Start Point: Pettigrew State Park, 2252 Lake Shore Rd. Creswell, NC 27928 (252)-797-4475

Directions: From US-64 take exit 558 – Creswell and turn **LEFT** and end of ramp. Continue until a stop sign at Main St. Turn **LEFT** on Main St (changes to Spruill Bridge Rd) for 1.9 miles to Thirty Foot Canal Rd. Turn **RIGHT** on to Thirty Foot Canal Rd for 4.5 miles to Lake Shore Rd. Turn **LEFT** on Lake Shore Rd and take the first **RIGHT** into parking lot. You can also use the brown informational signs to reach the park.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participants Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when they submit the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note however that the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

6 & 10 KM Walks

1. From the park office parking lot (restrooms) heading towards picnic area, turn **LEFT** toward family camping area – follow right loop.
2. Between campsites 6 & 7 Enter the Carriage trail **STRAIGHT AHEAD**.
3. Bear **RIGHT** to pass in front (lakeside) of Somerset Place.
4. CONTINUE **STRAIGHT AHEAD** on trail, now the Bee Tree Trail following as it turns to the right along the canal all the way to the Bee Tree Overlook.
5. After enjoying the view from the overlook, **REVERSE** your route to follow the Bee Tree Trail back to the Cemetery Trail. (Sign for Pettigrew Cemetery to the right and Somerset straight ahead.)
6. **RIGHT** onto the Cemetery Trail to the Pettigrew Family Cemetery.
7. At the Cemetery, **REVERSE** again for a short distance, but keep **RIGHT** following the wide bike trail/service road to a park service gate.
8. Pass the gate to the public road.
9. TURN **RIGHT** to the next road to the left, Lake Shore Road, SR 1123
10. **LEFT** on Lakeshore (SR1123) to the next intersection. Here is the County Line sign. To the right is Park Rd (SR 1167). To the left is a service Road toward Somerset Place.
11. **LEFT** on the service road toward Somerset House.

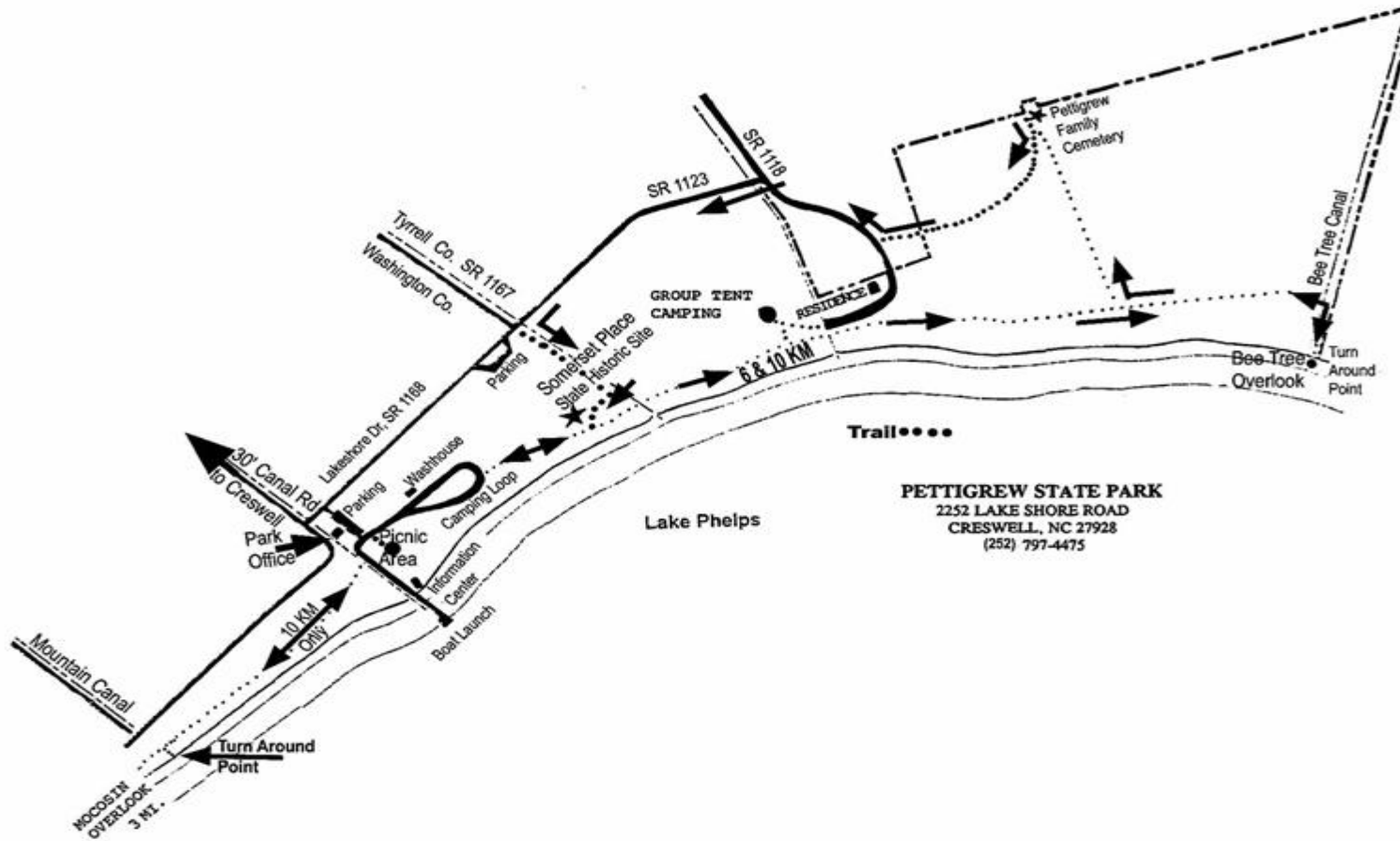
12. At Somerset pass the smaller outbuildings but do not pass the main house.
13. TURN **RIGHT** at “Visitors Center” sign down a few steps to a brick walkway going between the main house and the outbuildings. Continue on the brick walkway (restrooms available) and out through the white fence.
12. Bear **LEFT** to the Carriage Trail, then **RIGHT** to return to the parking lot (restrooms).

This is the **finish** of the **6 KM walk**.

CONTINUE 10 KM

13. Exit parking lot **RIGHT** across the boat ramp access road to the Carriage Trail.
14. Follow the Carriage Trail **STRAIGHT** passing two cleared areas to the left to the **third** clearing.
15. At the **third** clearing **REVERSE** the route and return to the **Finish** at the parking lot (restrooms).
