Driving Directions from I-11/US95 North or South:

- A. Take exit 68, Tropicana Ave, and **Go East** about 3 miles.
- B. **Turn Left** on Wetlands Park Lane and continue straight through Park Gate to the parking lot in front of Nature Center.

Trails open dawn-dusk daily. Nature Center open 9am – 3pm TUE-SUN. *Restrooms are available behind the Nature Center and throughout the park. This walk is on paved sidewalks and dirt paths. Walk during daylight hours only.*

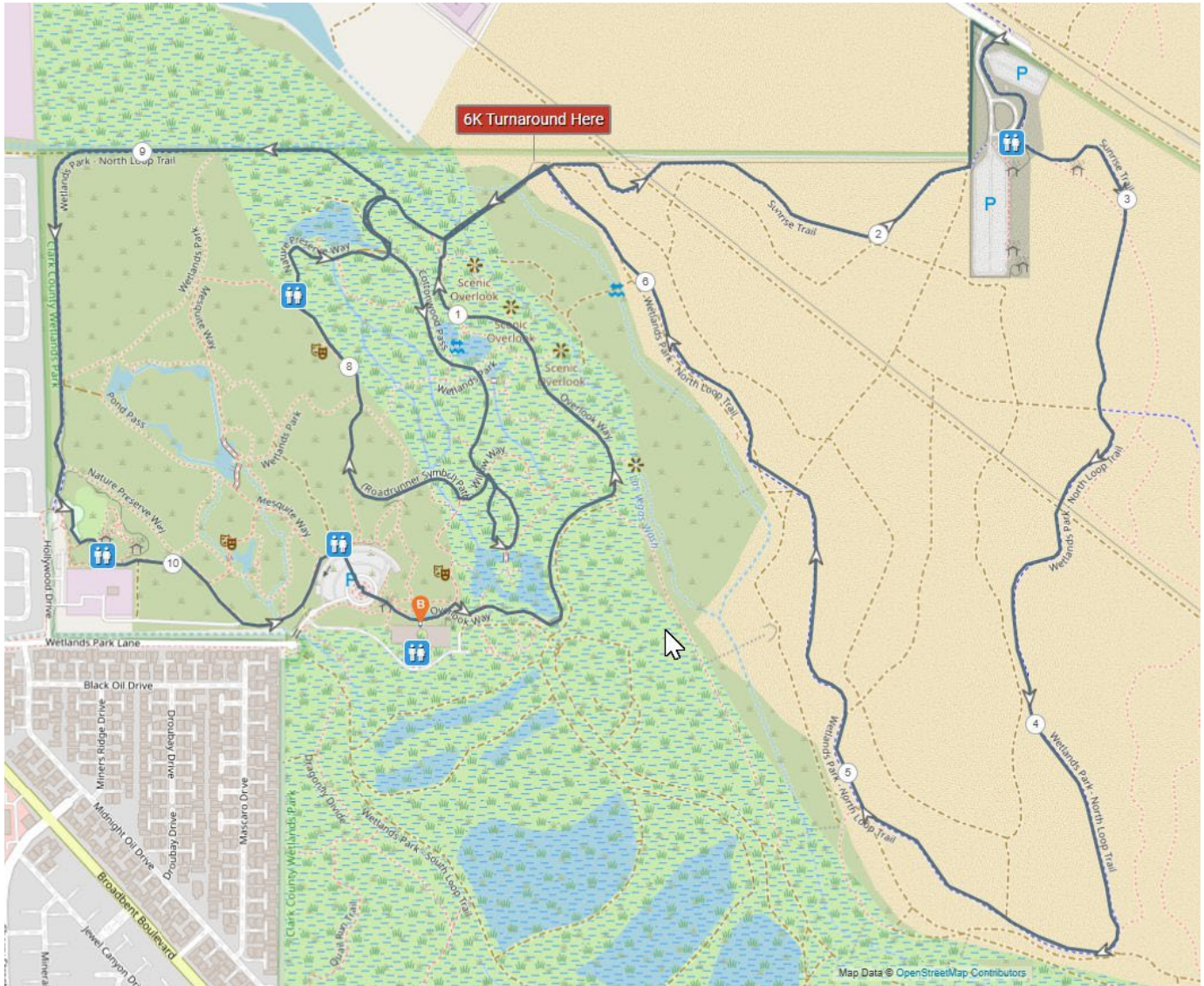
1. From the Wetlands Parking Lot, walk up the sidewalk to the Nature Center/Visitor Information.
2. Exit the Nature Center and **veer right** down the railed walkway.
3. **Turn right** on Overlook Way.
4. After a short distance, **turn left** down some rough steps to *Vern's Pond*. (*Informative kiosk and plaque*)
5. Return to the sidewalk and **turn left**.
6. **Cross** the small bridge and follow signs to *Wash Overlook* and *Big Weir Bridge*.
7. **Veer right** to walk over the *Big Weir Bridge* to the 3 cement benches on the left.

6KM Walkers: Turn around and recross bridge. Continue with **Step 17**.

8. **11KM Walkers:** Continue straight on the Sunrise Trail paved path.
9. After the paved path ends, **turn left** through or around the yellow gate on the dirt road. (*Concrete barricades on your left and wired wooden posts on the right*)
10. At the end of the dirt road, walk through or around the yellow gate and **turn right** on the paved road.
11. In a short distance, **turn right** again on a paved path.

12. Pass the 1st gazebo and continue on paved path. (*Pass restrooms on your right.*)
13. Walk past 2nd gazebo. (*You are on the Wetlands Loop Trail. It will change from concrete path to paved path.*)
14. At the next intersection, **continue straight** on the paved path. (*Ignore all lefts and rights.*) *Eventually, you will be veering right to walk closer to the Las Vegas Wash. You will see Sam Boyd Stadium in the distance.*
15. **Continue** on the *Wetlands Loop Trail* to return to the 3 cement benches.
16. **Turn left** on the trail to cross back over the *Big Weir Bridge*.
17. After crossing bridge, **veer right** to continue on the main sidewalk.
18. **Veer left** on *Nature Preserve Way*.
19. Walk to next left - *Cottonwood Pass* (dirt trail) and **turn left**. *Ignore all lefts and rights.*
20. Cross over a sidewalk and in a short distance **veer right** to make a complete loop of an area of newly planted trees. (**DO NOT** cross over bridge)
21. Finish the loop and walk back to the sidewalk (*Willow Way* – no sign), and **turn left**.
22. **Veer right** on *Roadrunner Run*. *Ignore all lefts and rights.*
23. Roadrunner Run ends at a 3-way “T” intersection.
24. **Continue straight** on *Nature Preserve Way*.
25. At the restroom, **continue straight** on *Nature Preserve Way*. *Ignore all lefts and rights.*
26. When this trail ends, **turn left** on *Wetlands Loop Trail*.
27. Continue on this outer trail and just before a small parking lot, **turn left** to meander through the children’s park with animal silhouettes in the sidewalk.
28. At the exit of the children’s park, **turn left** and continue on trail. (*Restrooms on your right and another small park on your left*).
29. After the restrooms, **bear left** and continue on the sidewalk. (wooden fence on your right)
30. At the next intersection, **turn right** on *Nature Preserve Way*. (*Ignore the left on Raccoon Run*)
31. At the “Y” intersection, **veer left**. Cross a short bridge and continue on the sidewalk back to the parking lot and Nature Center.

Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (NOTE: The \$2 fee for event PDF Download is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. This prepaid fee is applied against the credit fee(s) at the OSB "Finish Table" when you submit the walk completion info. However, the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires 60 days from download.)
