Start/Finish point is Harp’s Food Store, 401 E. Main St., Marble Hill, MO 63764. GPS coordinates: 37.30623, -89.97551 (Parking and restrooms available)

Directions from Cape Girardeau: From I-55 Exit 99 take MO Hwy 61 north to MO Hwy 72, then MO Hwy 34 west to Marble Hill. Harp’s is at the intersection of Hwy 34 and Hwy 51.

Directions from Poplar Bluff: Take US Hwy 60 east to MO Hwy 51, then north on Hwy 51 to Marble Hill. Harp’s is at the intersection of Hwy 51 and Hwy 34.

NOTE: For this YRE Walk you must use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete this event. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by going to the “Finish Table” and entering your participation date, distance, and any special programs using the OSB.

OSB COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to 'finish/complete' your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when they submit the event completion info as a paying-for-credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.) Also note that an event registration expires after 30 days, but if your registration lapses, you may re-register without cost.

Special Programs: Walking with America’s Veterans; Walking the USA A-Z (“M”); Walking Missouri Counties (*Bollinger County*)

Legend: TR = Turn Right, TL = Turn Left, SA = Straight Ahead, CR = Cross, SP = Special Program Qualifier

1. From the “Grocery Store exit” of Harp’s, **TL** and walk thru the parking area to Mayfield Dr.
2. **TR** on Mayfield a short distance, then **TL** on Main St. (Do not cross Main St.)
3. **SA** on Main St. for 2 blocks to North St.
4. **TL** on North St. 1 block to Boundary St.
5. **TL** on Boundary St. 1 block to Poplar St.
6. **TR** on Poplar St. 2 blocks to Allen St.
7. **TR** on Allen St. 1 block to North St.
8. **TR** on North St. 2 blocks to Boundary St.
9. **TL** on Boundary St.
10. In one short block, where Boundary, Broadway, and Mary Court come together, continue **SA** to stay on Boundary St. (stay to the right of the “Dead End” sign). Boundary St. then curves to the right to High St.
11. **TR** on High St., passing the **Bollinger Co. Courthouse** on your left, to Walnut St. (**SP-Veteran’s Memorial** in front of the courthouse.)
12. **TL** on Walnut St. 2 blocks to Pine St.
13. **TR** on Pine St. 1 block to Rock St.
14. **TL** on Rock St. 1 block to Broad St.
15. **TL** on Broad St. 2 blocks to Gilmore St.
16. **TL** on Gilmore St. 1 block to Pine St.

17. **TR** on Pine St. 1 block to Broadway St.
18. **TL** on Broadway St. 1 block to Massey St., passing a replica of the Alma Fisher one-room schoolhouse (early 1900s) to Massey St. The Massey Log House (1869) will be on your left.
19. **TR** on Massey St. (unpaved) 1 block to Boundary St.
20. **TR** on Boundary St. 1 block to Pine St.
21. **TL** on Pine St. 1 block to Hopkins St.
22. **TR** on Hopkins St. 2 blocks to Broadway St.
23. **TL** on Broadway St. to its end at County Road 302.
24. **TL** on Co. Rd. 302 a short distance to Bidwell St.
25. **TL** on Bidwell St. 3 blocks to Zimmerman St.
26. **TR** on Zimmerman St. to its end at Deer Path Ln.
26. **TL** on Deer Path Ln. 1 block to Fox Croft Dr.
27. **TL** on Fox Croft Dr. 1 block to Mill St.
28. **TR** on Mill St. 1 block to Hopkins St.
29. **TR** on Hopkins St. 1 block to where it merges into High St. Continue **SA** on High St., passing the old boarded-up Marble Hill School (1939) on your right, to Williams St.
30. **TL** on Williams St. 3 blocks to its end at Tippet St.
31. **TL** on Tippet St. 1 block to Graham St.

32. **TR** on Graham 1 block to Mayfield Dr. Directly ahead is the Bollinger Co. Library which occupies one of the buildings of the old Will Mayfield Baptist College (1878 – 1934).

33. **TL** on Mayfield Dr. and return to the Start/Finish at Harp's Food Store.

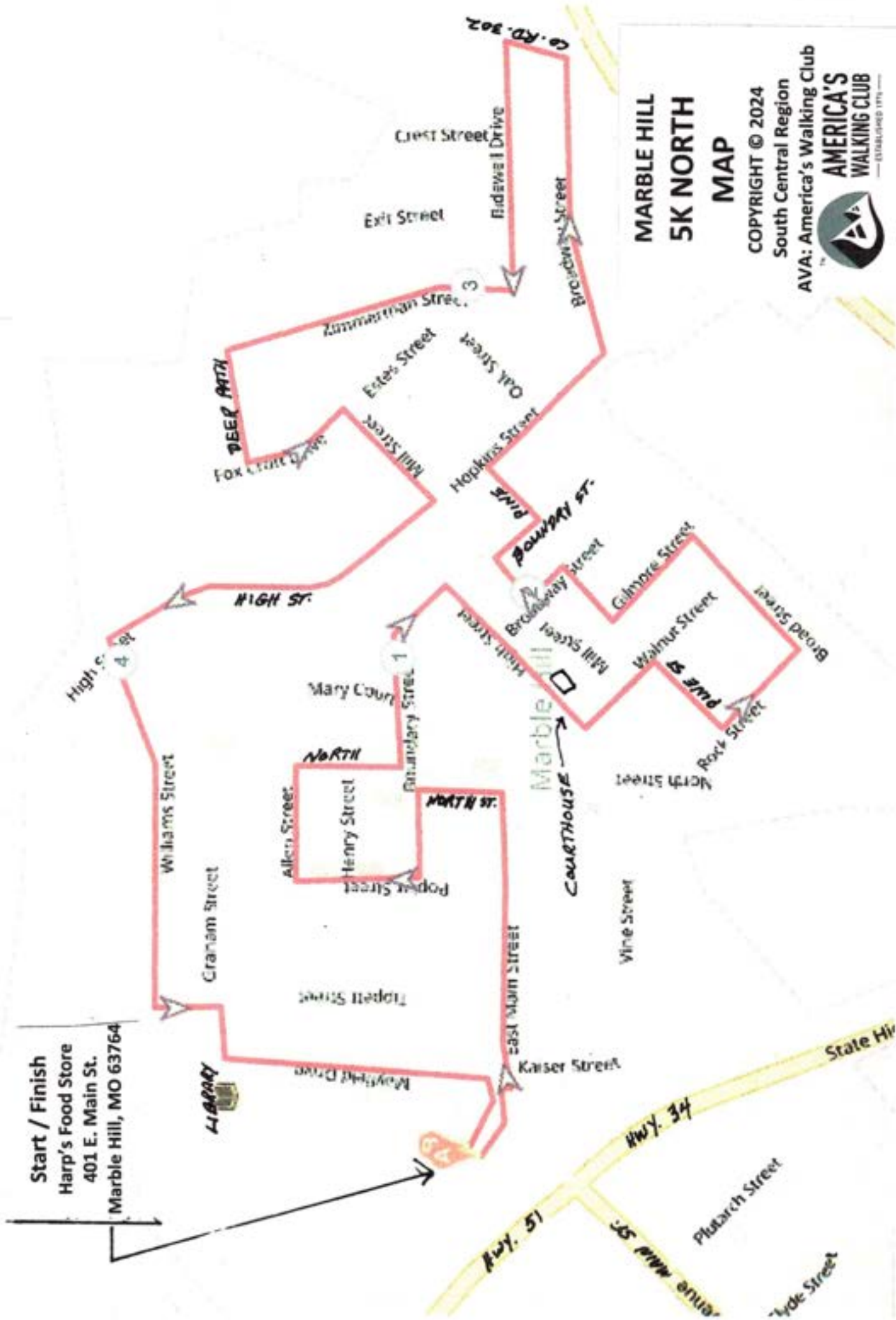

1. From the “Grocery Store exit” of Harp’s, **TL** and walk down the exit driveway to Main St.

2. **TR** on Main St. and walk on the grass shoulder a short distance to the 4-way stop. **CAREFULLY** cross Hwy. 51.

3. **SA** on Main St. (Hwy. 51 S, Hwy. 34 W), walking through the parking areas of the businesses along Main St.

4. After passing El Tule Mexican Restaurant, **TR** on the walking path in Twin City Park (**SP** – Par for the Course). After circling the small park, **TR** and go up the “covered” ramp to Main St. and cross the bridge over Crooked Creek.

5. After crossing Crooked Creek you are in the former town of Lutesville, which was merged with Marble Hill in 1985.

6. Continue **SA** along Main St. and carefully cross 1st St. (Hwy. 34).

7. Continue **SA**, up the hill to Central St.

8. **TR** on Central St. 2 blocks to Summit St.

9. **TL** on Summit St. 1 block to Slaybaugh St.

10. **TL** on Slaybaugh 2 blocks to Englehart Ln.

11. **TL** on Englehart Ln. a short distance to the next street – 3rd St. (no sign).

12. **TR** on 3rd St. 6 blocks to South St.

13. **TL** on South St. 1 block to 2nd St.

14. **TL** on 2nd St. 1 block to Ellen St.
15. **TR** on Ellen St. 1 block to 1st St.
16. **TL** on 1st St. 1 block to Lutes St.
17. **TL** on Lutes St. 1 block to 2nd St.
18. **TR** on 2nd St. 3 blocks to Mound St.
19. **TR** on Mound St. 1 block to 1st St.
20. **TR** on 1st St. 2 blocks to Crown St., passing **Marble Hill City Hall (SP)** on your right, and the **Bollinger County Veterans Memorial Wall (SP)** on your left.
21. **TL** on Crown St. 2 blocks to Magnolia St. (no sign, but it is directly behind Lutesville Ford).
22. **TL** on Magnolia St. 3 blocks to Main St., passing Magnolia Park on your right.
23. Carefully cross Main St. (Hwy. 51/34) and **TR**, walking along the left side of Main St. back to Harp's Food Store. Again, be very careful crossing Hwy. 51 at the 4-way stop just before Harp's.
