This walk is composed of 6 and 10km routes and will be available Apr 1 thru June 30, 2025. Truth or Consequences is the county seat of Sierra County. The 6k walk passes the downtown area, churches, schools, and other historic buildings. The 10k route continues on hiking trail and the Veterans Memorial Park.

Walk Registration:

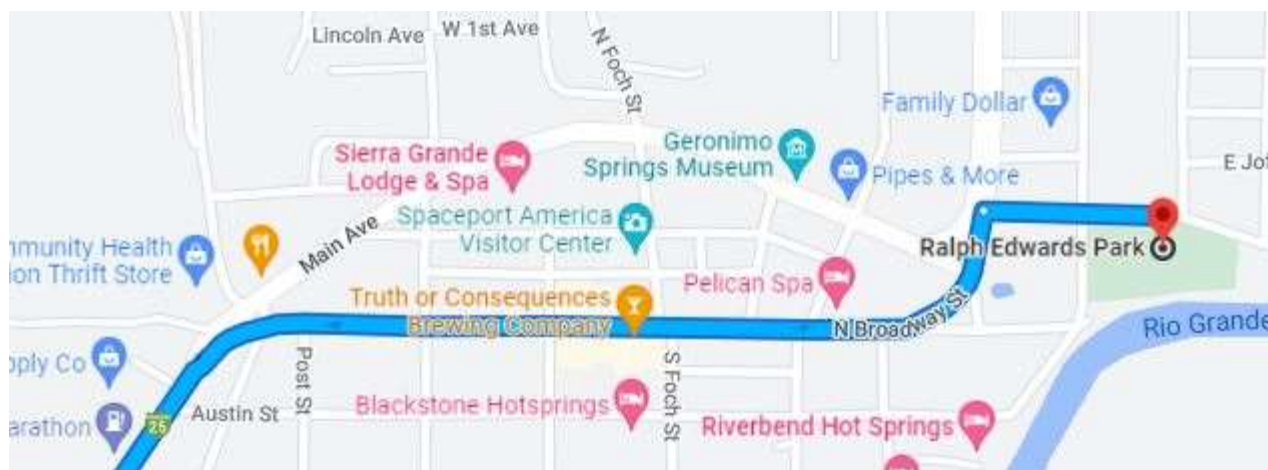
Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event or contact the POC for remote registration. The directions and stamps will be available at the AVA Convention Mon, Apr 28 thru Fri, May 2.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start Point:

The walk starts at Ralph Edwards Park (park address for city listed as 'intersection of Riverside and Cedar') on the east side. From the south on I-25, take Broadway (I-25 north, one-way) thru downtown. When I-25 starts to curve to the left, continue on I-25 to the first street on the right (Riverside). Right on Riverside and continue to the far end of the park, then turn left and left again into the parking lot. Park near the restrooms near Cedar St. Restrooms available in the park and at local businesses along the route.

TRUTH OR CONSEQUENCES – SIERRA COUNTY – 6k

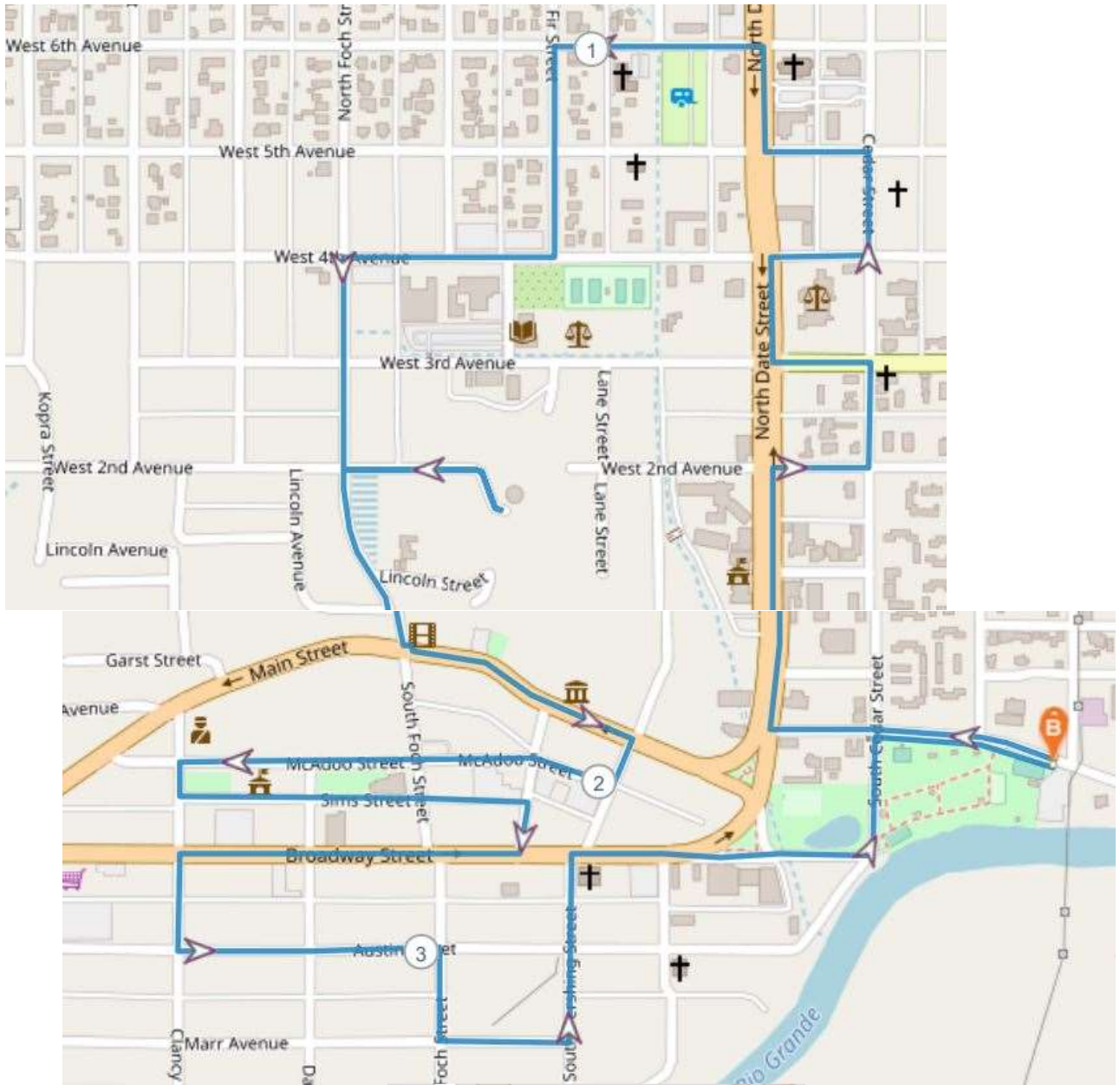
Walk starts at Ralph Edwards Park at the intersection of Riverside and Cedar streets.

Special Programs: Town Hall

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

1. From the parking lot, walk past the restrooms to Riverside Dr and turn **LEFT**. **Continue** to I-25 (Date St)
2. **RIGHT** on Date St 3 blocks to 2nd St.
3. **RIGHT** on 2nd St 1 block to Cedar.
4. **LEFT** on Cedar 1 block to 3rd St.
5. **LEFT** on 3rd 1 block to Date.
6. **RIGHT** on Date 1 block to 4th St passing the Sierra County Courthouse.
7. **RIGHT** on 4th St 1 block to Cedar.
8. **LEFT** on Cedar 1 block to 5th St.
9. **LEFT** on 5th 1 block to Date.
10. **RIGHT** on Date 1 block to 6th St.
11. **LEFT** on 6th 2 blocks to Fir St taking care when crossing Date (I-25).
12. **LEFT** on Fir 2 blocks to 4th St.
13. **RIGHT** on 4th St 3-4 blocks to Foch St.
14. **LEFT** on Foch 2 blocks to 2nd St.
15. **LEFT** on 2nd walking uphill to the T or C water tower and a nice view of T or C.
16. Return downhill to Foch St.
17. **LEFT** on Foch downhill to Main St (I-25 south, one-way). This is the start of the historic downtown area.
18. **LEFT** on Main St 2 blocks to Pershing.
19. **RIGHT** on Pershing 1 block to McAdoo.
20. **RIGHT** on McAdoo 4 blocks to Clancy St.
21. **LEFT** on Clancy a very short block to Sims.
22. **LEFT** on Sims 3 blocks to Jones.
23. **RIGHT** on Jones 1 block to Broadway.
24. **RIGHT** on Broadway 3 blocks to Clancy.
25. **LEFT** on Clancy 1 block to Austin.
26. **LEFT** on Austin 2 blocks to Foch.
27. **RIGHT** on Foch 1 block to Marr.
28. **10K ONLY: Go to 10k extension to complete the walk.**
29. **6K ONLY: LEFT** on Marr 1 block to Pershing.
30. **LEFT** on Pershing 2 blocks to Broadway.
31. **RIGHT** on Broadway 3 blocks to Cedar (going straight at the triangular intersection) and returning to the park and your car. **END of 6k walk.**

Truth or Consequences - 6k

TRUTH OR CONSEQUENCES - SIERRA COUNTY – 10k Extension

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

1. **10K ONLY: Follow the 6K directions for steps 1-27. Then continue for a hike and a visit to the Veterans Park.**
2. **RIGHT** on Marr 2 blocks to Clancy.
3. **LEFT** on Clancy 2 blocks to Charles St.
4. **LEFT** on Charles 2 blocks to Foch (end of street).
5. **RIGHT** on Foch a short distance to a bridge across a 'drainage' ditch (note private property sign next to bridge).
6. **LEFT** across the bridge. This ditch drains water from the town's hot springs. In cold weather, you can steam rising above the hot water.
7. Enter the park and walk toward the river then turn right to walk along the river. Continue to the far end of the park and look for the sign for the Carrie Tingley Hill Trail.
8. **STUDY the trail map carefully as you follow the trail to the Veterans Memorial Park.**
9. Follow the trail across a bridge to a road (Riverside). Cross the road and continue on the trail. This trail goes uphill and is lined with rocks on both sides. Pass a couple of picnic tables and continue to a dirt road.
10. Cross the road and continue toward the water tower and the Carrie Tingley Hospital for Crippled Children. Trail is no longer rock lined.
11. **CONTINUE** on trail and follow it to the Veterans Memorial Park. Check out the Statue of Liberty and the replica of the Vietnam Memorial.
12. Exit to I-25 (Broadway), then **RIGHT** on Broadway about 1/4 mile to Van Patton Ave.
13. **RIGHT** on Van Patton 2 blocks to Post.
14. **LEFT** on Post 3 blocks to Broadway.
32. **RIGHT** on Broadway 6+ blocks to Cedar St (going straight at the triangular intersection) and returning to the park and your car. **END of 10k walk.**
