for the trail system.
 14. Sharp **RIGHT** to the road tracks that circle the ball field.
 15. Sharp **LEFT** at bend in road.
 16. **RIGHT** at next bend near a maintenance shed on left and follow the trail straight ahead.
 17. **LEFT** at T, do not cross Foot Bridge. Trail ends at play area in Osprey Park.
 18. **CONTINUE** ahead on sidewalk next to covered play area to Stop Sign at First St. (*NOTE: Restrooms on your right just before Stop Sign.*)
 19. **CROSS and LEFT on First St.** (First Street sign hidden in trees) As you continue the road becomes Gohr Road.
 20. **RIGHT** on Wisteria Street.
 21. **RIGHT** on Turk.
 22. **LEFT** on Fourth Street (Amberwood Circle on the right).
 23. **RIGHT** on High Street.
 24. **LEFT** First Street.
 25. **LEFT** on Date Street. (*NOTE: Large Eagle Sculpture on left side of street*).
 26. **LEFT** on Fourth Street.
 27. **RIGHT** on Fir St. to 5th St. (*Note the Little Library, Bird houses and home on corner*).
 28. **CONTINUE** on Fir St to near the end of cul-de-sac to view 2nd Little Library on your right.
 29. Return on Fir to 8th
 30. **LEFT** on 8th and continue to Main Street.
 31. **CROSS and LEFT** on Main St to the Dutch Cup Motel and the Dutch Cup Windmill Coffee Shop. (*Around the corner and down about a block is the Sultan Bakery and Deli on Hwy 2*)
 32. Turn around and follow Main Street back passing Restaurants, Bars, Shops and the City Hall at 318 Main. (*On your left is historic pink bell at Post Office including the history of the bell*)
 33. Main St. ends past the Park Grandstand and just beyond is the entrance to the Veteran's Memorial Park at First St.
 34. **RIGHT** on First Street a short distance to end of white fencing
 35. **LEFT** at the paved trail going back across the foot bridge returning to Sportsman's Park
