Walk Registration:

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event or contact the POC for remote registration. The directions and stamps will be available in Madison AL during the Amblin' in Alabama Veterans Holiday Weekend of Walking November 9-12, 2023. If wishing to do the walk on the way to the events, contact the POC.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start Point:

Start point- Tuscumbia Parks and Recreation, 601 E Commons, Tuscumbia AL. From I-65, Exit 340A, head right on the ramp for AL-20 West toward Decatur. Keep right to stay on US-72 W Alt / AL-20 / Wilson St NE, Continue on US-72 W / AL-2 / Highway 72 E, Turn right onto Woodmont Dr, Road name changes to S Dickson St, Turn left onto E 6th S, Road name changes to W 6th St, Turn right onto S Hook St, Road name changes to N Hook St, left onto W 2nd St, Road name changes to Blackwell Rd, Turn right onto W 1st St, Arrive at W 1st St

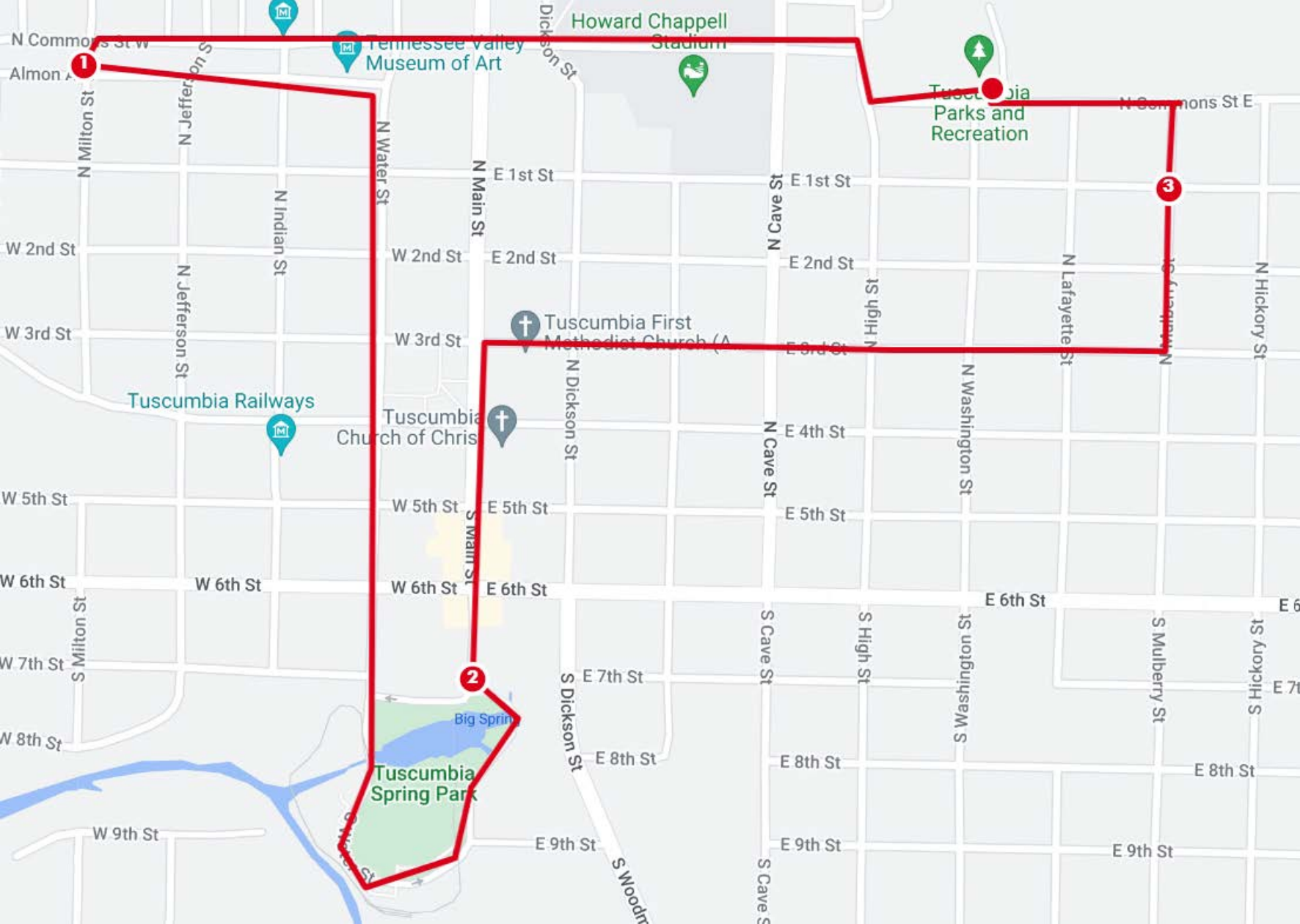
10k Directions

1. R- N Commons St E (no sidewalk) Walk against traffic in the grass until the stop sign.
2. This stop sign is at a T intersection, take a R on to the sidewalk. This is N High Street, there is no sign.
3. L- N Commons Street E, using the crosswalk. Continue on N Commons where you will pass many points of interest- Historic Calvary Baptist Church, Winston Home, Deshler H.S, Alabama Institute for the Deaf and Blind, Yellow Fever Epidemic Plaque and Helen Keller's Birthplace. There are Veteran's Biographical Flags. You will be walking for 5 blocks. **BE CAUTIOUS- THE CEMENT IS UNEVEN.** Continue on N Commons Street E to Milton Street.
4. L- N Milton Street (one block only over a green spaced boulevard)
5. L- Almon Avenue (no sign). Will pass the Nieman-Moss home on the Right, The Tennessee Valley Museum of Art on the left and the Almon House at the corner of Almon and N Water.
6. R- N Water Street all the way to and through Spring Park (**bathrooms and BBQ restaurant**). Walking 7 blocks, you will pass the Colbert County Courthouse on your left and The Tusculumbia Railways Museum on your Right. **BE CAUTIOUS** – The sidewalk ends in a 5 foot drop. There is caution tape all over the area, but **PLEASE** walk in to the road or in to the grass of the museum. Take your time in the Park walking counter clockwise viewing the railroad, the covered bridge, waterfall, fountain, statute, and the Princess Im Me Ah Key plaque. Exit the park on Water Street. This is a huge hill.
7. R S Main Street passing the Colbert County Courthouse, war monuments, and a monument to law enforcement (Walk with America's Veterans)
8. R- E 3rd Street. St. John's Episcopal Church on the corner at Lafayette
9. R- N Dixon Street
10. L- E 6th Street
11. R- S Cave Street
12. L- E 7th Street
13. L- E Washington Street
14. R- E 5th Street
15. L- S King Avenue
16. L- E 3rd Street
17. R- N Dixon Street
18. R- E Second Street
19. R- N Cave Street
20. L- E 4th Street
21. L- N Mulberry Street
22. L- N Common Street and return to the Starting Point

5K Directions

1. R- N Commons St E (no sidewalk). Walk against traffic in the grass until the stop sign.
- 2 This stop sign is at a T intersection, take a R on to the sidewalk. This is N High Street, there is no sign.
3. L- N Commons Street E, using the crosswalk. Continue on N Commons where you will pass many points of interest- Historic Calvary Baptist Church, Winston Home, Deshler H.S, Alabama Institute for the Deaf and Blind, Yellow Fever Epidemic Plaque and Helen Keller's Birthplace. There are Veteran's Biographical Flags. You will be walking for 5 blocks. **BE CAUTIOUS- THE CEMENT IS UNEVEN.** Continue on N Commons Street E to Milton Street.
