#### **Walk Registration:**

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event or contact the POC for remote registration. The directions and stamps will be available in Madison AL during the Amblin' in Alabama Veterans Holiday Weekend of Walking November 9-12, 2023. If wishing to do the walk on the way to the events, contact the POC.

#### **Walk Completion and Walk Credit:**

Once you have completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

#### **Driving Directions to Start Point:**

Start point- From I-65 N turn right onto 565 W continue onto Decatur on to US-&2 ALT W. Continue to Hwy 20 and turn right onto Wilson St NE. Turn left onto Oak St NE, turn right at 1st cross Street onto church St NE. Destination Center Village Senior Community 807 Bank St. NE, Decatur.

## 10k Directions

1. Leaving the start point at Church and Bank Streets, go straight on Church for 5 blocks. The Cook's Museum is new and popular!
2. R- on Well Street for approximately 6 blocks.
3. Curve left via Cain Street which becomes 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Ne; follow 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, which becomes 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE, (approx. 6 blocks)
4. Cross Gordon and take a L crossing 4<sup>th</sup> ST to Delano Park- (Note: Vintage Faith Church is on your left).
5. Cross 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and follow the sidewalk into Delano Park. Go through the Rose Garden, coming out of the park, cross the street and turn left on 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE.
6. R- on Johnston St. SE.
7. R- on Somerville Rd SE.
8. R- on Prospect, proceed on Prospect Drive, cross 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue at the light.
9. R- at Fourth Avenue SE
10. L- Jackson
11. Proceed on Second Avenue (**food and bathrooms!**) Pass the Princess Theater (what's playing this week?)
12. Cross Lee St with the light and take a L on Lee St., in front of the Court House (be careful!)
13. R- on Canal St.
14. R- on Davis
15. L- on Line St. NE
16. R- just before Cherry St. into Frazier Park
17. Enjoy walking through Frazier Park (very cool)
18. Cross Ferry St. NE and take a Left
19. L- on Lafayette St. NE.
20. L- on Line St.
21. R- on Cain St. NE.
22. R- on Oak St. NE for approx. 6 blocks, cross Wilson (Hwy 29) at the light. Enter Rhodes Ferry Park (bathrooms!) Walk straight to view the river (across the railroad track) at the pier. Come back across the railroad track and turn left along the river path. Follow the river on the L, take a R at the black wrought iron fence curving in front of the buildings (Line St.)
23. R- Highway 20 (Wilson)
24. L- at Oak St. crossing Hwy 20 (Wilson St)
25. Proceed on Oak St to Lafayette St. NE.
26. R- walk on the left side of Lafayette St. Approx. half a block past Bank St. On the Left, is Lafayette St. Cemetery, circa 1818. Turn around and go back to Bank St.
27. R- on Bank St.
28. Cross Church St. and continue to the Old State Bank. From the Bank, return to the Start Point.

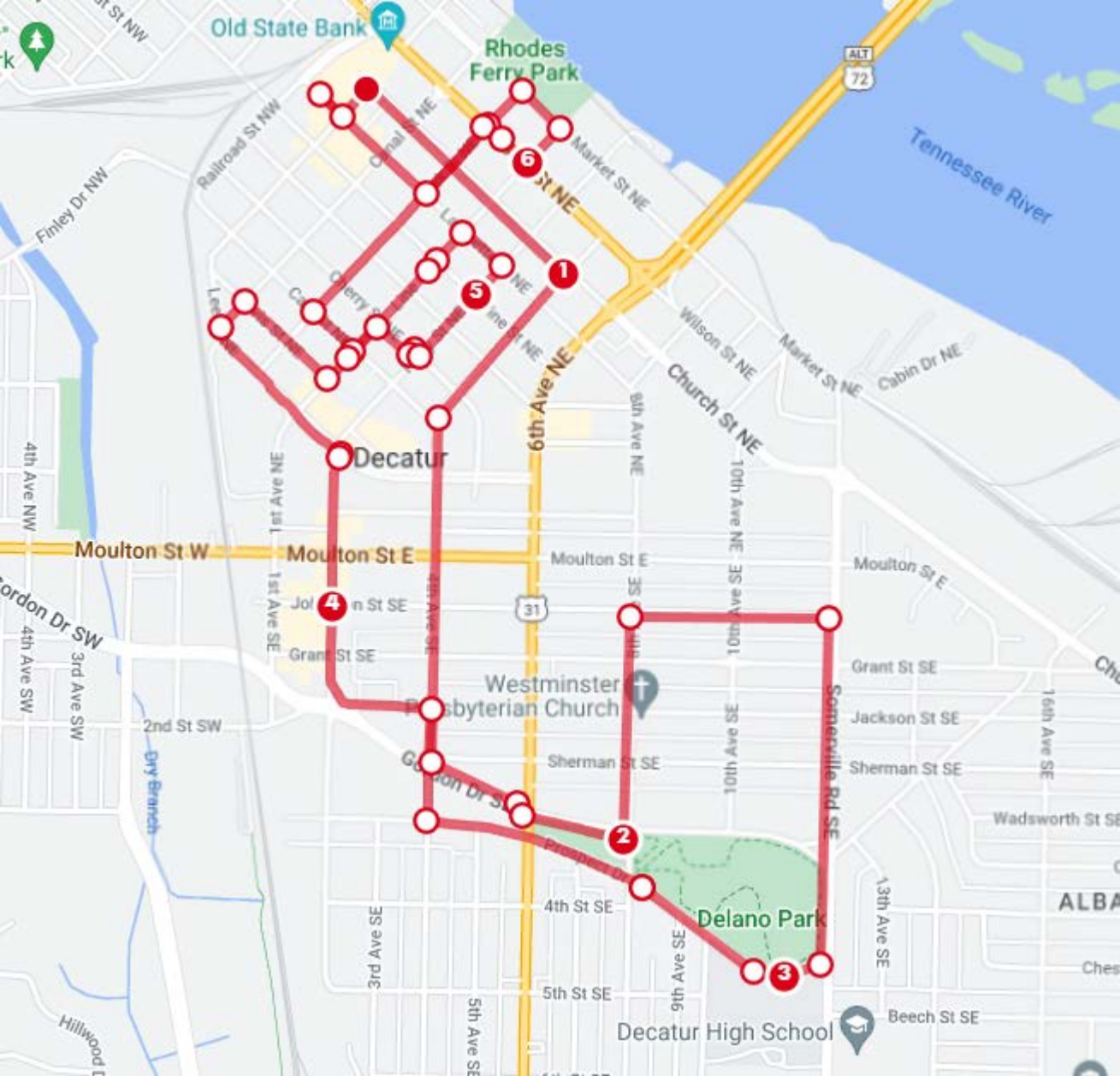

## 5k Directions

1. Leaving start point at Church and Bank Streets, go straight on Church for 5 blocks.
2. R- on Well Street for approximately 6 blocks.
3. Curve left via Cain Street which becomes 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Ne; follow 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, which becomes 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE, (approx. 6 blocks)
4. L- on Gordon Drive Se (Note: Vintage Faith Church is on your left).
5. At 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, cross Gordon Drive then cross 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and follow the sidewalk into Delano Park. Using the upper sidewalk, go through the Rose Garden, coming out of the park and turn R- on Gordon. (8<sup>th</sup> Ave SE is just ahead).
6. R- on 8<sup>th</sup> Ave SE
7. R- on Prospect, proceed on Prospect Drive, cross 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue at the light.
8. R- at Fourth Avenue SE
9. L- Jackson (after you cross the street).
10. . Proceed on Second Avenue (**food and bathrooms!**) Pass the Princess Theater (what's playing this week?)
11. L- on Lee St., in front of the Court House
12. R- on Line St. (Note, there is no sign, it is the first R at the Court House. The same road is 1st Avenue N on the L of Lee St.) As you are walking down Line, at Cherry St, there is Frazier Park. Stop and play!)
13. R- on Bank St. return to Start Point.

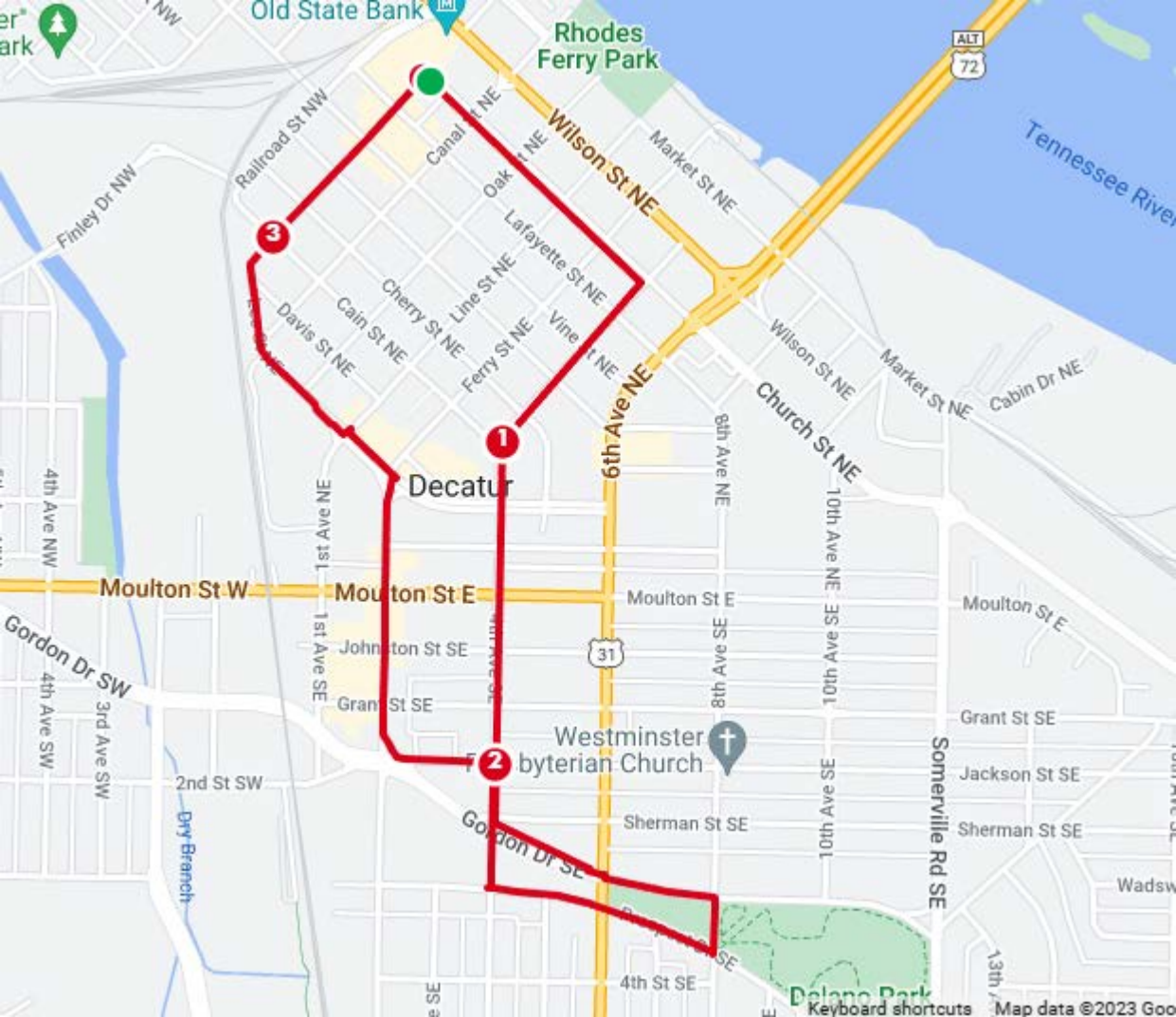
