This walk is composed of a 6km and a 10km routes. The walk is rated 1A and is along city sidewalks. The walk passes historic homes and buildings and the springs for which the town was named. The start/end point Spring Park. Restrooms are not available at the start point, but are available at the Visitor Center (Mon-Fri) and at various businesses along the route.

Walk Registration:

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) or contact the POC register remotely. If using the OSB, then complete the walk online as indicated below. If registering remotely, insert cards will be mailed to you. Directions and stamp will be available during the MLK weekend events Jan 12-16 from the POC.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start Point:

The walk starts at Spring Park located at the intersection of River Road and Tabernacle St. From LA-16, west on Centerville (LA-1032) to River Rd, then right on River Rd to Spring Park located on the west side of the street. Park in the parking lot off of Tabernacle St.

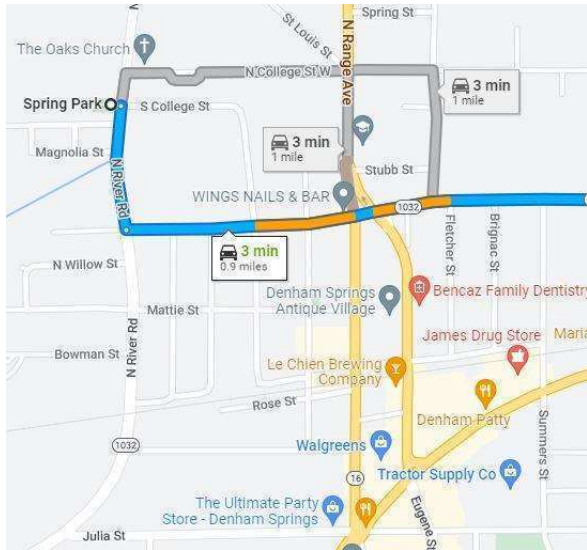

Drive to Spring Park at the intersection of River Road and Tabernacle. From LA-16 (Range Ave), west on Centerville to River Road, then right on River Rd to Tabernacle and the park on the left side of River Road.

Special Programs: Rockin' Around the Clock, Walking with America's Veterans, City Halls



1. **From the parking lot**, walk the trail down to the original springs for which the town was named. Return to the parking lot.
2. **LEFT** on River Rd a short distance to S College St.
3. **RIGHT** on S College to Mattie as College curves to the right.
4. **LEFT** on Mattie 1 block to Benton. Note: Visitor Center at Mattie and Benton.
5. **RIGHT** on Benton 1 block to Railroad.
6. **LEFT** on Railroad 1 block to Range Ave, the main street thru the historic district.
7. **CROSS and LEFT** on Range to College. Checkout Douglas Ennis's woodworking skills at the Bayou's Best Restoration & Antiques at Mattie St. Continue on Range passing the elementary school.
8. **LEFT** at N College, then immediately **ANGLE RIGHT** on Saint Louis 2 blocks to Leslie.
9. **RIGHT** on Leslie 2-3 blocks to Range.
10. **LEFT** on Range about ½ mile to the entrance to the Memorial Cemetery.
11. **LEFT** into the cemetery to the far road, then right and right to return to Range.
12. **LEFT** on Range a short distance to Cockerham (LA-1030).
13. **RIGHT** on Cockerham 1 block to Robbie.
14. **RIGHT** on Robbie 5-6 blocks to Maple (Robbie curves left and right).
15. **LEFT** on Maple 1 block to Angelican just pass St Francis Episcopal Church.
16. **RIGHT** on Angelican and continue as it curves right to White Oak.
17. **LEFT** on White Oak 1 block as it curves right to become Pine St.
18. **CONTINUE** on Pine 4 blocks to Cedar.
19. **LEFT** on Cedar 2 blocks to Centerville.
20. **LEFT** on Centerville 2+ short blocks to Summer.
21. **RIGHT** on Summer 1 block Railroad
22. **RIGHT** on Railroad 4 short blocks to Range.
23. **LEFT** on Range 1+ blocks to Sullivan.
24. **RIGHT** on Sullivan 1 block to River Road.
25. **RIGHT** on River Rd 1 block to Bowman.
26. **LEFT** on Bowman to the end, then **U-TURN** back to River Rd.
27. **LEFT** on River Rd 4 blocks to Magnolia.
28. **LEFT** on Magnolia as it curves right to Tabernacle.
29. **RIGHT** on Tabernacle and return to your car at Spring Park.

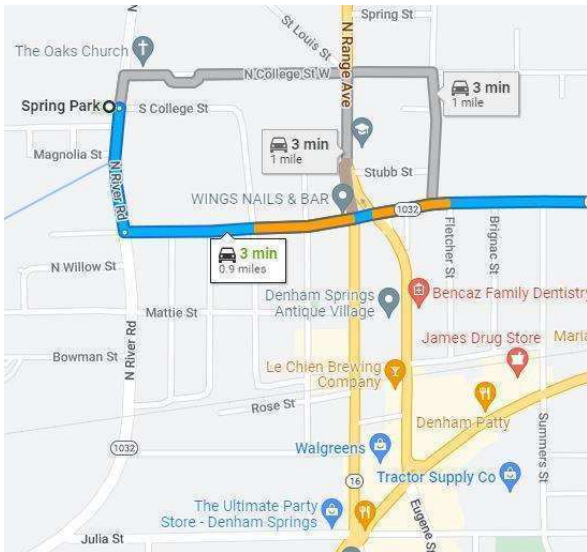

Drive to Spring Park at the intersection of River Road and Tabernacle. From LA-16 (Range Ave), west on Centerville to River Road, then right on River Rd to Tabernacle and the park on the left side of River Road.

1. **From the parking lot**, walk the trail down to the original springs for which the town was named. Return to the parking lot.
2. **LEFT** on River Rd a short distance to S College St.
3. **RIGHT** on S College to Mattie as College curves to the right.
4. **LEFT** on Mattie 1 block to Benton. Note: Visitor Center at Mattie and Benton.
5. **RIGHT** on Benton 1 block to Railroad.
6. **LEFT** on Railroad 1 block to Range Ave, the main street thru the historic district.

7. **CROSS** and **LEFT** on Range to College. Checkout Douglas Ennis's woodworking skills at the Bayou's Best Restoration & Antiques at Mattie St. Continue on Range passing the elementary school.
8. **CONTINUE** on Range about 1 mile to Cockerham passing the elementary and high schools.
9. **RIGHT** on Cockerham 1 block to Robbie.
10. **RIGHT** on Robbie 3 blocks to Sharon (Robbie curves left).
11. **RIGHT** on Sharon 1 block to Yellow Jackets Blvd.
12. **RIGHT** on Yellow Jacket a short block to Martin.
13. **LEFT** on Martin 1 block to Janmar.
14. **RIGHT** on Janmar 1 block to Range.
15. **LEFT** on Range 1 block to Leslie (on right only).
16. **RIGHT** on Leslie 3-4 blocks to River Road.
17. **LEFT** on River Rd. 1+ blocks to Tabernacle
18. **RIGHT** on Tabernacle and return to your car at Spring Park.
