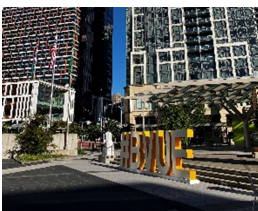


Light Rail – Bellevue Downtown/Wilberton YR3572 6K/10K Rated 1B



Interlaken Trailblazers welcome you to Bellevue Downtown & Wilberton

Starting Point: Bellevue Downtown Light Rail Station GPS LOCATION: @47.6149956,-122.1935014,623

Restrooms: Bellevue City Hall, Marriot Hotel, Parks

This walk is designed to be accessed via light rail.

Line 2 stations with parking:

South Bellevue Park and Ride – (1500 spaces) 2516 Bellevue Way SE, Bellevue, WA 98004. Take the link (North) toward Redmond Tech station and debark at downtown station (2nd stop)

Bel-Red Station – (300 spaces) 13102 NE Spring Blvd Bellevue, WA 98005. Take the link (South) toward South Bellevue. Debark at Downtown Station (3rd stop)

Redmond Technology Station – (323 spaces) 3929 156th Avenue NE Redmond, WA 98052. Take the link (South) toward South Bellevue. Debark at Downtown station (5th Stop)

To board, purchase your ticket at a kiosk (or tap your Orca card). Select platform for your direction.

If you prefer to not to take light rail, you can park at Bellevue Botanical Gardens 12001 Main St, Bellevue, WA 98005 47.60950952728702, -122.17802869514082. For 10k start with direction #33 for 6k Start with direction #10. 10K can also start at Hidden Valley Field House 1903 112th Ave NE, Bellevue, WA 98004 47°37'39.5"N 122°11'32.3"W and start with direction #16.

Special Programs: AVA – A-Z (B) City Hall, Par for the Course, Rail to Trail, Step to the Beat ESVA: King County, Rail to Trail, That’s Entertainment

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participants Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the users Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a users Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days

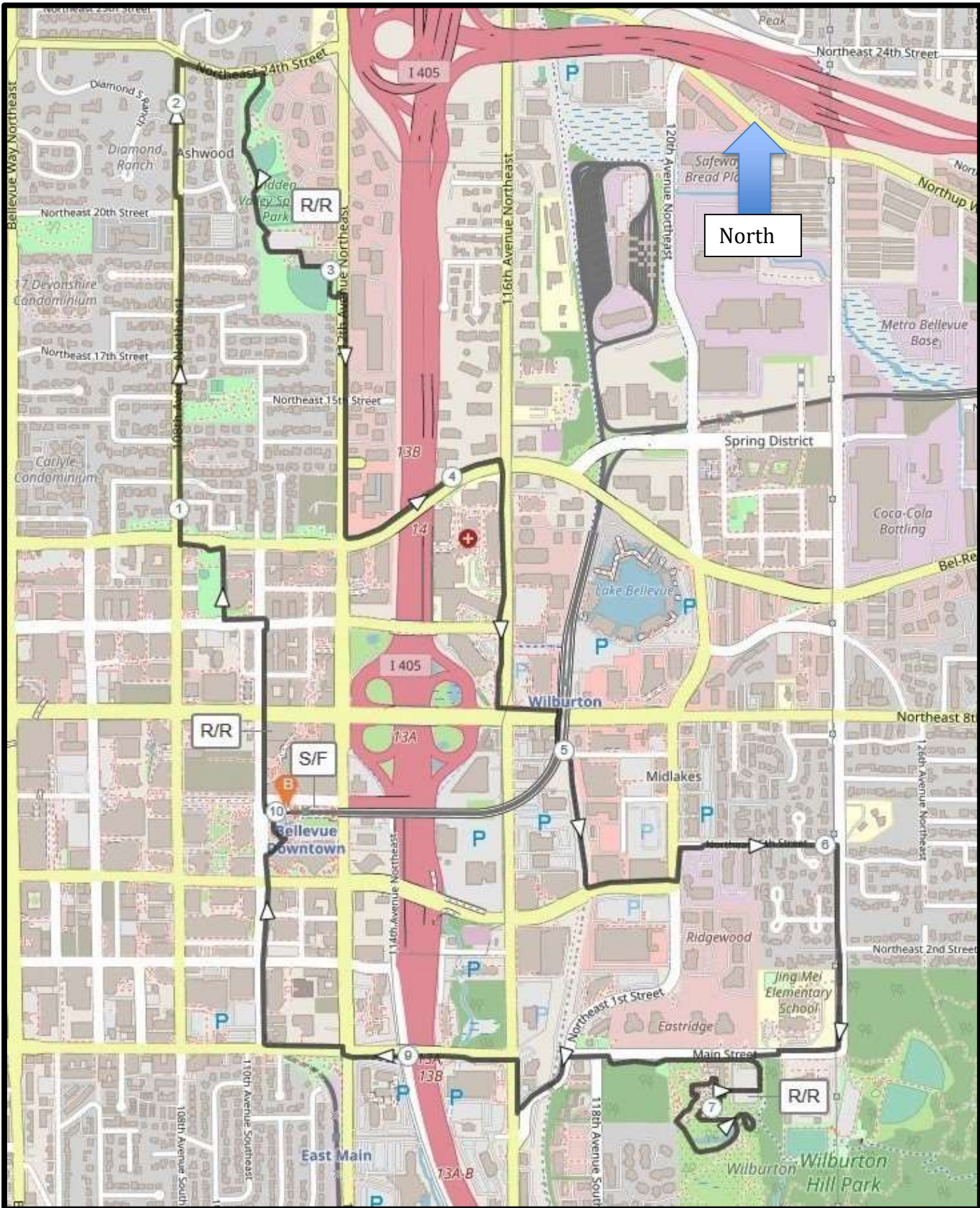
Restrooms: Bellevue City Hall, Marriott, Bellevue Library, in Parks.

- 1) Disembark at Bellevue Downtown Light Rail Station. Take stairs or elevator up to street (110th Ave. NE.)
- 2) **RIGHT** on 110th and **CROSS** NE 6th St. Continue on 110th for two blocks, to NE 10th St. (*restrooms at Marriott at NE 8th St. – beyond the café, on left*).
- 3) **CROSS** 10th, then **LEFT** to **CROSS** 110th.
- 4) **STRAIGHT** on 10th, passing Bellevue Library.
- 5) **RIGHT** on sidewalk between the library and the park. Continue to next street (NE 12th St.)
- 6) **LEFT** on 12th. Walk to traffic light at 108th Ave. NE.
- 7) **RIGHT** to **CROSS** 12th, and continue **STRAIGHT** on 108th, several blocks. (*restrooms at park on right*)
- 8) Just before NE 20th St., (watch for church on right), turn **LEFT** at the marked crosswalk.
- 9) Turn **RIGHT** to walk single-file in the road shoulder (left side of 108th). Walk to the end at NE 24th St.
- 10) At 24th, **RIGHT** to **CROSS** 108th. Continue on 24th to a park on right (wood split-rail fence on right).
- 11) **RIGHT** into the park. Walk on asphalt path, passing tennis courts on left, restroom building on right.
- 12) **VEER LEFT** at play field with tall chain-link fence. Follow asphalt path, keeping field on left, to parking.
- 13) **RIGHT**, then **LEFT** to walk around the end of the lot, walking to the building ahead.
- 14) At building, turn **RIGHT**, keeping building on left.
- 15) Then jog **LEFT** and **RIGHT**, keeping field on right.
- 16) **LEFT** on the sidewalk to the street (112th Ave. NE)
- 17) **CROSS** 112th using the flashing crosswalk signal. (3K)
- 18) **RIGHT** on 112th. Continue to NE 12th St.
- 19) **LEFT** on 12th. Continue as it crosses over I-405.
- 20) At 116th Ave. NE, **RIGHT** to **CROSS** 12th at the light.
- 21) Continue on 116th to next traffic light at NE 8th St.
- 22) **LEFT** to **CROSS** 116th. Continue **STRAIGHT** on 8th.
- 23) At Wilburton Light Rail Station, go under the pedestrian overpass, and turn **LEFT** to walk to the end of the Station (passing last red building on left). Then **LEFT** to intercept Eastlink Trail (mural ahead).
- 24) **LEFT** to go up ramp onto the pedestrian overpass.
- 25) After the overpass, continue **STRAIGHT** on concrete sidewalk, then gravel path, to next street (NE 4th St.)
- 26) **LEFT** on 4th. Walk one block to 120th Ave. NE.
- 27) **CROSS** then **LEFT** on 120th. Continue to NE 5th St.
- 28) **RIGHT** on 5th. Continue to the end at 124th Ave. NE.
- 29) **RIGHT** on 124th. Continue to the end at Main St.
- 30) **RIGHT** on Main St. After the driveway for school on your right, **LEFT** to **CROSS** Main at crosswalk. (7K)
- 31) **RIGHT**, continuing uphill to Bellevue Botanical Gardens on your left. (Note: no dogs in garden – continue **STRAIGHT** on Main, and skip to number 36).
- 32) **LEFT** at building. Walk to the end, at garden entry.
- 33) **RIGHT** into garden. Meander and linger as you wish, then return to this garden entry. For our suggested route, see next page for garden map and directions.
- 34) Exit garden, then **LEFT** to return to street (Main).
- 35) **LEFT** to follow trail, then sidewalk, alongside Main.
- 36) At NE 1st St., **RIGHT** to **CROSS** Main with the light, then **LEFT** to **CROSS** 1st St. with the light.
- 37) **LEFT** on 1st, walking downhill on right side.
- 38) At Windermere driveway, **RIGHT** toward stairs down.
- 39) Take stairs down to street (116th Ave. SE). Make a **RIGHT U-TURN**. Walk to next traffic light (Main St.).
- 40) At Main, **LEFT** to **CROSS** 116th. Walk to 112th Ave. NE.
- 41) At 112th, **CROSS** 112th then **RIGHT** to **CROSS** Main.
- 42) **LEFT** on Main, to walk uphill on right side of Main.
- 43) **RIGHT** on 110th Ave. NE. Continue to NE 6th St.
- 44) **RIGHT**, up the steps to enjoy the art at the plaza outside City Hall and the Station.
- 45) Return to Bellevue Downtown Light Rail Station.
- 46) To board, purchase your ticket at a kiosk (or tap your Orca card). Select platform for your direction (North = Redmond Tech. South = South Bellevue)

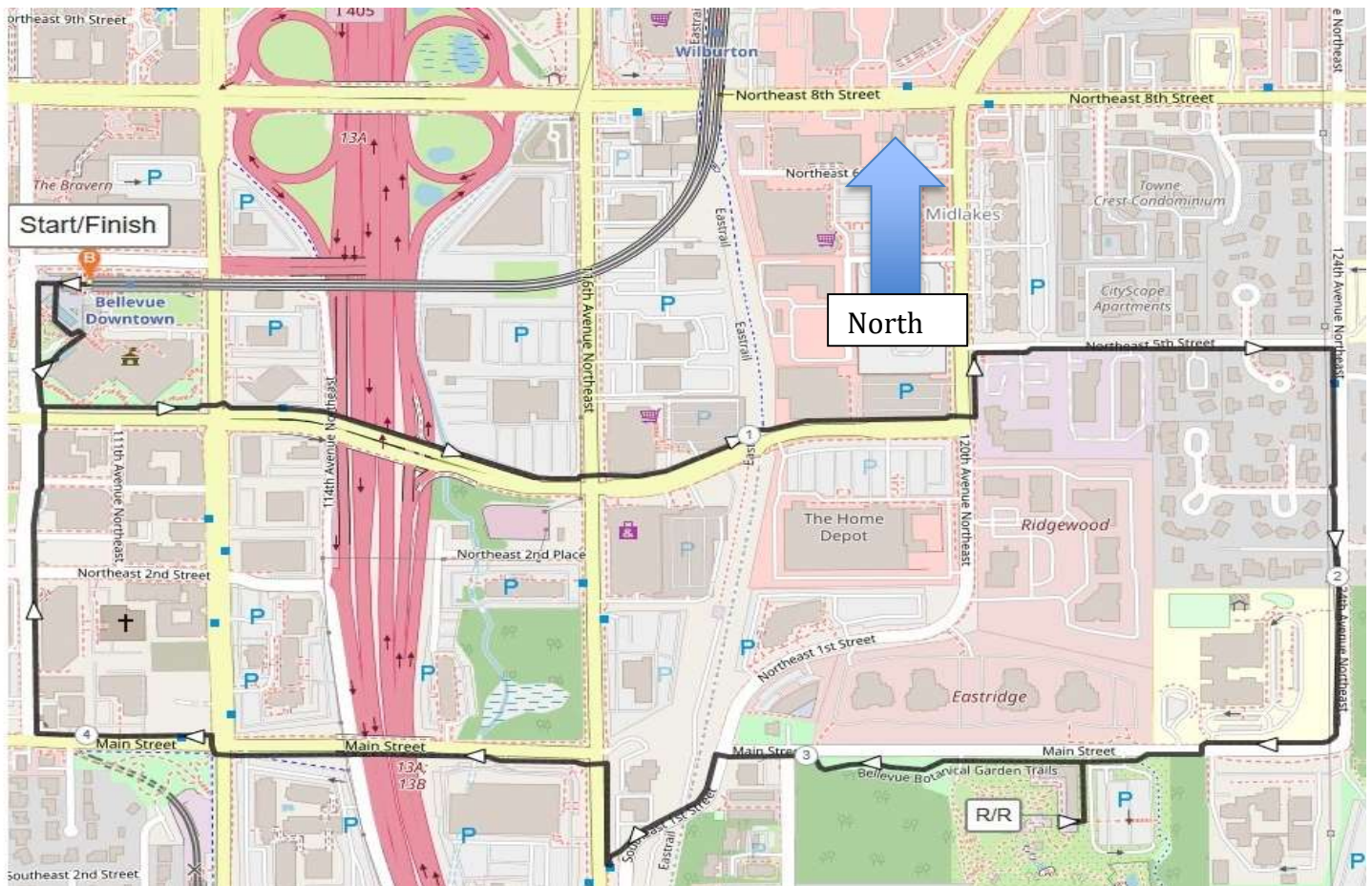
Start: Bellevue Downtown Light Rail Station

Restrooms: Bellevue City Hall, Marriott, Parks.

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- 1) Disembark at Bellevue Downtown Light Rail Station. Take stairs or elevator up to street (110th Ave. NE). (For restroom before your walk, **RIGHT** at 110th. Walk two blocks to NE 8th St. Restrooms at Marriott – beyond the café, on left. Then return to 110th and begin your walk, per direction below.)
- 2) **LEFT** on 110th to NE 4th St.
- 3) **LEFT** on 4th. Continue as it crosses over I-405, then several blocks to 120th Ave. NE.
- 4) **CROSS** then **LEFT** on 120th. Continue to NE 5th St.
- 5) **RIGHT** on 5th. Continue to the end, at 124th Ave. NE.
- 6) **RIGHT** on 124th. Continue to the end, Main St.
- 7) **RIGHT** on Main St. After the driveway for school on your right, **LEFT** to **CROSS** Main at crosswalk.
- 8) **RIGHT**, continuing uphill to Bellevue Botanical Gardens on your left. (Note: no dogs in garden – continue **STRAIGHT** on Main, and skip to # 13).
- 9) **LEFT** at building. Walk to the end, at garden entry.
- 10) **RIGHT** into garden. Meander and linger as you wish, then return to this garden entry. For our suggested route, see next page for garden map and directions. (3K)
- 11) Exit garden, then **LEFT** to return to Main St.
- 12) **LEFT** to follow trail, then sidewalk, alongside Main St.
- 13) At NE 1st St., **RIGHT** to **CROSS** Main with the light, then **LEFT** to **CROSS** 1st St. with the light.
- 14) **LEFT** on 1st, walking downhill on right side.
- 15) At Windermere driveway, **RIGHT** toward stairs down.
- 16) Take stairs down to street (116th Ave. SE). Make a **RIGHT U-TURN**. Walk to next traffic light (Main St.).
- 17) At Main, **LEFT** to **CROSS** 116th. Walk to 112th Ave. NE.
- 18) At 112th, **CROSS** 112th then **RIGHT** to **CROSS** Main.
- 19) **LEFT** on Main, to walk uphill on right side of Main.
- 20) **RIGHT** on 110th Ave. NE. Continue to NE 6th St.
- 21) **RIGHT**, up the steps to enjoy the art at the plaza outside City Hall and the Station.
- 22) Return to Bellevue Downtown Light Rail Station.
- 23) To board, purchase your ticket at a kiosk (or tap your Orca card). Select platform for your direction (North = Redmond Tech. South = South Bellevue)

Welcome!

The Garden is 53 acres of cultivated gardens, restored woodlands, and natural wetlands.

The Garden is open dawn until dusk, every day of the year. Admission is free.

The Trillium Store and Copper Kettle Coffee have seasonal hours. For current hours, go to bellevuebotanical.org.

Only service animals are allowed in the Garden.

Leave all flowers, plants, fruits, and seeds for everyone to enjoy.

Please stay on paths and lawns. Do not walk in plant beds or climb on rocks.

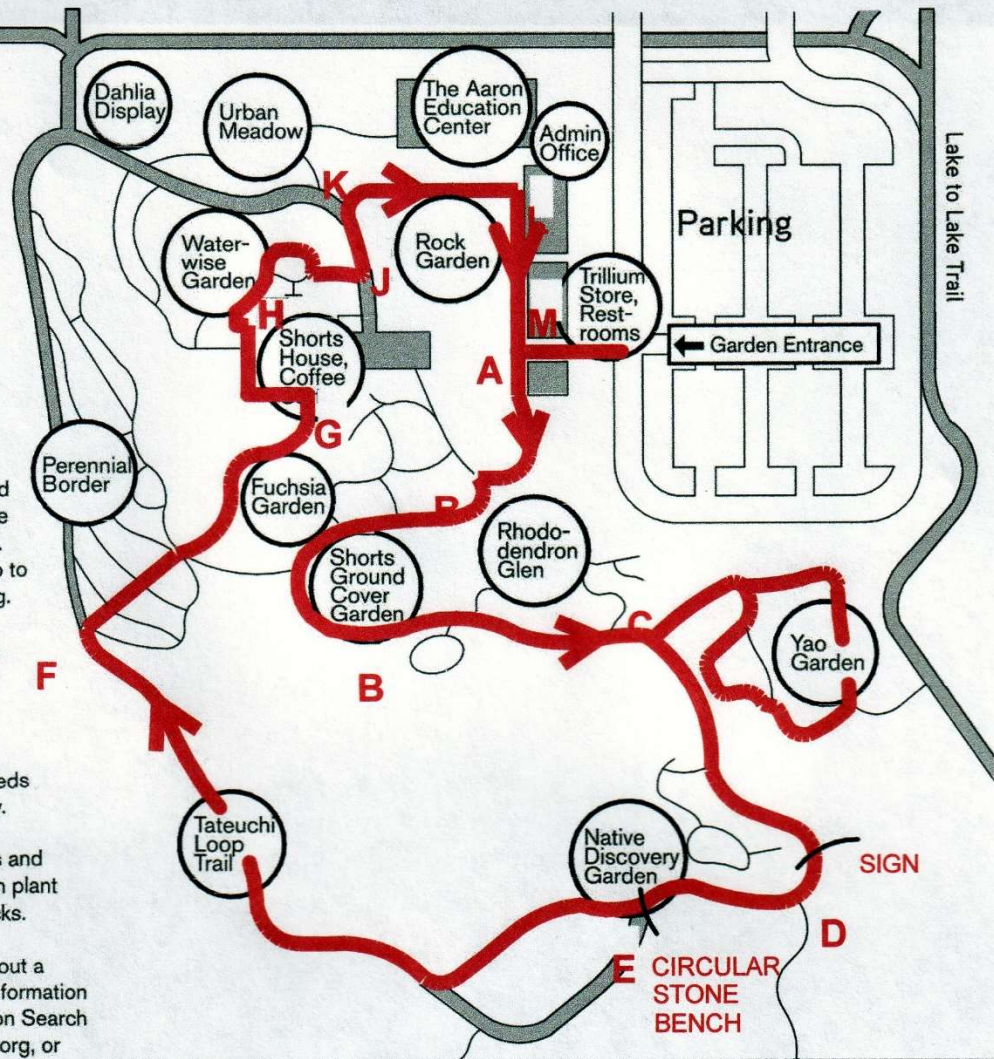
If you are curious about a plant, you can find information in our Plant Collection Search at bellevuebotanical.org, or scan codes on "What's that Plant?" signs in the Garden.

- A.** At water feature (ahead) turn **LEFT**.
- B.** At first available left, turn **LEFT** onto gravel path. Go over bridge. Stay on wide gravel path as it turns a few **LEFTS**, passes a waterfall on left, and goes downhill to Yao Japanese Garden.
- C.** **LEFT** to enter garden through gateway. Follow path clockwise all around pond. Exit garden, then **LEFT** on main path.
- D.** Immediately after sign (on right) for Native Display Garden, follow the **RIGHT** fork, for slight uphill. Stay on wide gravel path.
- E.** At next fork (circular stone bench on rt). **RIGHT** fork. Continue to concrete steps.
- F.** **RIGHT** up steps and follow gravel path to building ahead.
- G.** **LEFT** at building, then **LEFT** and **RIGHT** to walk thru patio.
- H.** Pass under trellis, **STRAIGHT** into Waterwise Garden (sign). Walk either way around tree, to main gravel path.
- J.** **LEFT** on main gravel path downhill.
- K.** **RIGHT** at next fork of main path, to walk toward building.
- L.** **RIGHT** to follow sidewalk, passing restrooms and gift shop.
- M.** **LEFT** at garden entry/exit. Resume walk direction #34 (10K), or #11 (6K).
