This walk is composed of a 6km and a 10km routes. The walk is rated 1A and is along city sidewalks and levee trails. The walk passes and the parish courthouse and historic homes and buildings and features a trail along the levee looking across the river to the state capital. The start/end point is at a park next to the Scott United Methodist Cemetery located at the corner of Court and River Road in Port Allen. Restrooms are not available at the start point, but are available at the parish courthouse during the work week and at various businesses along the route.

Walk Registration:

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) or contact the POC register remotely. If using the OSB, then complete the walk online as indicated below. If registering remotely, insert cards will be mailed to you. Directions and stamp will be available during the MLK weekend events Jan 12-16 from the POC.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start Point:

The walk starts at a small park next to the Scott United Methodist Cemetery in Port Allen. From I-10, turn North on LA-415 toward Port Allen. Then right on Court St to its end at River Road. Right on River Road passing the Scott United Methodist Cemetery to the parking area at the city park.
