IMPORTANT EVENT INFORMATION: Restrooms: Yes, Vault toilets are available at the starting point of both trails and halfway through the Lake Trail but not on the Woods Trail. Pets: Yes, but they must be always kept on a leash and clean up after your pet. Strollers: Easy on the paved Lake Trail but Hard on the woods trail, Wheelchairs: Easy on the paved Lake Trail but hard on the Woods Trail. Free parking and restrooms at the starting point and along the lake route.

There are two 5 Km loops, the Lake trail is a paved shared bike trail, and the Woods Trail is mostly a natural trail of grass and dirt with some hills.

START POINT and DIRECTIONS:

Cleary Lake Regional Park

Prior Lake MN. 55372

Take Interstate Highway 35 E or W south to Interstate Highway 35. In Lakeville exit onto 185th St. East/County Rd 21, Prior Lake exit. Turn Right onto 185th St. E. Turn left onto Texas Ave. Turn right onto Park Rd, into Cleary Lake Regional Park

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when they submit the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note however that the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days. Also note that an event registration expires after 30 days, but if your registrations lapses, you may re-register without cost.



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PAVED LAKE TRAIL

1. Start at the end of the road in the Lakeview Reservation Area, there is a vault toilet available here.
2. LEFT: The trail is on the back side of the parking lot, with your back to the lake go to the paved trail and turn Left, keeping the lake on your left and the golf course on your right.
3. LEFT: At the first Y keep left.
4. LEFT: At the second Y keep left. The trail to the right is the Big Woods Regional Trail that goes to Prior Lake.
5. STRAIGHT: At the + continue straight on the main trail. There is a vault toilet available here.
6. STRAIGHT: there will be three different dirt trails exiting from or crossing the paved trail, stay on the paved trail.
7. LEFT: cross the road going towards the golf club house/park office and then turn left following the paved trail back to the start point.

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1. Start at the end of the road in the Lakeview Reservation Area. There is a vault toilet available here.
2. RIGHT, from the back of the parking lot facing away from the lake and towards the golf course, walk to the paved trail and turn right.
3. STRAIGHT, cross the park road and go straight following the paved trail.
4. LEFT, just before the bridge at the intersection, turn left onto the Poplar Creek Trail.
5. STRAIGHT, cross the paved trail and continue onto the Poplar Creek Trail.
6. RIGHT, at light pole #83 there is an unmarked trail on the left, keep right.
7. LEFT, at intersection #3 turn left onto the Lakeside Trail.
8. STRAIGHT, after going through a cleared area cross the dirt service road and go straight to the trail that will then curve left at intersection #4.
RIGHT, go through a cleared area following the service road, keep right and go through the gate.
9. LEFT, at intersection #5 turn left to follow the Iron Wood Trail, there will be a picnic table here on the right.
10. RIGHT, at the Y, keep right, the left trail is a closed service road.
11. RIGHT, at intersection #6 keep right.
12. RIGHT, at intersection #7 keep right to and stay on the Ironwood Trail.
13. STRAIGHT, at intersection #8 go straight and continue onto the Lake Side Trail.
14. RIGHT, at intersection #9 turn right and follow the paved trail.
15. RIGHT, at the T, turn right and cross the park road.
16. LEFT, after crossing Park Road turn left and head back to the starting point.
