AVA Sanctioned Year Round Event

This walk is composed of 6km and 10km routes. Routes are rated 1A and are along city streets and trails. A lovely walk that walks on the levee of the West Fork of the Trinity River. It passes a hidden treasure, a waterfall, along the way to Airfield Falls trailhead and Conservation Park which was part of Carswell AFB. Carswell AFB closed by 1994 and now is known as Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base of Fort Worth. It now houses Air Force Reserve, Navy Reserve, Marine Corps Reserve and Air National Guard Flying units.

Walk Registration:

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, login to your Online Start Box account. Click on the "My Start Box" tab. then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start Point:

Melva Campbell Park 3121 Burton Hill Rd. Westworth Village, TX

I-30 take exit 9B Horne St./Camp Bowie Blvd. **E bound LEFT** on Horne. **W bound RIGHT** on Horne St. (Horne changes name to Roaring Springs Rd). **RIGHT** on Fursman Ave. **LEFT** on Burton Hill Rd. **RIGHT** at 311 (towards Police Dept) and park in the back by the park.

Notes:

Restrooms are located at the Police Dept. Port a potty at the Airfield Falls Trailhead.

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WESTWORTH VILLAGE / AIRFIELD FALLS – FORT WORTH

Start Point: Melva Campbell Park, 311 Burton Hill Road, Westworth Village, TX.

1. Leaving the Pavilion, walk past the Municipal Complex to Burton Hill Road.
2. Turn **RIGHT** on Burton Hill to White Settlement Road.
3. **RIGHT** on White Settlement to just before the bridge over the Trinity River.
4. **CAREFULLY CROSS** White Settlement Rd. to the left to the gate in front of the gravel trail.
5. Proceed past the gate and continue almost to River Oaks.
6. **TURN SHARPLY** down to the lower trail, then turn left on the lower trail and continue under Westworth Blvd.
7. After about 1 km, cross the bridge over the water.
8. After about another ½ km, cross the next bridge.
9. Continue to the Airfield Falls Trailhead & Conservation Park. (If you go past the US Navy sculpture, there is a porta potty on the right just before the parking lot)
10. Turn around and return on the lower trail ~2 ½ km to White Settlement Road.
11. Pass under the road and take the paved sidewalk to the right.
12. Continue, staying to the right, to the ponds.
13. Follow the trail between the ponds and continue to the **FINISH**.
14. **10 km**: turn around and return on the lower trail to just before River Oaks Blvd. (the deer mural WF2895).
15. Take the left ramp down to the low water crossing.
16. **CROSS** the river and take the ramp up to the trailhead sign.
17. Turn **RIGHT** for ~2 ½ km to the ramp that goes down to the river crossing.
18. **CROSS** the river to your right and then turn **RIGHT**.
19. Stay on the upper trail and continue to the water station/bench/ trash can.
20. Continue past the station on the upper trail to concrete embedded mile “6” marker.
21. Just past the mile marker, turn left and downhill to the trailhead at Oak Forest Drive.
22. Continue on Oak Forest ½ block to Dennis Avenue.
23. **RIGHT** on Dennis for 1 block to Ansley Drive.
24. **RIGHT** on Ansley around the school to Burton Hill Road.
25. **RIGHT** on Burton Hill to the Westworth Village Municipal Complex.
26. Turn **RIGHT**, passing the Complex and back to the **FINISH**.
