Start at: Winthrop Town Trailhead, 208 White Ave, Winthrop, WA 98862

Driving Directions to Winthrop Town Trailhead: HWY 20 WEST: Continue 8 miles beyond Twisp. After passing the Coldwell Real Estate sign on the left, Look for brown signs on right for Trailhead/Ice Rink. Turn LEFT (White Ave/Twin Lakes Road) In 50 yards turn RIGHT into gravel Trailhead/Ice Rink Parking

HWY 20 EAST: 13 miles East of Mazama at 4-way stop in Winthrop, TURN RIGHT Continue through town and across a bridge, immediately after the bridge the road curves left. TURN RIGHT onto White Ave/Twin Lakes Road. In 50 Yards turn RIGHT into gravel Trailhead/Ice Rink Parking.

This event has a remote start. Restrooms available here.

Restrooms Down the stairs and turn left to enter the building for restroom.

Directions from Winthrop Town Trailhead to walk start point are on each set of walk directions

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.



Event #4a 2024 Mazama Trails SYR3518 6K(Rated 1B)

Directions : From Winthrop Town Trailhead Left onto White Ave/Twin Lakes Road **LEFT** on Hwy 20 to 4 Way Stop. **LEFT** to continue west on Hwy 20 for 13.2 miles. **RIGHT** on Lost River Road (sign for Mazama). **PROCEED** 0.5 miles (over the river) to a stop sign. **PROCEED STRAIGHT** ahead , then **TURN RIGHT** into the gravel trailhead parking lot. **Vault toilets at trailhead.**

No Parking Pass is required at the Mazama Trailhead

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Description: 6K is an out and back.

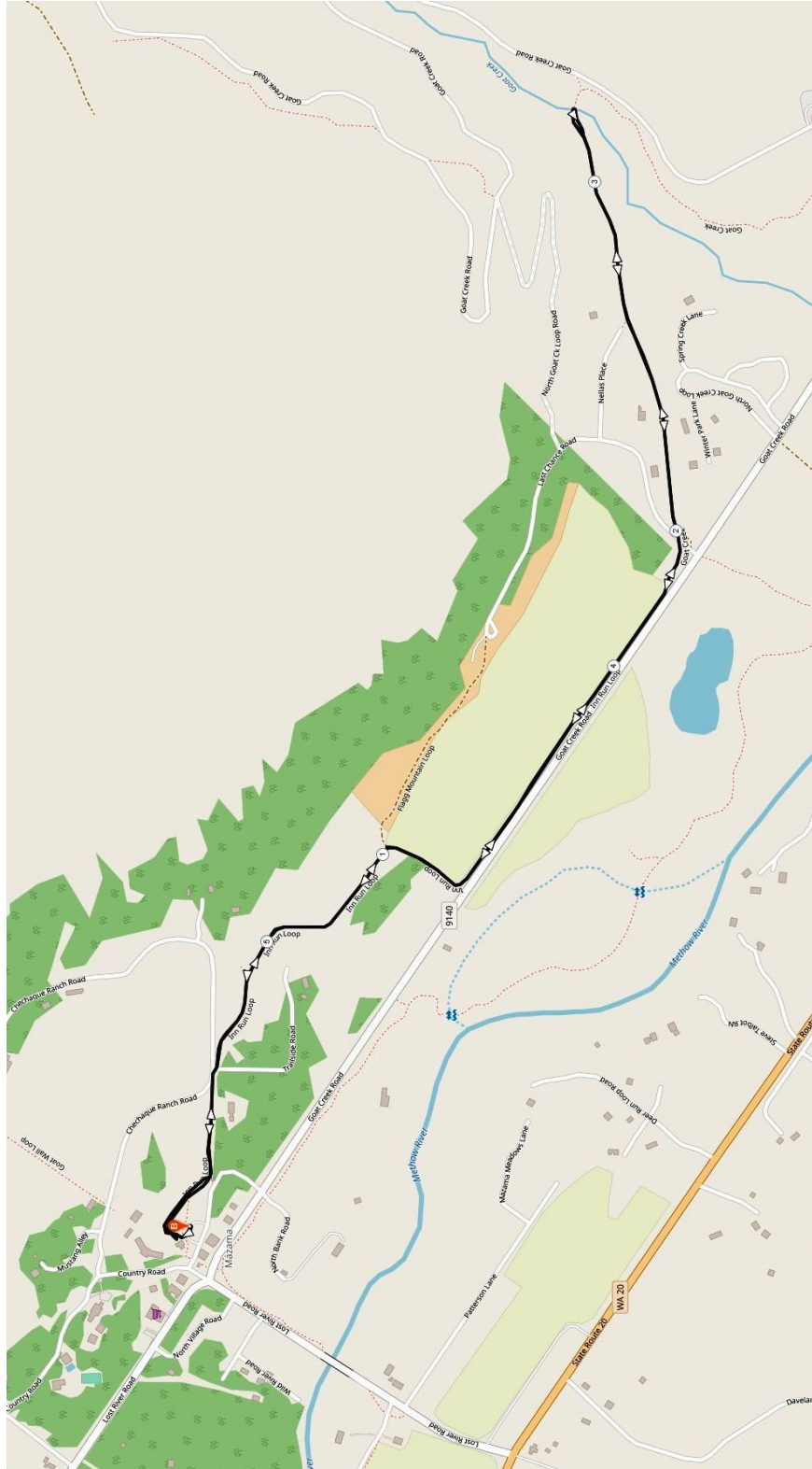
Safety and Other Info: Emergency 911 only works near the parking lot area. This is a community trail system . Please stay on the trail as portions of this event cross private property

- 1) At signboard, follow the gravel trail around parking lot to a small kiosk on your left. Just past the kiosk, **LEFT** on the brown cinder rock trail.
- 2) **PROCEED** on the Inn Run trail through the meadow, crossing gravel driveways/roads. Keep on the main trail.
- 3) Pass a farmer's field on left, road on your right.
- 4) **CROSS** Last Chance Road and continue the trail into the woods.
- 5) Continue **STRAIGHT** at a road end turnaround circle on your left.
- 6) At Goat Creek bridge (not marked) **TURN AROUND** (You will be retracing your steps back on the trail to the start point parking lot.)
- 7) **CONTINUE** through woods on the trail to Last Chance Road.
- 8) **CROSS** Last Chance Road
- 9) **CONTINUE** on trail with Farmers field on your right.
- 10) Curve **RIGHT** on the trail through the meadow, crossing gravel driveways/roads. Keep on the main trail.
- 11) **CONTINUE** to parking & end.

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Event #4b Twisp – Town and Art SYR3518 - 5K Rated 1B

Driving Directions to Twisp Park: From Winthrop Town Trailhead LEFT onto Twin Lakes Rd, Turn Right on Hwy20. Continue for 8 miles to Twisp Ave. LEFT on Twisp Ave to Lincoln St. LEFT on Lincoln St to the end at Twisp Park. Park here near the informational Kiosk. Porta-Potty available here.

Note: numbered streets may be written out or numerical in this community.

1. **START** at the information kiosk onto initially paved trail that turns to gravel. River on your left just prior to the confluence of Twisp and Methow Rivers.
2. Continue on the trail to the end as it curves to the right becoming Methow St. (unmarked)
3. **TURN LEFT** on Methow St. for one short block to 2nd Ave.
4. **TURN LEFT** onto 2nd Ave.
5. Continue to end of the street, cross the gravel traffic circle, proceed **RIGHT** around the plastic sheeting barrier and onto the small path. Keep on the path, the Methow River is on your left, until it exits onto Bridge St (not marked). (1K)
6. **CONTINUE** on Bridge St to 5th Ave.
7. **TURN RIGHT** on 5th Ave to Glover St.
8. At the corner of 5th Ave. and Glover St, **LEFT** onto short gravel path to enter through the gate into the Methow Valley Interpretive Center and Garden. Please remember to close all gates behind you.
9. Stroll through the gardens noting the plants, Artwork and Plateau Indian Pit House.
10. Exit the garden through the double gate to the gravel walkway leading to large metal sphere art.
11. **ANGLE LEFT** across the parking lot toward the "i" and covered information kiosk into the Twisp Works compound. (Former US Forest Service Buildings)
12. **ANGLE LEFT** toward the Bunkhouse Building then **RIGHT** continuing to pass by all buildings in a clockwise circle. (Porta-Potty in Building L)
13. After OSB Brewery building, **LEFT** to exit compound through the parking lot passing Building A, toward Glover St.
14. **CAREFULLY CROSS** Glover St. and **TURN RIGHT** on Glover St. sidewalk.
15. Continue to 4th Ave.
16. **CROSS** and **RIGHT** on 4th Ave.
17. **LEFT** on Lincoln St and continue 3 blocks to Twisp Ave. (sign behind shrubs)
18. **CROSS** and **LEFT** on Twisp Ave 2 blocks to Hwy 20 (unmarked) Chevron on your left.
19. **TURN LEFT** on Hwy 20 (unmarked) two blocks to 3rd Ave. (Note restroom located halfway down 2nd and return)
20. **TURN RIGHT** to **CROSS** Hwy 20 to the Community Center and Park. Tour the area and return to this crossing. (*Saturday market here till noon.*)
21. **CROSS** Hwy 20 again and continue on 3rd Ave to Glover St.
22. **LEFT** on Glover St. and enjoy the shops and galleries for the next 2 blocks.(sidewalk is open during construction)
23. At Twisp Ave, **RIGHT** and **CROSS** Glover St.
24. **TURN RIGHT** on Glover St. for 2 blocks enjoying more shops and galleries. (*The famous bakery and Confluence Art Gallery are along these blocks*)
25. Due to sidewalk closure, turn around after viewing Confluence Art Gallery to 2nd Ave.
26. **CROSS** and **RIGHT** on 2nd Ave to Methow St.
27. **LEFT** on Lincoln St to 2nd Ave.
28. **RIGHT** on 2nd Ave. to Methow St
41. **CROSS** and **LEFT** onto Methow St.
42. **RIGHT** at first gravel trail past homes, just before the meadow, onto the trail. River is on the right this time, back to the parking lot.
43. Exit at the Kiosk and back to your car.
