

# The Olympic Peninsula Explorers Volkssport Club Welcomes You to the 'Hansville Point No Point Lighthouse' walks

The walks are 5k (1A) or 11K (2B).

The walks take you along the beautiful tip of the Kitsap Peninsula's shoreline and into the lovely Greenway with its logging history. Walk on rural roads and forest trails to enjoy the sun and shade.

Pets: Yes, Restroom: Yes, Pass Required: No.

Pets are permitted; owners are responsible for leash and clean-up laws

Walks start at Norwegian Point Park (39118 Hansville Rd NE, Hansville, WA 98340) and the route takes you to Point No Point lighthouse and also through the nearby Hansville Greenway. There will be traffic on the portion of the rural roads in this walk, so walk carefully as the roads do not have pedestrian shoulders.

## **Walk Registration:**

Registration takes place online using the AVA Online Start Box, on <http://my.ava.org>. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

## HANSVILLE POINT NO POINT LIGHTHOUSE (YRE 3624) 11km Rated 2B

**ESVA Challenges:** 39 Counties – Kitsap, On the Road Again, That’s Entertainment (Culture, Museum)

**AVA Challenges:** Lighthouses,

1. Leaving the parking lot, **LEFT** and stay on the left side of Hansville Road until you come to the first intersection.
2. **LEFT** on Point No Point Road and follow it all the way to the lighthouse area.
3. As you approach the lighthouse, note the big rock on your left. It is the Point No Point Treaty monument. Go all the way to the Lighthouse, which is on the National Register.
4. **REVERSE** your course and walk back on Point No Point Road to Hansville Road.
5. Carefully **CROSS** Hansville Road and proceed straight along the road, which is now Buck Lake Road.  
**PLEASE WALK CAREFULLY, SINGLE FILE ALONG THE LEFT SIDE OF THE ROAD FACING TRAFFIC.**
6. Follow the road uphill, turning **LEFT**, then **RIGHT**, and then **LEFT** until you come to **Buck Lake County Park** on your right.
7. **RIGHT** and **CROSS** Buck Lake Road and enter the park.
8. **CROSS** the parking lot and walk toward the brick restrooms on a crushed gravel trail (open in the summer only).
9. Immediately past the picnic pavilion on your left, **LEFT** and walk on the grass between the pavilion and a playground to a rail fence ahead.
10. Walk to the right of the rail fence, joining a trail with gardens on the right. Continue on trail.
11. **RIGHT** onto the Greenway Trails at the kiosk and go downhill to the **Marker Post 0**.
12. **RIGHT** on the Walking Trail.
13. The trail opens into a clearing and a **Greenway Trails** sign (**Marker Post 1**).
14. **RIGHT** and follow the trail to Buck Lake, enjoy the view.
15. **TURN AROUND** and retrace your steps.
16. Walk straight past **Marker Post 1**.
17. At **Marker Post 2** (hard to read), go straight ahead (slight veer left).
18. **LEFT** at **Marker Post 4**.
19. At **Marker Post 5** and **6** continue straight to **Marker Post 9**.
20. **RIGHT** at **Marker Post 9** (only choice).
21. At **Marker Post 10**, (on your right) keep **LEFT**.
22. Continue to the very end of the trail at Lower Hawk’s Pond, passing straight by **Marker Post 13**. There is a bench and neat observation deck at the turn-around.
23. Reverse your course, pass **Marker Post 13**, and return to **Marker Post 10**.
24. **LEFT** at **Marker Post 10**.
25. **RIGHT** at **Marker Post 7**.
26. **LEFT** at **Marker Post 6**.
27. Go straight past **Marker Posts 5 & 4**
28. **LEFT** at **Marker Post 3**.
29. **RIGHT** at **Marker Post 40**.
30. Continue straight ahead to pass **Marker Post 12**, **Marker Post 8** and past the Greenway Trails sign.
31. You will come out on an unpaved road. Continue downhill, curving left, until the road joins a paved road (unmarked).
32. **RIGHT** continuing downhill until the road turns left. You will see six posts with reflectors in front of you.
33. Go through the posts and take the trail through the woods.
34. At Twin Spits Road (unmarked), **RIGHT** and walk along the trail parallel to the road.
35. **LEFT** at the **CROSSWALK** and **RIGHT** on the other side of the road. Return to the Norwegian Point Park.

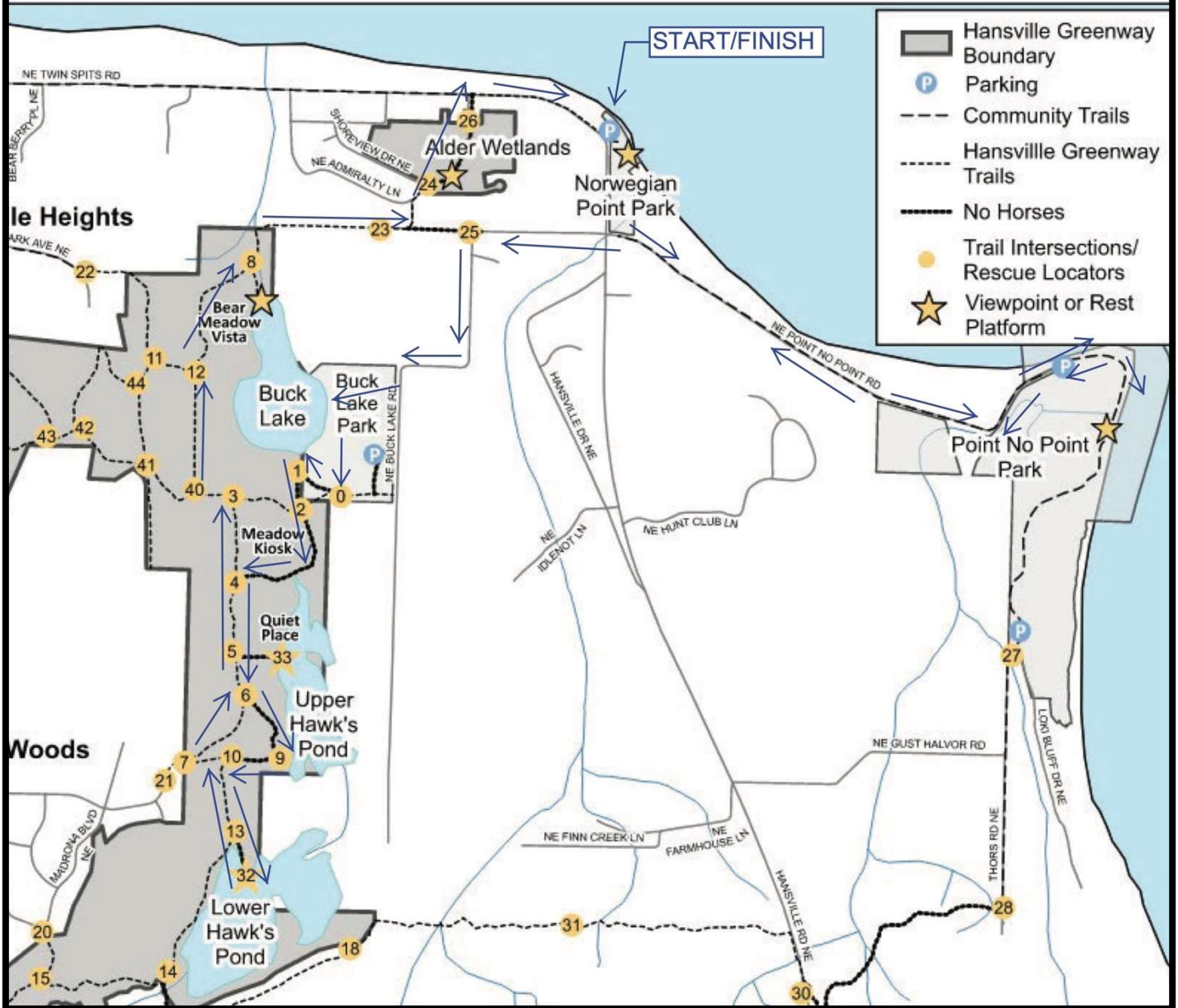

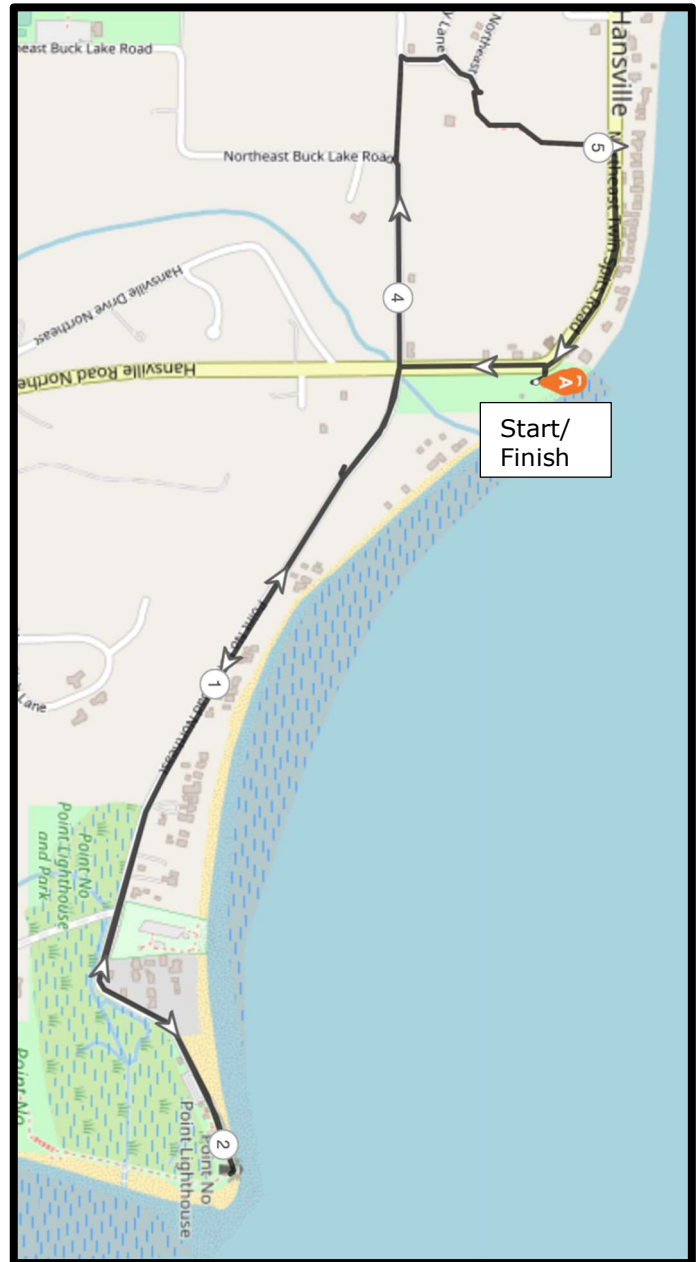
**AVA Challenges:** Lighthouses

1. Leaving the parking lot, **LEFT** and stay on the left side of Hansville Road until you come to the first intersection.
2. **LEFT** on Point No Point Road and follow it all the way to the lighthouse area.
3. As you approach the lighthouse, note the big rock on your left. It is the Point No Point Treaty monument. Go all the way to the Lighthouse, which is on the National Register.
4. **REVERSE** your course and walk back on Point No Point Road to Hansville Road.
5. Carefully **CROSS** Hansville Road and proceed straight along the road, which is now Buck Lake Road.

**PLEASE WALK CAREFULLY, SINGLE FILE ALONG THE LEFT SIDE OF THE ROAD FACING TRAFFIC.**

6. As you walk up a gradual hill, you will see that the road makes a sharp turn to the left.
7. Before the turn, carefully **CROSS** the road and walk on the right shoulder.
8. You will see a Hansville Greenway sign. Walk by the sign (on your left) and follow the unpaved road/trail uphill.
9. **RIGHT**, downhill at Greenway Trails sign. Follow the unpaved road downhill to a paved road (unmarked).
10. **RIGHT** continuing downhill until the road turns left.
11. You will see 6 posts with reflectors in front of you. Go through the posts and take the trail through the woods. (Alder Wetlands)
12. At Twin Spits Road (unmarked), **RIGHT** to walk along the trail parallel to the road.
13. **LEFT** at the crosswalk and **RIGHT** on the other side of the road.
14. **RETURN** to the Norwegian Point Park.
