Getting There

From the Maine Turnpike: Take Exit 9 and follow signs to Route 1 South, Falmouth. Once you pass Walmart

on your right, turn right onto Clearwater Drive, then right onto Hat Trick Drive.

From Route 295, get off at the Bucknam Road, Exit 10 and take a left off the exit onto Route 1. Once you pass Walmart on your right, take a right onto Clearwater Drive, then right onto Hat Trick Drive.

Walk Completion and Credit

Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when they submit the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, that the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

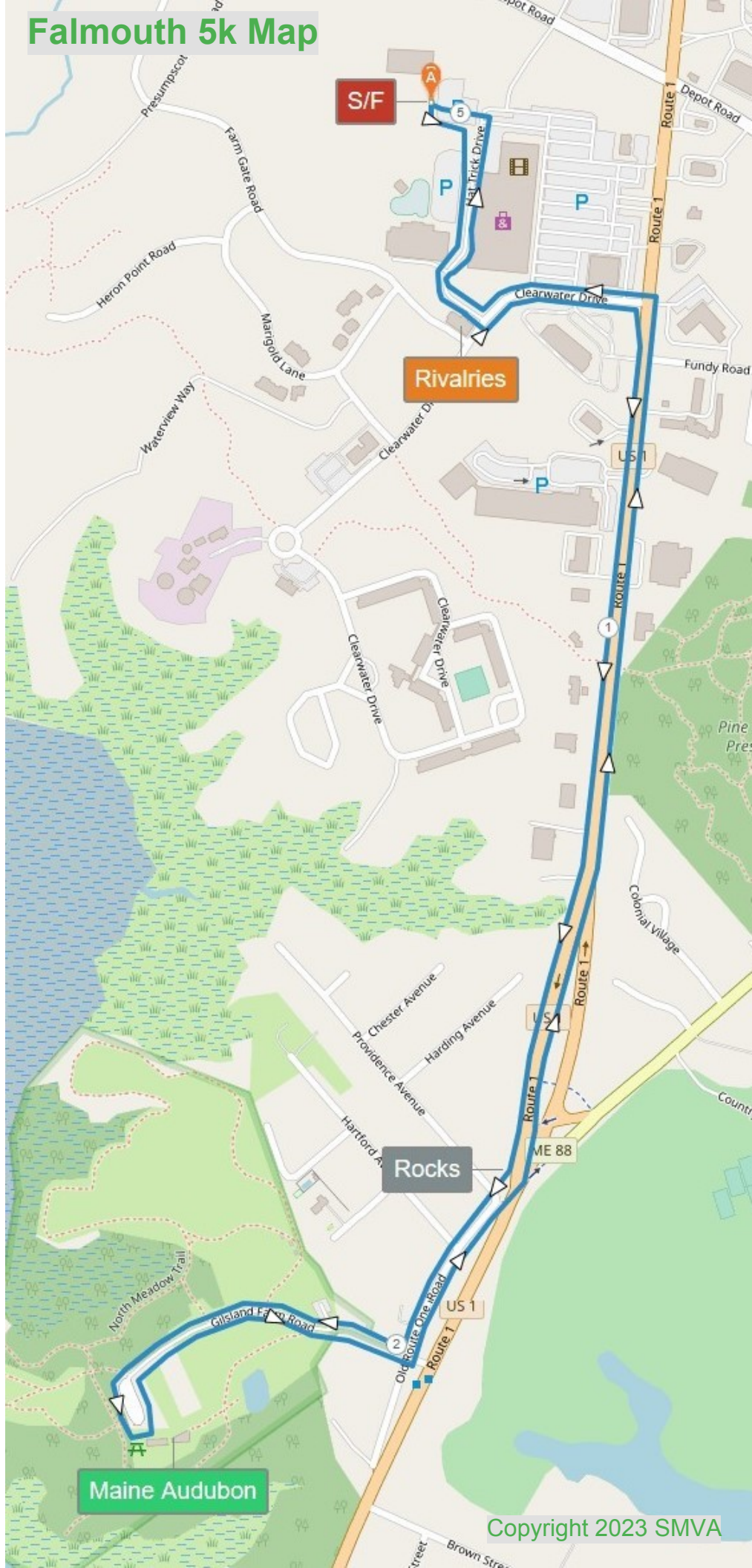
FALMOUTH WALK 5K WALK

- 1. Leaving Village Park parking lot, take a right at the first intersection. Follow the road to the left.**
- 2. Take a left at the stop sign. Family Ice will be on your right.**
- 3. Take a left at the next stop sign (do not cross the street). Cross Clearwater Drive at the crosswalk. Rivalries Restaurant will be on your right.**
- 4. Take a left once you cross Clearwater Drive. Continue on the sidewalk to Route 1.**
- 5. Turn right on Route 1 without crossing it. Stay on Route 1, passing by Waldo's/Citgo/Super Scoops.**
- 6. Continue on Route 1 and take the path to the right near the large rocks.**
- 7. At the stop sign, take a right into the driveway of ME Audubon. Follow the driveway to the end (there are no sidewalks).**
- 8. Go into the Environmental Center/Nature Store for restrooms. There are many trails on this property. Although they are not part of the official walk, check for trail maps in the Environmental Center or at www.maineaudubon.org (click on *Visit Us*, then *Gilsland Farm Audubon Center, Falmouth*).**
- 9. Follow the driveway to the end. Go into the Environmental Center/Nature Store for restrooms and light refreshments.**
- 10. Walk back down the parking lot the way you came in. At the first stop sign, take a left and continue on the sidewalk, heading north on Route 1 to Clearwater Drive.**
- 11. Take a left on Clearwater Drive, then take the first right onto Hat Trick Drive.**

**12. Follow Hat Trick Drive back to
Village Park.**

FALMOUTH WALK 10K WALK

- 1. Leaving Village Park parking lot, take a right at the first intersection. Follow the road to the left.**
- 2. Take a left at the stop sign. Family Ice will be on your right.**
- 3. Take a left at the next stop sign (do not cross the street). Cross Clearwater Drive at the crosswalk. Rivalries Restaurant will be on your right.**
- 4. Take a left once you cross Clearwater Drive. Continue on the sidewalk to Route 1.**
- 5. Turn right on Route 1 without crossing it. Stay on Route 1, passing by Waldo's/Citgo/Super Scoops.**
- 6. Continue on Route 1 and take the path to the right near the large rocks.**
- 7. At the stop sign, take a right into the driveway of ME Audubon. Follow the driveway to the end (there are no sidewalks).**
- 8. Go into the Environmental Center/Nature Store for restrooms. There are many trails on this property. Although they are not part of the official walk, check for trail maps in the Environmental Center or at www.maineaudubon.org (click on *Visit Us*, then *Gilsland Farm Audubon Center, Falmouth*).**
- 9. Return to the parking lot and go back out the way you came in.**
- 10. At the first stop sign, take a right and continue to the end of the street.**
- 11. Cross the street at the crosswalk (button will activate the lights).**
- 12. Continue right on Route 1, heading south towards the bridge to Portland. On the bridge, there is a 75-pound sculpture of a nesting osprey. This sculpture was created in 2012 by Wendy Klemperer of**

Nelson NH. The metal rebar from the old Martin's Point Bridge was used to make the nest.

13. Cross the bridge and turn around at the end of the bridge. Go back across the bridge the way you came.

18. At the end of the road, take a right at the stop sign. You will pass Falmouth Memorial Library on the opposite side of the street. Restrooms are available there when open.

14. Continue heading on Route 1. Take a right onto Bayshore Drive (no sidewalk) and walk to the end. Portland Headlight can be seen in the distance. Also visible is Fort Gorges.

19. Follow the sidewalk. When the sidewalk ends, take a right onto the paved path that will take you to the Start Point.

15. Take a left onto Reg-Roc Road. At the stop sign, take a right onto Route 1 North.

16. Cross Route 1 at the crosswalk (at Brown Street). Continue on the sidewalk to Clearwater Drive.

17. Take a left onto Clearwater Drive. Take a right onto Farm Gate Road, a residential neighborhood. Portions of this street have no sidewalk. Pass through the white farm gates. Check out the Gardens at Tidewater Farm,
