Driving Directions to Winthrop Town Trailhead: HWY 20 WEST:
 Continue 8 miles beyond Twisp. After passing the Coldwell Real Estate sign on the left, Look for brown signs on right for Trailhead/Ice Rink. Turn LEFT (White Ave/Twin Lakes Road) In 50 yards turn RIGHT into gravel Trailhead/Ice Rink Parking
 HWY 20 EAST: 13 miles East of Mazama at 4-way stop in Winthrop, TURN RIGHT Continue through town and across a bridge, immediately after the bridge the road curves left. TURN RIGHT onto White Ave/Twin Lakes Road. In 50 Yards turn RIGHT into gravel Trailhead/Ice Rink Parking.



This event has a remote start. Restrooms available here.

Restrooms Down the stairs and turn left to enter the building for restroom.

Directions from Winthrop Town Trailhead to walk start point are on each set of walk directions

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.



#3 2024 Rex Derr Trail/Lake Pearrygin State Park SYR3515 5K (Rated 2B)



Start: Register at Winthrop Town Trailhead and drive 4 miles to the start. Mapped walk.

Discover Pass Required. Restrooms at Start

Directions to Start: From Winthrop Town Trailhead, turn LEFT on White Avenue/Twin Lakes Road, LEFT onto Highway 20 to the 4-way stop. RIGHT on Bridge Street RIGHT on Bluff Street, which becomes E. Chewuch Road. In 1 ¼ miles RIGHT on Bear Creek Road. After 1 mile RIGHT into Lake Pearrygin State Park East Entrance. Follow signs for EAST/BOAT RAMP. Drive past boat parking to sign for Upper Rex Derr. **CONTINUE STRAIGHT.** In a short distance, TURN RIGHT at the “P” sign, (Day Use Parking)

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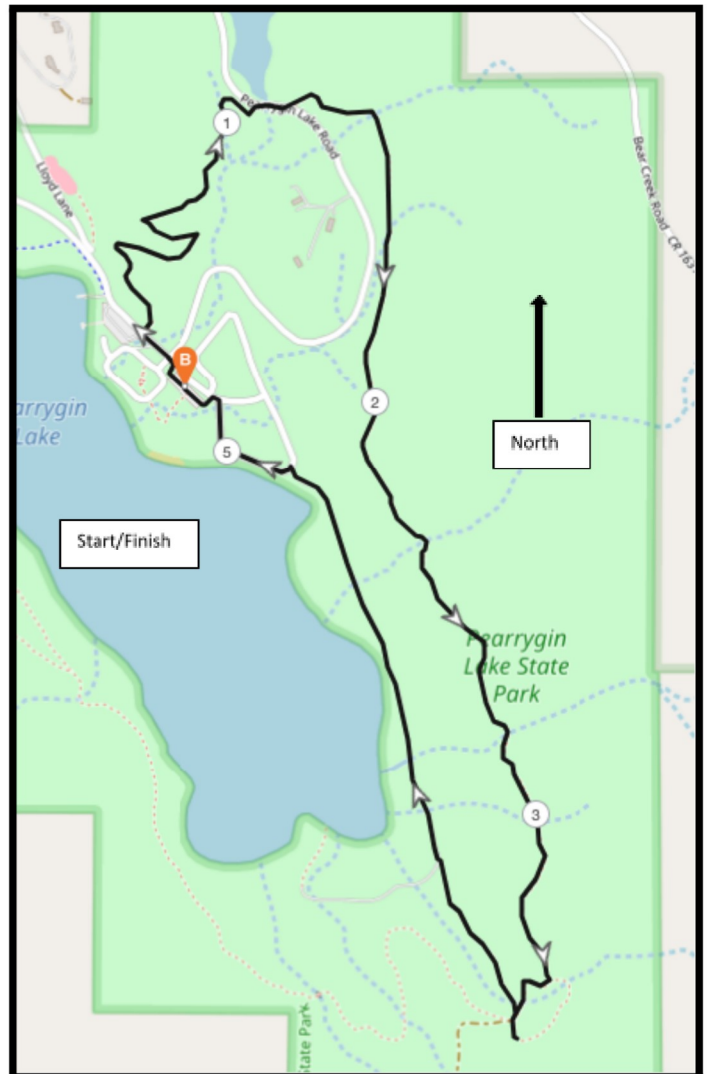


IN CASE OF EMERGENCY DIAL 911

- 1) From the Day Use parking area, walk toward the boat ramp area parking.
- 2) After rail fence see sign “Right Lane” look to the right for the sign to the Rex Derr Trail.
- 3) **RIGHT** Follow the Rex Derr Trail as it switchbacks uphill for 1k.
- 4) When you reach the road **CROSS and RIGHT.**
- 5) In a short distance **LEFT** at the TRAIL signpost to re-enter the trail.
- 6) **STRAIGHT** at the sign for Lake Creek Trailhead
- 7) At 2.7k you will cross a bridge. At 3k the trail starts downhill. **VEER RIGHT** at the “Y”. You will see the old homestead ahead.
- 8) Walk to the trailsign. Continue **STRAIGHT** for a few yards to view the old truck, then come back to the sign.
- 9) **VEER RIGHT**, then take the trail heading down hill toward Campgrounds.
- 10) In .4k you will reach the Group Camp Access Road (no sign). **VEER RIGHT** and walk on the gravel road to the paved campground road.
- 11) **VEER LEFT** and walk on the paved road.
- 12) After site #32, **TURN LEFT** and return to the parking area. (5k)

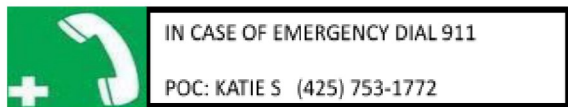


**Start: Register at Winthrop Town Trailhead and drive 4 miles to the start. Mapped walk.

Directions to Start: From Winthrop Town Trailhead, turn LEFT on Twin Lakes Road, LEFT onto Highway 20 to the 4-way stop. RIGHT on Bridge Street RIGHT on Bluff Street, which becomes E. Chewuch Road. - 3) Follow the Rex Derr Trail as it switchbacks uphill for 1k.
- 4) When you reach the road **CROSS and RIGHT**
- 5) **LEFT** at the TRAIL sign to re-enter the trail.
- 6) At 2.7k you will cross a bridge. At 3k the trail starts downhill. **TURN RIGHT** at the "Y". You will see the old homestead ahead.
- 7) **STRAIGHT** at the sign for Lake Creek Trailhead
- 8) At 2.7k you will cross a bridge. At 3k the trail starts downhill. **VEER RIGHT** at the "Y". You will see the old homestead ahead.
- 9) Walk to the trail sign. Continue **STRAIGHT** for a few yards to view the old truck, then come back to the sign.
- 10) **LEFT** toward Lake Creek Trailhead, stay **RIGHT** at the fork heading downhill.
- 11) The trail briefly curves away from the lake, crosses a bridge over a dry creek. Enjoy the view from the bridge, then return to the homestead.
- 12) **TURN LEFT** on trail heading down hill toward Campgrounds.
- 13) In .4k you will reach the Group Camp Access Road (no sign). **VEER RIGHT** and walk on the

- gravel road to the paved campground road.
- 14) **VEER LEFT** and walk on the paved road.
 - 15) After site #32, **TURN LEFT** (7K WALKERS RETURN TO YOUR CAR.)
 - 16) To complete the 10k, **CONTINUE** to the boat parking (same as #1).
 - 17) Just beyond the boat ramp, **VEER LEFT** to join pedestrian trail on the left,
 - 18) Pass by a yellow pylon and enter campground **CONTINUE STRAIGHT**
 - 19) **STRAIGHT** at entry road (on the right.)
 - 20) **STRAIGHT** at DO NOT ENTER sign (you are not a car)
 - 21) At a group of buildings, the road curves right. continue around the curve then
 - 22) **TURN RIGHT** at the 1st road (another do not enter sign)
 - 23) **TURN LEFT** after Camp host (Site 148 ahead)
 - 24) **STRAIGHT** at the entry road.
 - 25) **VEER LEFT** at the "y" and enter the trail with yellow pylon.
 - 26) At the boat launch Carefully cross to left side of road
 - 27) **CONTINUE** to parking and finish.
