Start at: Winthrop Town Trailhead, 208 White Ave, Winthrop, WA 98862

Mapping Apps: (Apple/Google) Winthrop Ice Rink

Driving Directions to Winthrop Town Trailhead: HWY 20 WEST: Continue 8 miles beyond Twisp. After passing the Coldwell Real Estate sign on the left, Look for brown signs on right for Trailhead/Ice Rink. Turn LEFT (White Ave/Twin Lakes Road) In 50 yards turn RIGHT into gravel Trailhead/Ice Rink Parking
HWY 20 EAST: 13 miles East of Mazama at 4-way stop in Winthrop, TURN RIGHT Continue through town and across a bridge, immediately after the bridge the road curves left. TURN RIGHT onto White Ave/Twin Lakes Road. In 50 Yards turn RIGHT into gravel Trailhead/Ice Rink Parking.

This event has a remote start. Restrooms available here.

Restrooms Down the stairs and turn left to enter the building for restroom.

Directions from Winthrop Town Trailhead to walk start point are on each set of walk directions

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.



#2 Patterson Mountain SYR3517

6/8k (Rated 4C)

Start: Register at Winthrop Town Trailhead and drive 7.1 Miles to Patterson Mountain Trailhead.

Mapping Apps: Search: ([Apple Maps](#))Patterson Lake Boat Launch/([Google Maps](#)) Patterson Lake Public Access

Directions: TURN RIGHT on White Ave which becomes Twin Lakes Road. Continue to Lake Patterson Road and TURN RIGHT, following the signs to Sun Mountain Lodge. After a couple of miles, you'll see Patterson Lake on your left. About 2/3 of the way up the lake parking is on your left. Pit Toilet available.

Discover Pass is Required at the Trailhead. Poles recommended. Elevation gain 1200'

- (1) Walk back to Patterson Lake Road
- (2) **CAREFULLY CROSS** Patterson Lake Road to the Patterson Mountain trail sign and start the trail.
- (3) At about .5K you will come to a green gate. Pass through the gate then **LEFT** to pass through the second green gate. Close the gates behind you.
- (4) **RIGHT** onto the Northern Loop Trail. It's for the most part a gradual uphill from here with the occasional steep bit.
- (5) At about 2k you will reach a fence that has a platform for you to climb over it.
- (6) Continue climbing for about 1 more km and you will come to a "T". (3k)
- (7) **At the "T" is decision time. As the signs indicate, TURN LEFT to the Summit, CONTINUE STRAIGHT to begin the Southern Loop. Going to the Summit is your additional 2k option.**

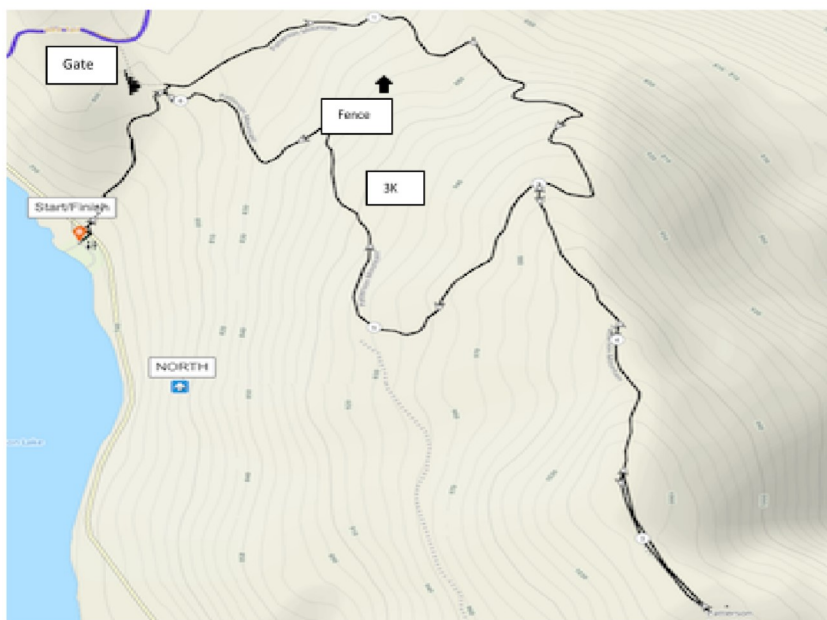
***For those going to Summit, **TURN LEFT** and follow the path to the top. You'll know you're there when you reach the cistern and the largest cairn I've ever seen. After enjoying the views retrace your steps down to the trail junction and **TURN LEFT** on the Southern Loop.

*****Those doing the 6K, CONTINUE STRAIGHT onto the Southern Loop.**

(8) When you reach the green gates again, LEFT through the gate and continue down the hill.

(9) **Carefully Cross** Patterson Lake Road to the start/finish point.

#2 Beaver Pond Loop SYR3517

5k rated 1B

Start: Register at Winthrop Town Trailhead and drive 7.5 Miles to Chickadee Trailhead.

Mapping Apps: Search: (Apple Maps/Google Maps) Chickadee Trailhead

Directions: TURN RIGHT on White Ave which becomes Twin Lakes Road. Continue to Lake Patterson Road and TURN RIGHT, following the signs to Sun Mountain Lodge. After a couple of miles, you'll see Patterson Lake on your left. At the far end of the lake, you'll make a sharp turn to the left. Chickadee Trailhead is a ¼ mile past this curve on your left.

No Pass is Required at the Trailhead.

1. Walk back through parking area to the unpaved forest service road you came in on.
2. Carefully cross the forest service road and enter a trail marked "RODEO."
3. **RIGHT** at "T" to stay on Rodeo. Shortly after you start on this trail you will find a downed tree. You can walk around it and continue on the trail. (4/18/2024)
4. Rodeo widens (Fire access road), goes down a short hill and back up, bending right. As the road starts downhill again, look left to see a narrower trail.
5. **TURN LEFT** this is the original Rodeo trail.
6. Follow signs for "Rodeo" to the end.
7. **RIGHT** at service road and cross bridge over Patterson Creek. The Homestead is in front of you.
8. **RIGHT**, immediately after crossing bridge.
9. Continue ahead to "Y".
10. **ANGLE RIGHT** on "Beaver Pond" You will be on this trail for 2.2 K (The pond will be on your right in 1k)
11. **RIGHT** just before the forest service road, crossing a bridge, enjoying views of Beaver Pond. Continue on the trail for a short distance back to the road.
12. Carefully **CROSS** the road and re-enter Chickadee Trailhead Parking area to the finish.
