This walk is composed of 5 and 10km routes and will be available in 2023 only. Danville and Oakville are Lawrence County. The 5k walk has 2 Options. Option 1 walks in between the Oakville Indian Mounds and The Jesse Owens Museum & Park and Option 2 stays within the Oakville Indian Mounds and accesses the land that surrounds the museum and Indian Mound. The 10k route incorporates both the Oakville Indian Mound and the Jesse Owens Museum & Park, and the land that surrounds both sites.

Walk Registration:

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event or contact the POC for remote registration. The directions and stamps will be available in Madison AL during the Alabama Amblers Veterans Holiday Weekend of Walking November 9-12, 2023. If wishing to do the walk on the way to the events, contact the POC.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start Point:

Start point - From I-65, At Exit 310, head right on the ramp for AL-157 toward Cullman / Moulton, Keep left, heading toward Moulton / West Point, Turn left onto AL-157 / AL Highway 157, Turn right onto County Road 81 / County Hwy-61 / County Hwy-81, Turn left to stay on County Road 203 / County Hwy-203 / County Hwy-61, Arrive at County Road 203 / County Hwy-203 / County Hwy-6, arrive at Jesse Owens Community Center

10 K Directions:

Park in the Jesse Owens Community Center Parking Lot. There are bathrooms there. Take a Left out of the parking lot.

R- first sidewalk and walk towards the Jesse Owens' house. Follow the path to the museum. Tour the museum and practice your long jump. After you have awarded yourself an Olympic Gold Medal, walk back to the Community Center and continue to the main road

R- Hwy 203

L- Gibson Chapel Church and walk down Hwy 187. It is a country highway with very little traffic, but you are walking on a highway shoulder- just know this and **be aware!** Continue to the Oakville Indian Mounds Entrance. This is about one mile down a country highway.

R- Entrance to the Indian Mounds Park

At the Indian Mound on your R, walk around the bottom, then up the stairs and around the top. Return to the main road

Follow the Road past the Museum on the Right

L-at the "Y", Continue Walking to a 4-Way Intersection

NOTE:

5K Walkers: Turn around at Wheeler Pounds Plaza Street Sign on the Right and go back to the Start/Finish Point

10K Walkers: Continue below.

At the 4-Way Intersection; proceed on Gravel Road on your Right, keeping the Lake on your Right

Optional 5K if you don't want to walk on the Highway

Start at the Indian Mound Museum and walk around the lake twice. Walk to the Indian Mound, around the Indian Mound, and back to the Museum. That's 5K. Drive to the Jesse Owens Museum and practice your long jump like an Olympian!

At "Y", Bear to the Left

L- at First Paved Road, continue to Gate and Turn Around

L- at Next Paved Road ("T" Junction)

L- at Next Paved Road

R- at Gate through Grassy Area and Bear Right at Fence. Merge Left to Entrance Road at End of Fence

R- at Gravel Road

L- at Next Paved Road

L-at "Y"

L- at "Y"

At "Y", note Footbridge Straight Ahead; Cross Footbridge and Turn Left at Gravel Road

R- at Paved Road

R- at "Y"

R- at Sidewalk Just Prior to 4-Way Intersection

R- at Gravel Path

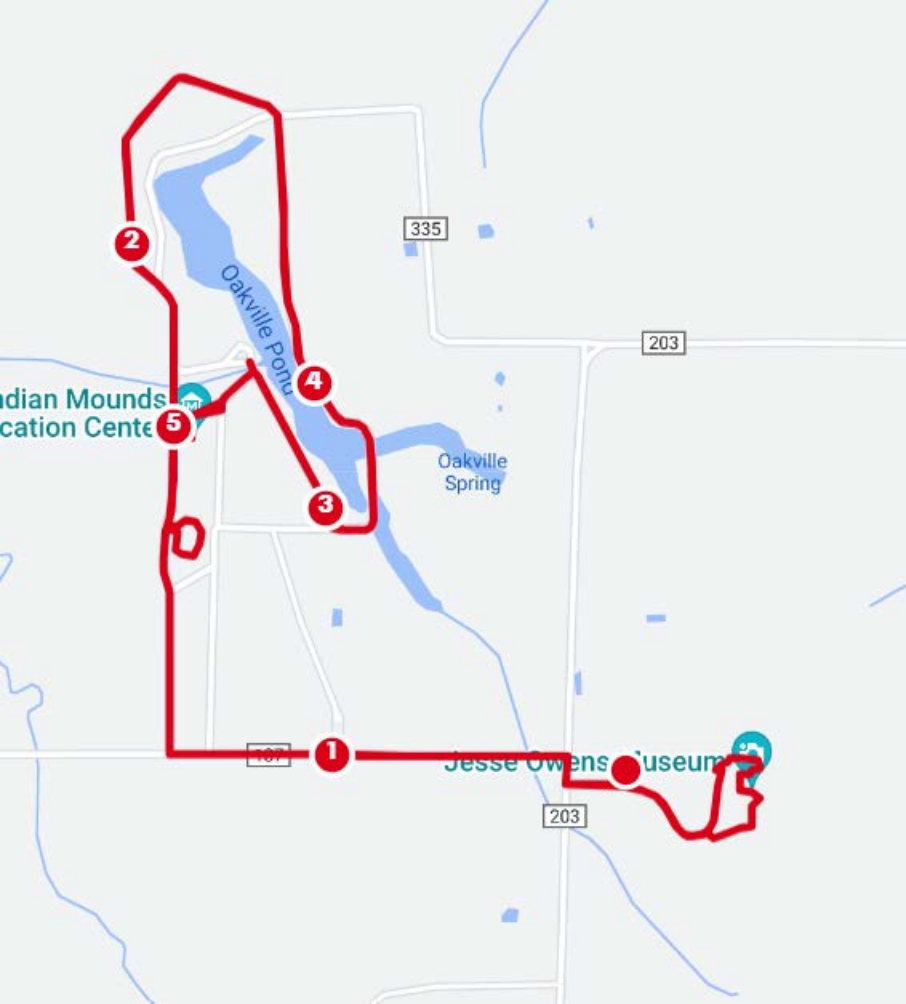
R- at Footbridge

R- at Grey Building on your Right and follow Gravel Path to the Paved Road

L- at Main Road (Park Entrance) and Return to Start/Finish at Jesse Owens Community Center

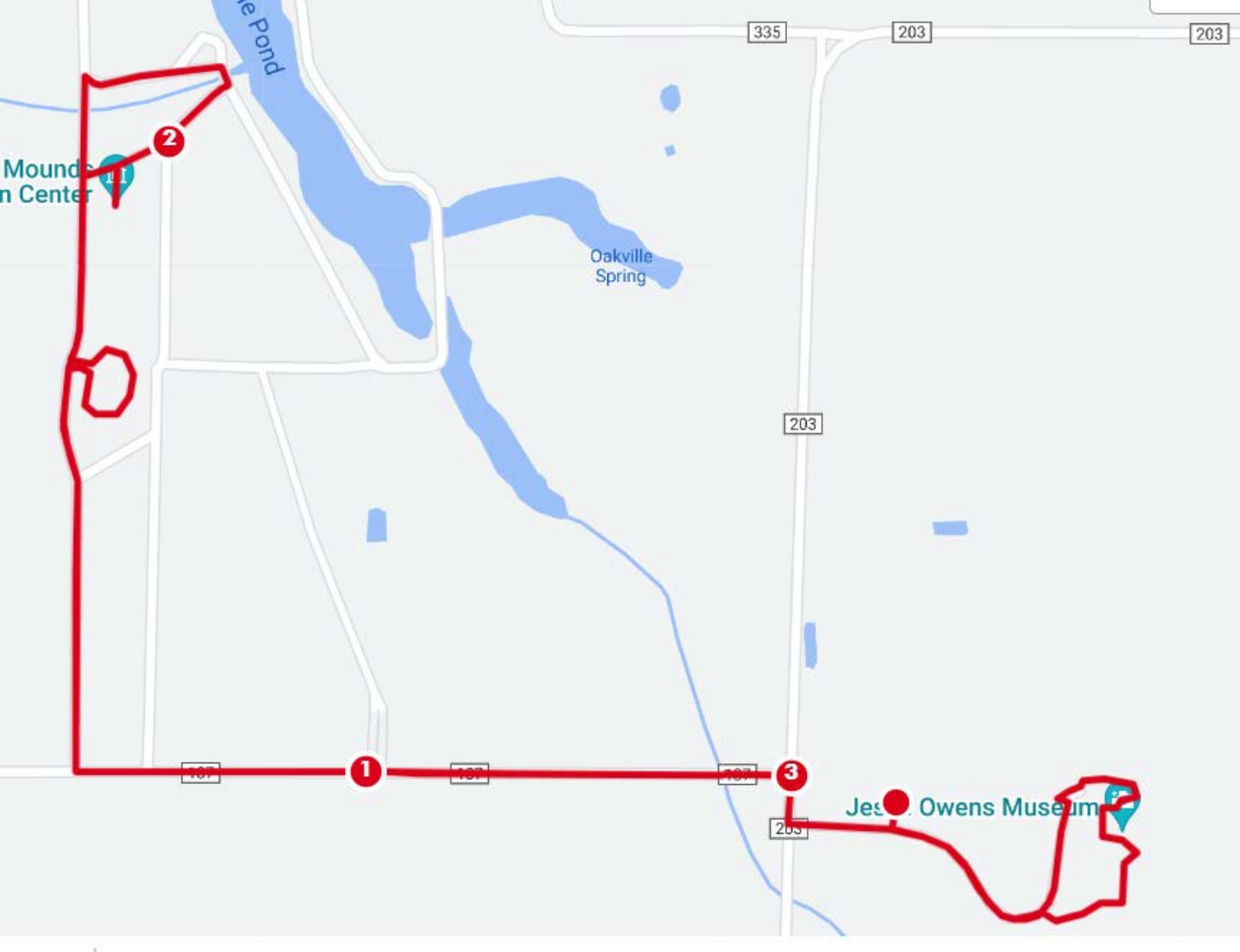
