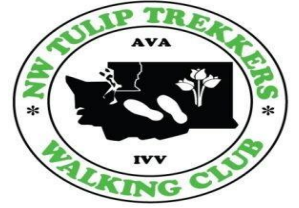

Description: Walk along a 2,000-foot-long paved trestle spanning Fidalgo Bay. You will see murals, trailside sculptures and many signs that describe the local history.

There have been views of Blue Heron and Eagles on the trail. The shallow waters are home to habitat for salmon and other fish and wildlife.

The views of Mount Baker are spectacular.

Start Point/Driving Directions: The Market grocery store parking lot at 1519 Commercial Ave. From I-5, Exit 230, Highway 20 west. Follow signs for Anacortes. In Anacortes, follow Highway 20 as it turns right on Commercial Ave.

The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB. WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in.

Nevertheless, a fee for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.

1. **EXIT** parking lot onto Q Street.
2. **RIGHT** on Q Ave. to 17th St.
3. **LEFT** crossing Q Ave. in crosswalk.
4. **CONTINUE WALKING DOWN Q AVE.** (restroom at .5k)
5. **LEFT** on round a about on 22nd Ave.
6. **CROSS** crosswalk and turn **RIGHT** onto Q St. (boat yard on your left).
7. **CROSS** when you come to crosswalk.
8. **CONTINUE** down trail between 2 posts (you will see 34th Street Message Board).
9. You will see an RV Park at 3.42 km.
10. 7k walkers will turn around and retrace their steps to start of walk when they pass the RV site and come to the trailhead.
11. 10 k walkers, **CONTINUE** walking on the trail eventually crossing the trestle. (water on both sides).
12. When you reach the end of the train trestle; **TURN AROUND** and **RETRACE** your steps and return to the start point.

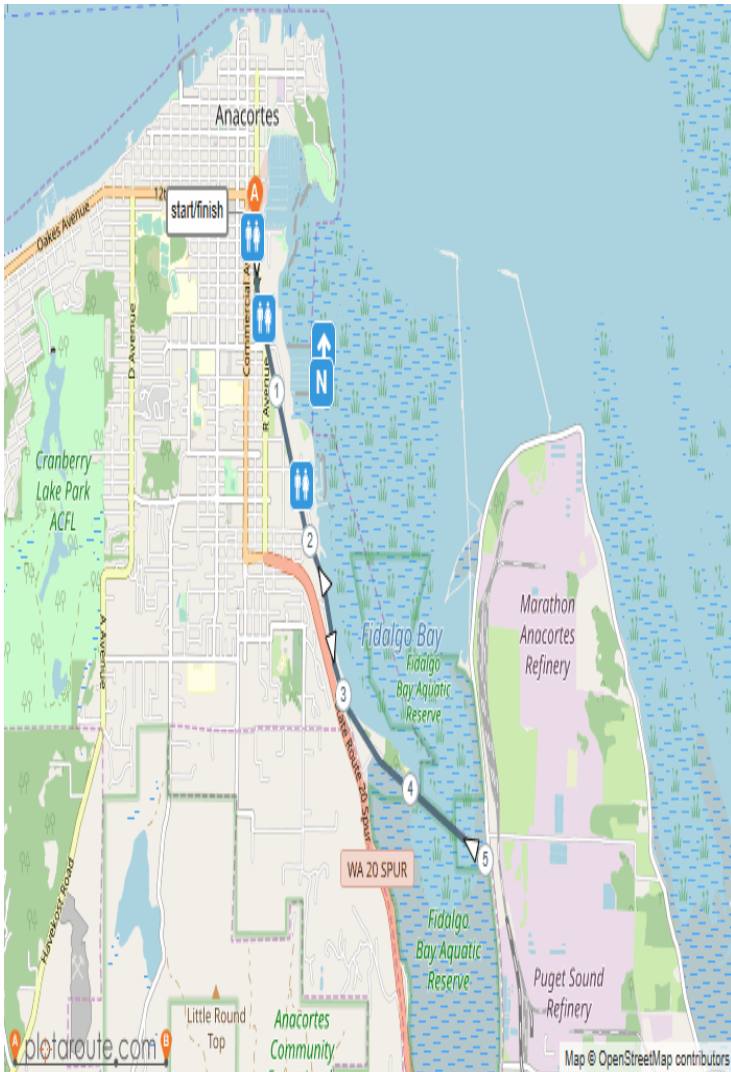
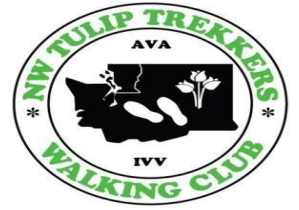
