START POINT: Colonel Sanders Shelter, Clear Creek Park, Shelbyville, KY

Hours Sunday June 22, 8-11 Finish by 1.

Restrooms inside.

DIRECTIONS TO START:

From I-64, take KY 53N (exit 35) toward Shelbyville. LEFT on US 60/Midland Trail. RIGHT on 7th Street. This turns into Burks Branch Rd. Continue left on Burks Branch Rd past the first Park entrance to Park Access Road #2. Enter the park, turning right. Colonel Sanders Pavilion will be on your left.

CLEAR CREEK PARK and DOWNTOWN 7K LOOP

1. Leave the pavilion toward parking lot and Park Access Rd #2.
2. LEFT at Park Access Rd.
3. Follow to circular drive.
4. Right turn to take park trail. Fence will be on your left.
5. Just past maintenance building, cut across to the path on other side of building.
6. Turn Left onto this path and follow the path along the edge of Clear Creek Park.
7. When the path comes to the road, turn LEFT onto the road. Follow the road out of the park.
8. Continue straight on this road (Burks Branch Rd) into town. You will pass Eminence Pike (3 way stop), walk under a viaduct, (road name changes to 7th Street) and go past the visitor center.
9. Straight at traffic light, crossing Washington.
10. In one block, turn left onto Main St.
11. Continue on Main for 3 blocks.
12. Turn left onto 4th street.
13. In one block, turn left onto Washington.
14. Continue on Washington back to 7th Street. 7th Street becomes Burks Branch Rd after the viaduct.
15. Turn right onto 7th Street and walk back to Clear Creek Park.
16. ENTER Clear Creek Park on Park Access Rd #1.

17. LEFT at first trail before playground.

(There is a small botanical garden near the park entrance with trails between the trees. Feel free to explore but this is not part of the distance.)

18. FOLLOW trail around west side of park.

RESTROOMS are in the blue building just before the main park road.

19. LEFT at main park road.

20. RIGHT onto service road (trail) at beginning of golf course parking lot.

21. FOLLOW service road (trail) back to traffic circle.

22. LEFT at traffic circle.

23. RIGHT at Colonel Sanders Parking lot and Pavilion.

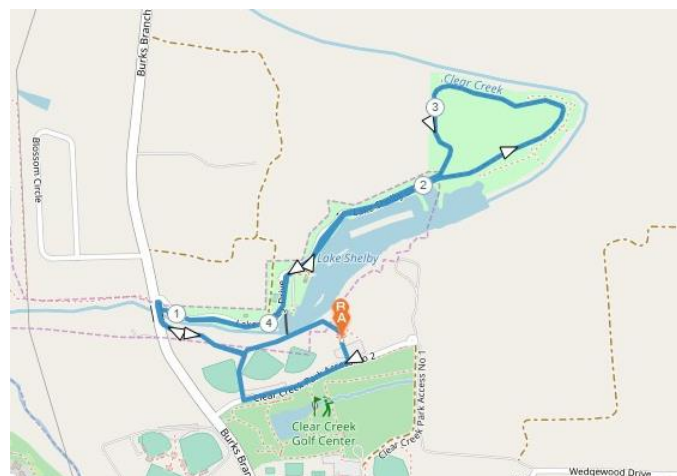

LAKE SHELBY & SQUIRE BOONE TRAIL 5K LOOP

1. Leave the pavilion toward Park Access Rd #2.
2. **RIGHT** turn at the Park Access Rd.
3. **RIGHT** at end of last parking lot before exiting park, walk towards ball diamond and follow trail between diamonds.
4. **LEFT** onto paved trail behind ball diamond.
5. **CROSS** creek.
6. **RIGHT** onto Lake Shelby Drive.
7. **FOLLOW** the road along Clear Creek and Lake Shelby.
8. **GO THROUGH THE GATE.** The road will end at Squire Boone Trial Loop. The gate is so vehicles do not go through. Make your way through the gate and take the path straight ahead.
You can take the easy trail for this loop or a more rugged trail at the edge of the lake through the trees. You will find the start of this trail to your right where the trees start at the end of the clearing.
9. **RETURN** through the gate and follow the road back.
10. **LEFT** to cross the creek on the path just before Burk's Branch Road.
11. **CONTINUE** on the paved trail.
12. Near the pavement end, **TURN LEFT** into the opening to the trees.
13. **TURN RIGHT** onto trail through the woods.
14. **FOLLOW** trail to a large clearing. **COLONEL SANDER'S PAVILION** is to your right, up a hill.
