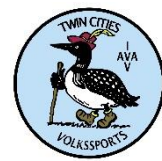




Little Canada Walk 5 & 10 km

Walk is on sidewalks and trails through Pioneer, Spooner, and Gervais Mill parks, St John's Cemetery (Minnesota's 2nd oldest), and the Waterworks Right of Way Trail.

The detailed location of, and driving directions to, the event starting point are included in the event directions, downloaded from the Online Start Box (OSB). The POC does not provide event directions nor accept alternate payment methods.

COMMENTS: French-Canadian Benjamin Gervais (1792-1896) was one of the founders of Saint Paul MN. He donated land for the chapel of Saint Paul which then became the name for the new city. He later moved to the present Little Canada and built the first independent grist mill in Minnesota. Along the walk route you can see one of his millstones on display at Gervais Mill Park as well as his gravesite at St John's cemetery. The cemetery, established in 1852, is Minnesota's second oldest. The settlement that followed Gervais grew to become the city of Little Canada.

The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walkers Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the users Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a walkers Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker. Note however that the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days. Also note that an event registration expires after 30 days, but if your registrations lapses, you may re-register without cost.

1. From the trail intersection between the parking lot and buildings, walk between the soccer and ball fields
2. **Circle** the park clockwise to the tennis courts
3. **Left** on the trail between the tennis courts and the playground
4. **Left** on sidewalk along Centerville Rd crossing Labore and Eli Roads
5. **Left** at the Y onto the asphalt trail into Spooner Park
6. **Take the First Left**
7. After passing the picnic shelter, tennis courts, and second parking lot all on your left, turn **Left** at the T
8. **Straight** on trail crossing Noel Dr (unmarked street with water tower on the right) to and enter Gervais Mill Park

The Gervais Mill millstone is along the sidewalk to your right near the parking lot

9. **Keep to the left** around the park and **Left** onto the unpaved trail just before the pond
10. **Continue** on the trail to and through the parking lot to the paved trail always keeping the ponds on your right
11. Pass the pier on your right and turn **Right** at the T

5km keep to the right across the bridge to the next trail intersection. Keep Left to cross Noel Dr and return on the same trail you entered the park on. Make no turns on this trail until you reach

Centerville Rd. Then turn right to return to the start point.

10 km Continued:

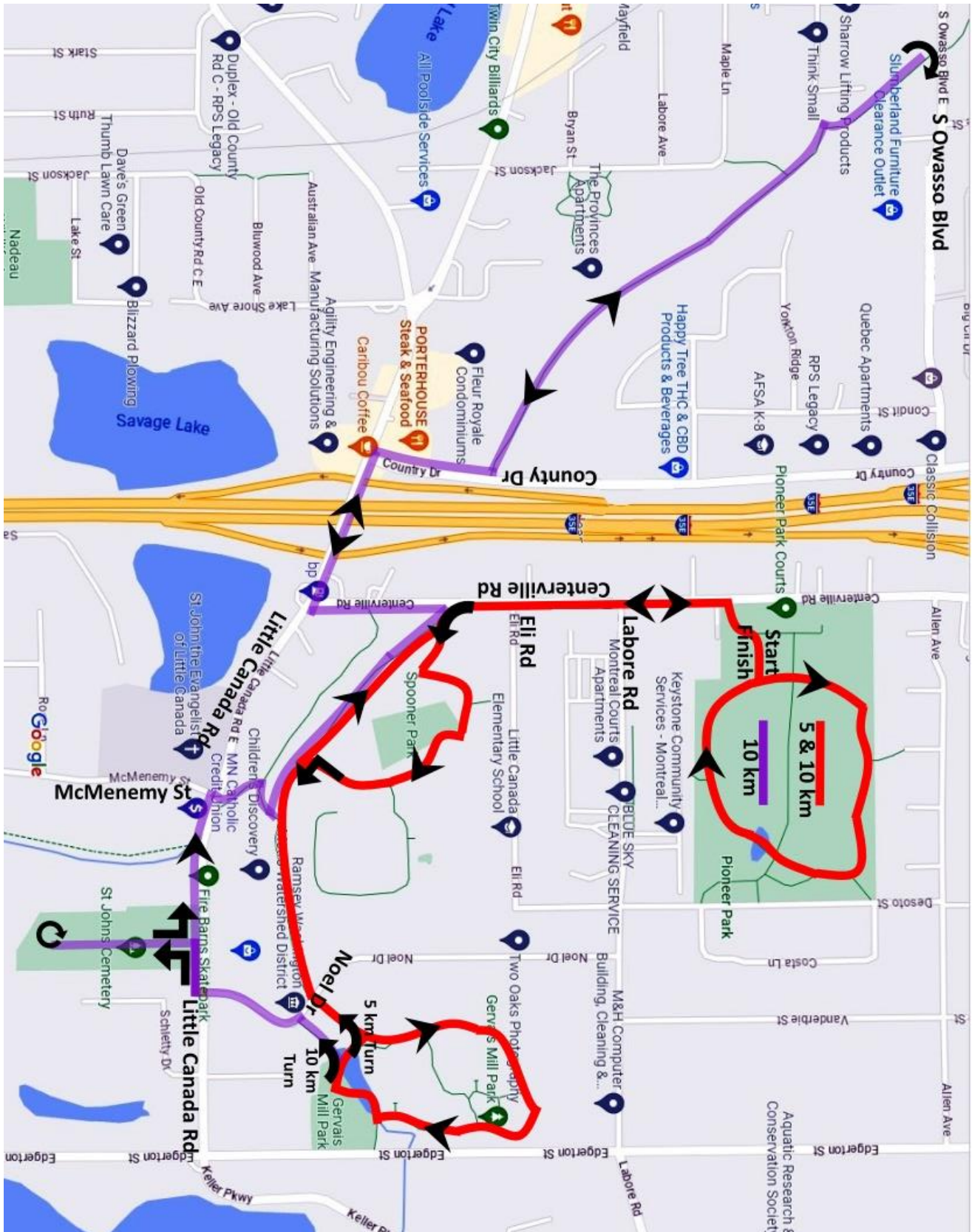
12. **Left** at the Y to reach and cross Noel Dr to the crosswalk at Little Canada Rd
13. **Cross** Little Canada Rd and turn **Right**
14. **Left** into St Johns Cemetery following path to the end and returning to Little Canada Rd
15. **Left** on sidewalk with Little Canada Rd on your right to McMenemy St
16. **Cross** Little Canada Rd at the crosswalk and onto the trail via the entrance to the right of the fence
17. **Left** at the T to Centerville Rd
18. **Left** on Centerville Rd
19. **Right** at Little Canada Rd crossing the freeway and Country Dr
20. **Right** on sidewalk with Country Dr on your right
21. **Left** onto trail through water utility pipeline corridor to the road (S Owasso Blvd E)
22. **Turn around** and return to Country Dr
23. **Right** to Little Canada Rd
24. **Left** crossing Country Dr and the freeway
25. **Cross** Centerville Rd and turn **Left** returning to the start point
