This walk is composed of 5 and 10km routes and will be available in 2024 and 2025 only. Cullman is a city in and the county seat of Cullman County, Alabama, United States. Known for its culture and charm, Cullman County shares a strong German heritage and with a sense of history and identity comes a strong work pioneer spirit that is evident in the people. This route encompasses downtown and quaint streets with restaurants, coffee, and ice cream (yum!) with milage made on city streets and hilly neighborhoods. If you walk it in October, you will walk right into Oktoberfest where you can find the best beer and brats in Alabama! Driving Directions to Start Point:

Start point is the Parking lot on the corner of 6th Street and 2nd Avenue SW/US HWY 31 next to the Cullman County Courthouse. Address for the Courthouse is 500 2nd Avenue SW, Cullman AL 35055

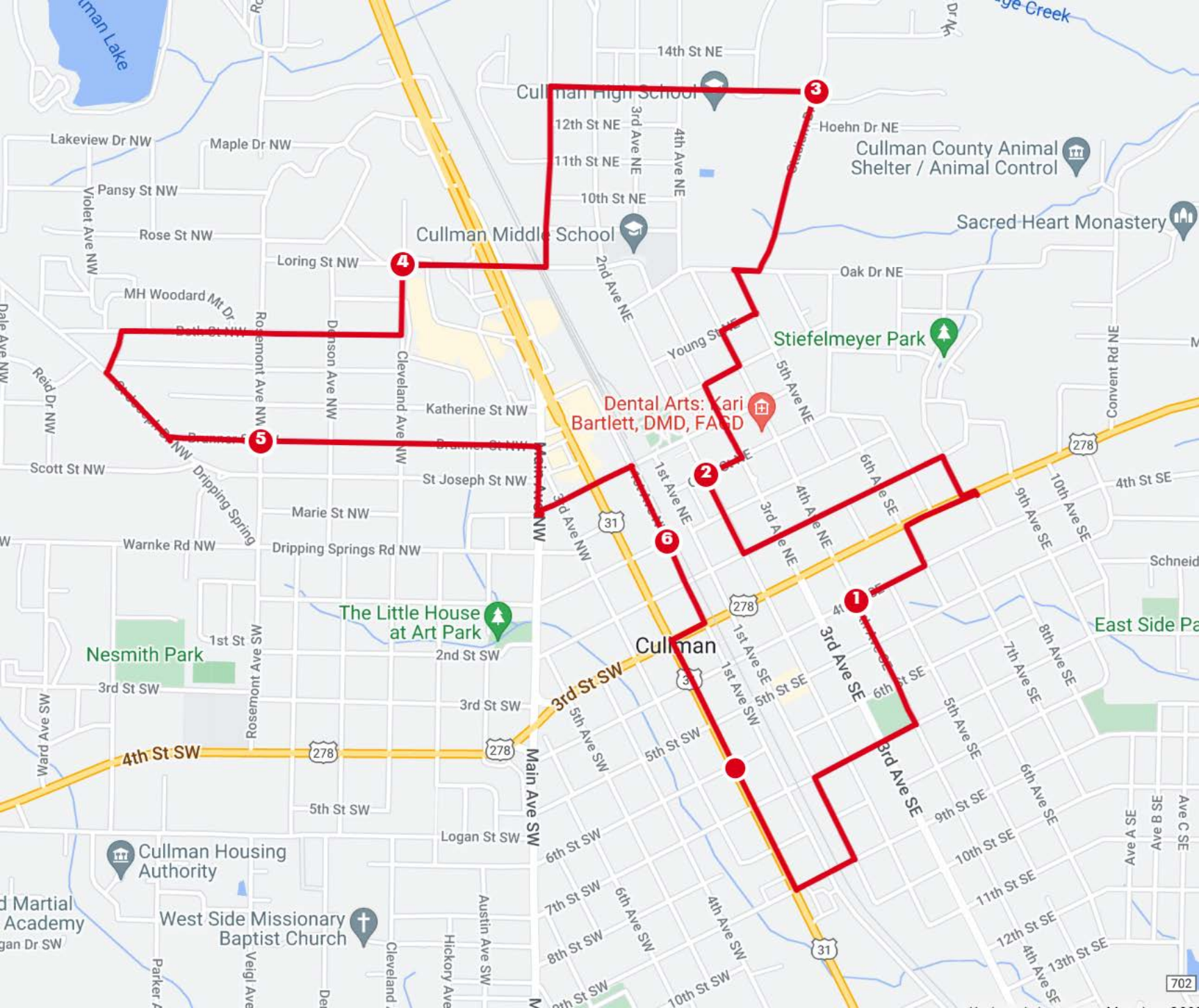
10K Directions

1. Left out of the Parking lot (Parking lot is to your back) on to 2nd Avenue SW
2. Left on 9th Street (you have walked 3 blocks)
3. Left on 1st Avenue SE
4. Right 7th Street SW
5. Left 4th Avenue SE
6. Right on 4th Street SE
7. Left on 6th Avenue SE
8. Right on 3rd Street to 8th Avenue, but to get there...
9. You are about to cross Hwy 278 and you need to WALK CAREFULLY!! 8th Avenue is waiting for you on the other side of Hwy 278. PLEASE BE CAREFUL and use the sidewalk and look BOTH ways! Continue straight on to 8th Avenue.
10. Left on 2nd Street NE– (travel for 6 blocks)
11. Right on 2nd Avenue (Sacred Heart of Jesus Church on the corner) as of 12 Feb the street sign was on top of a construction detour sign- so they might change it to say 2nd Ave NE or SE
12. Right on Clark Street NE (Cullman County Library on the corner- bathrooms)
13. Left on 3rd Avenue NE passing Cullman City Hall on the left (special program for City/Town Halls and Walking w American's Veterans)
14. Right on Elizabeth Street (Special Program Elizabeths are AWESOME)
15. Left on 4th Avenue NE
16. Right on Young Street NE
17. Left on 5th Avenue NE
18. At the end of 5th Avenue NE, cross Oak Drive NE and dead end at Cullman High School. take a Right. You will walk around the High School (Paf for the Course)
19. Left around Stadium Drive NE, you are now walking around Oliver Woodward Stadium and Cullman HS
20. Left on 13th Street NE
21. Left on Main Avenue NW
22. Walking 5 blocks (on the left) take a right on 8th Street NW. You will cross the Railroad tracks.
23. You will now cross 2nd Avenue NW/Hwy 31 with the light and crosswalk. This is still dangerous. Pray to your all our supernatural people and be careful. As you are crossing 2nd Avenue NW/Hwy 31, 8th Street NW turns into to Loring Street NW. Stay on the Left and use the parking lot of the Pet Smart.
24. Left on Cleveland Avenue NW, walk on the street, not the parking lot because if you are in the parking lot you will miss your...
25. Right on Beth Street. This is a hilly neighborhood- a warning for you whiners.
26. Left on Ann Drive
27. Left on St. Joseph Drive NW. There are two choices here. Walk in the grass to Brunner Street and take a left To walk on a sidewalk, cross the street, take a left, look for the If you are walking on the sidewalk, A.A. Fellowship Hall on your left and Brunner Street, cross St.

- Joseph Drive NW again to be on Brunner.
28. Walk 5 blocks and take a Right on Main Avenue NW
 29. Left on Arnold Street NW. Arnold crosses 2nd Avenue SW/Hwy 31, but this intersection is not as bad as the first one. There is a Farmer's Market on the corner.
 30. Right on 1st Avenue SW
 31. Right on 3rd Street SW/Hwy 278
 32. Left on 2nd Avenue SW and walk back to the start point at the Cullman County Courthouse Parking Lot. Check out the mural across the street!

5K Directions – do not eat before this walk because you will want to eat **throughout** this walk!

1. Left out of the Parking lot (Parking lot is to your back) on to 2nd Avenue SW
2. Left on 9th Street (you have walked 3 blocks)
3. LEFT on 1st Avenue SW.
4. RIGHT on Arnold
5. Cross the Railroad and take RIGHT 1st Avenue NE. The Cullman Farmer's Market is on the corner. You will pass shops, an Angel Wing mural, Flavors Bakery for ice cream and treats, The Duchess for twist donuts, and tons coffee shops. Check out the Cullman Banana Supply "Use Jazz Feeds" Mural
6. LEFT on 5th Street. There is no sign, but the Buzzy Bee Café on the corner. Stop and get a bologna biscuit as a snack!
7. LEFT on 2nd Avenue SE. More cool shops and the Cullman County Museum. There's a time capsule in front of the museum. You probably need a break from eating, so go in and learn something!
8. RIGHT on Arnold
9. RIGHT on 3rd Avenue. You will pass the public library – thank you Andrew Carnegie for creating a hallowed institution of books and clean restrooms
10. RIGHT on 1st Street SE
11. LEFT 1st Avenue
12. Between 3rd Street SE and 4th Street SE on the right side of the street is a pedestrian bridge. The pedestrian bridge is across from Berkeley Bob's Coffee House. Walk across this bridge to cross the railroad tracks.
13. Take a LEFT to get to 4th Street SE. If you miss the bridge, take a RIGHT on 4th Street SE. Your goal is to be on the corner of 4th Street SE and 1st Avenue SW.
14. Cross 4th Street SE and take a RIGHT.
15. You will pass the Downtown Grill-home of the Fried Banana Pudding.
16. LEFT 2nd Avenue SW. Check out the Cullman in the 1880's Mural across the street.
17. Return to your car at the Start Point

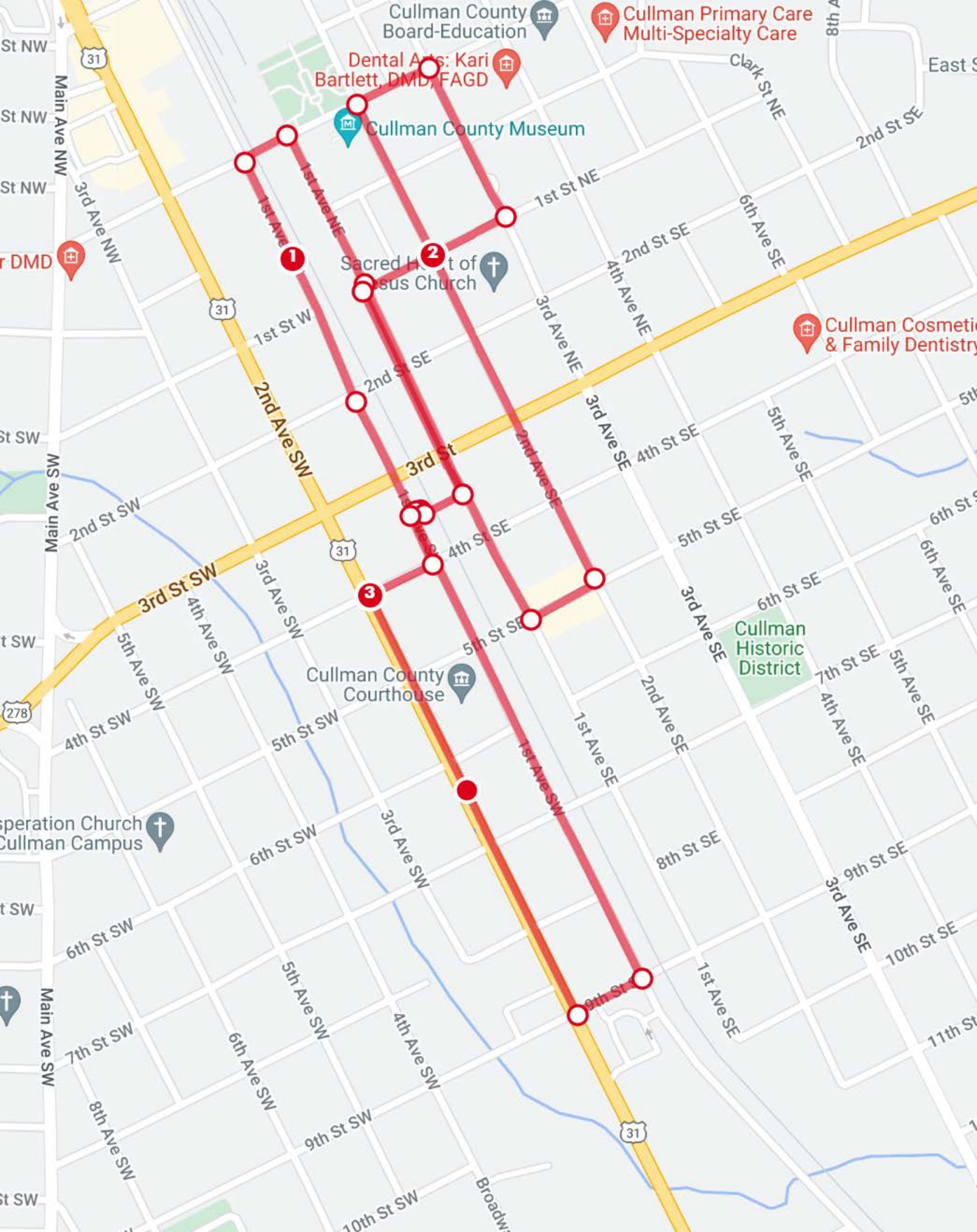
