Description: This walk will take you through the Bayview State Park, walking along the beach and dike.

The trail is along the Puget Sound with beautiful views. You may see eagles, herons, seals, etc. The estuary of the Skagit River is the most biologically productive of all major estuaries on Puget Sound. Padilla Bay supports one of the largest known wintering populations of peregrine falcons in North America.

1. Park at Bayview/Edison Road Trailhead. Mile Marker 0. There is a port-a-potty at the start of the trailhead.
2. **FOLLOW** gravel trail along the dike.
3. When you reach the end of dike, walk through the Skagit County Park gate.
4. Head towards road. **CROSS** Bayview/Edison Rd at crosswalk and turn **LEFT**, continue walking **STRAIGHT** up the road.
5. Turn **RIGHT** on Second St
6. Keep going **STRAIGHT**.
7. Turn **LEFT** on Farham Rd.
8. At the next stop sign (Bayview/Edison Rd), turn **RIGHT**.
9. Walk up Bayview Edison Rd. Turn **RIGHT** into park entrance (Bayview State Park).
10. Walk past Park Booth.
11. At washrooms, keep to your **RIGHT**.
12. Go past second set of restrooms keeping **RIGHT**.
13. Walk on the road circling past campgrounds #31-76. (restrooms to your left).
14. When you reach the stop sign, walk back towards the park booth.
15. Just before you reach the booth, turn **RIGHT** and follow beach trail to beach and proceed downstairs.
16. At end of stairs, **CONTINUE** under overpass to beach.
17. Turn **RIGHT** at beach and follow the fence along the beach alongside the fence to the end of the parking lot (restrooms here).
18. Circle back and walk under the overpass.
19. At stop sign, turn **RIGHT** through gate to Bayview Edison Road facing traffic.
20. Walk back to crosswalk at Dike Trail Head.
21. Turn **RIGHT** at the cross walk and walk through the fence at the trail head and back along the dike to return to your car.
