**Start/Finish point:** Town & Country Supermarket, 7 Hal’s Plaza Drive, Piedmont, Missouri 63957.

GPS coordinates: 37.13888, -90.69961 (Parking and restrooms available)

**Directions from Cape Girardeau:** From I-55 Exit 99 go north on MO Hwy 61 to intersection of Hwys 61, 25 & 72. Continue north on MO Hwy 72 to MO Hwy 34, then west on MO Hwy 34 to Piedmont. In Piedmont go left (south) on MO Hwy 49 to Town & Country Supermarket, near intersection of Hwy 49 and Hwy HH.

**Directions from Poplar Bluff:** Go north on US Hwy 67 to MO Hwy 49, then north on MO Hwy 49 to Piedmont. Town & Country Supermarket is near the intersection of Hwy 49 and Hwy HH.

**NOTE:** For this YRE Walk you must use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete this event. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by going to the “Finish Table” and entering your participation date, distance, and any special programs using the OSB.

**OSB COMPLETION AND CREDIT:** You MUST log back into the OSB system to 'finish/complete' your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when they submit the event completion info as a paying-for-credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.) Also note that an event registration expires after 30 days, but if your registration lapses, you may re-register without cost.

1. From the supermarket, **TL** through the parking lot to Hwy. HH (Main Street).
2. **TR** on HH/Main. SA to Gooch’s.
3. **Cross** HH/Main at the crosswalk. **TR** to continue walking on HH/Main.
4. **TL** on Corrigan Street.
5. Walk 2 blocks to Legion Park Road.
6. **TR**. Walk 1 block to Park Street. **TL**. Walk a short distance and then **TR** to go on the “Walking Trail.”
7. **SA** and pass the sign that says “Rotary Centennial Park” on your left.
8. **SA**, following the path as it curves towards HH/Main.
9. **TL** on the sidewalk along HH/Main as you leave the park.
10. **CR** the bridge over McKenzie Creek.
11. **SA** to Ash Street at the Clark gas station.
12. **CR** HH/Main at the crosswalk. **TL** to continue walking along HH/Main.
13. **SA** to Fir Street.
14. **TR** on Fir. Walk 1 block to First Street. No street sign. Enter Handy Park and follow the park path. A

gazebo and a playground (**SP**) are on your left.

15. **SA** on the park path. It will seem that you're blocked by a junkyard, but follow the park path as it turns to the left.
16. You come to a sign, "Welcome to McKenzie Creek Greenway", on your left. **SA** on the park path, but to see a nice view of McKenzie Creek, **TL** at the sign, walk to the creek, and then return to the park path.
17. **SA** along the path. Walk under HH/Main. Follow the park path as it curves around, back toward HH/Main.
18. **TR** on the sidewalk and **CR** over McKenzie Creek.
19. Pass Dollar General, Sonic, and American Legion Post #281 (**SP**) on your right.
20. Use the crosswalk at Gooch's to cross HH/Main.
21. **TL** at Tractor Supply.
22. Return to Town & Country Supermarket and your car.

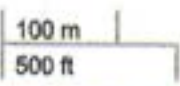


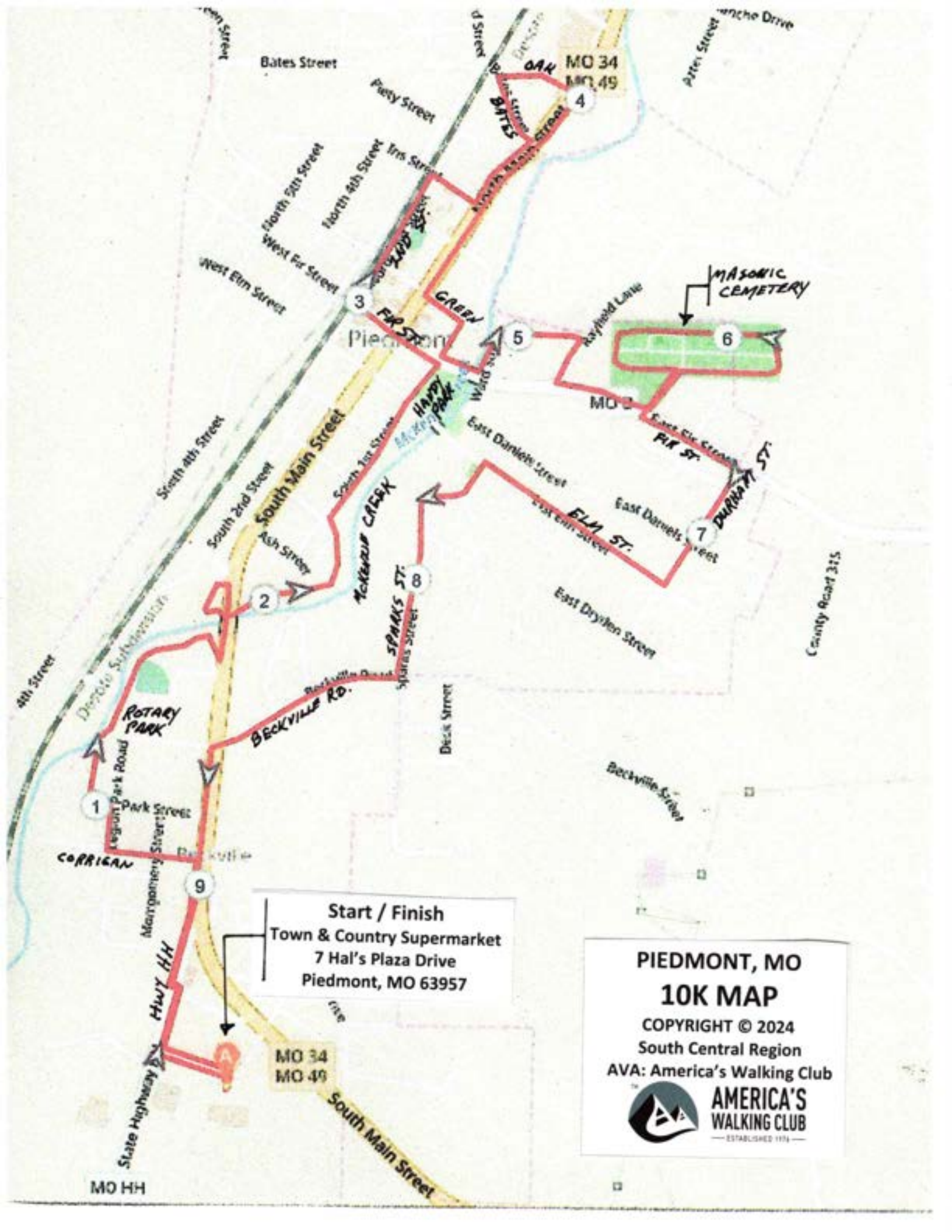

**Start/Finish point:** Town & Country Supermarket, 7 Hal’s Plaza Drive, Piedmont, Missouri 63957.

GPS coordinates: 37.13888, -90.69961 (Parking and restrooms available)

**Directions from Cape Girardeau:** From I-55 Exit 99 go north on MO Hwy 61 to intersection of Hwys 61, 25 & 72. Continue north on MO Hwy 72 to MO Hwy 34, then west on MO Hwy 34 to Piedmont. In Piedmont go left (south) on MO Hwy 49 to Town & Country Supermarket, near intersection of Hwy 49 and Hwy HH.

**Directions from Poplar Bluff:** Go north on US Hwy 67 to MO Hwy 49, then north on MO Hwy 49 to Piedmont. Town & Country Supermarket is near the intersection of Hwy 49 and Hwy HH.

**NOTE:** For this YRE Walk you must use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete this event. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by going to the “Finish Table” and entering your participation date, distance, and any special programs using the OSB.

1. From the supermarket, **TL** though the parking lot to Hwy. HH (Main Street).
2. **TR** on HH/Main. SA to Gooch’s.
3. **Cross** HH/Main at the crosswalk. **TR** to continue walking on HH/Main.
4. **TL** on Corrigan Street.
5. Walk 2 blocks to Legion Park Road.
6. **TR**. Walk 1 block to Park Street. **TL**. Walk a short distance and then **TR** to go on the “Walking Trail.”
7. **SA** and pass the sign that says “Rotary Centennial Park” on your left.
8. **SA**, following the path as it curves towards HH/Main.
9. **TL** on the sidewalk along HH/Main as you leave the park.
10. **CR** the bridge over McKenzie Creek.
11. **TL** on the park path to circle back, to walk under HH/Main along McKenzie Creek.
12. You come to a sign, “Welcome to McKenzie Creek Greenway”, on your right. **SA** on the park path, but to see a nice view of McKenzie Creek, **TR** at the sign, walk to the creek, and then return to the park path.
13. **SA** on the park path. Pass a junkyard on your left and follow the park path **SA**.
14. You will come to Handy Park. A playground (**SP**) and a gazebo are on your right. This is the corner of Fir Street and First Street, but no street signs.

15. **TL** on Fir, **CR** HH/Main on the crosswalk.
16. **SA** 2 blocks to Second Street. No signs.
17. **TR** on Second. **TR** on Iris Street, back to HH/Main.
18. **TL** on HH/Main to Bates Street and **TL**.
19. Walk 1 block to Oak Street (no street sign) and **TR**, back to HH/Main.
20. **TR** at Main and **SA** to Green Street. **TL** and carefully cross HH/Main.
21. Walk 1 block to First Street (no sign).
22. **TR** on First. **SA** to Fir. You see Handy Park again, but now **TL** on Fir and cross the bridge. Immediately at the end of the bridge, **TL**. This is Ward Street (no sign). Ward runs along McKenzie Creek.
23. **TR** on Green and walk 1 block to Rayfield Lane.
24. **TR**. Return to Fir. **TL** on Fir.
25. **TL** at the next intersection to enter Masonic Cemetery. No sign. **Steep hill**.
26. Circle around the cemetery. Great view of Clark Mountain! Return to Fir.
27. **TL** on Fir to Durham Street. **TR** on Durham. Walk to Elm Street.
28. **TR** on Elm and cross Lee and Berry Streets. The next street is Sparks, but no sign. **TL** on Sparks. **SA** to Beckville Road
29. **TR** on Beckville to HH/Main.
30. Carefully cross HH/Main. **TL**.
31. American Legion Post #281 (**SP**) is on your right as you walk along HH/Main.
32. Use the crosswalk at Gooch's to cross HH/Main again.
33. **TL** at Tractor Supply.
34. Return to Town & Country Supermarket and your car.
