



**Sound Steppers Volkssport Club welcomes you to the
Mountlake Terrace Parks & Link Station Y3748
5K and 10K EVENT
This walk is rated 2B.**

Starting from either the Mountlake Terrace light rail station or the MT Library, walk sidewalks, quiet streets, Lakeview Trail, and wooded paths to explore lakeside Ballinger Park (converted golf course with fishing pier and views of Edmont Island), peaceful Lyon Park, the Mountlake Terrace City Hall (with sculptures), and Library.

Starting Points:

Driving: Mountlake Terrace Library, 23300 58th Ave W, Mountlake Terrace, WA 98043

Link light rail: Mountlake Terrace Link Light Rail station



Driving Directions:

From I-5 Southbound: Take Exit 179. **TURN LEFT** onto 220th St SW, **TURN RIGHT** onto 58th Ave W, **TURN RIGHT** into library parking lot in about 0.8 miles.

From I-5 Northbound: Take exit 178. **TURN RIGHT** onto 236th St SW, **TURN LEFT** on 58th Ave W, **TURN LEFT** into library parking lot in about 0.2 miles.

Restrooms: Mountlake Terrace library, Ballinger Park, Mountlake Terrace Rec Pavilion (10k)

Emergency: Dial 911

Walk completion and credit: This is an OSB-only walk. Register online for the walk. Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying-for-credit walker. Note, however, the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

23300 58th Ave W, Mountlake Terrace, WA

5k rated 2B

Restrooms at Mountlake Terrace Library and Ballinger Park.

Note: To start from the Link Station, walk to 236th St SW, TURN RIGHT, and follow directions beginning at step 3.

1. From the Mountlake Terrace Library parking lot (RESTROOMS in the library during business hours), walk to 58th Ave W, **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk.
2. Continue on 58th Ave W passing Veterans Memorial Park on the right. **TURN RIGHT** on 236th St SW.
3. Continue past the Mountlake Terrace Link station (on the right) and over the freeway.
4. At the crosswalk at the intersection with 65th Pl W, **TURN LEFT** to cross 236th St SW.
5. Immediately **TURN RIGHT** to start walking on paved Lakeview Trail (unmarked).
6. Continue on Trail to the driveway entrance to Lake Ballinger Boat and Fishing Access, **TURN LEFT** on sidewalk and walk toward the lake. RESTROOMS are in the brown building next to the upper parking lot.
7. After leaving the restrooms, return to the sidewalk and walk toward Fishing Pier.
8. Walk to end of pier for view of Edmont Island.
9. Return to the sidewalk and **TURN LEFT** at the first Trail junction.
10. Pass the Hazel Miller Universally Accessible Playground.
11. Continue on the walking path toward the parking lot.
12. Enter the parking lot through gate in cyclone fence,

TURN LEFT toward brown building.

13. **TURN RIGHT** onto the sidewalk parallel to the driveway.
14. Follow the sidewalk as it curves to the right to the stop sign.
15. **TURN RIGHT** on Lakeview Trail (unmarked).
16. Continue on paved trail to crosswalk with pedestrian walk signal. **TURN LEFT** to cross Lakeview Dr in crosswalk. (If you reach the driveway to Lake Ballinger Boat and Fishing Access, you have gone too far).
17. **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk.
18. Look for a red & white "No Trespassing" sign next to a cyclone fence. On the other side of the cyclone fence is a paved trail. **TURN LEFT** onto the trail.
19. Follow paved trail and continue straight ahead onto sidewalk along 235th St SW (unmarked).
20. Street will **TURN LEFT** at 66th Ave W. Stay on street as it curves for two blocks. At stop sign, **TURN LEFT** again onto 66th Ave W.
21. **TURN RIGHT** on 228th St SW.
22. After crossing above the I-5 freeway, the street will curve right and then change street number to 230th St SW.
23. Continue to 58th Ave W, **TURN RIGHT**.
24. Pass by Mountlake Terrace City Hall and return to the Library parking lot.

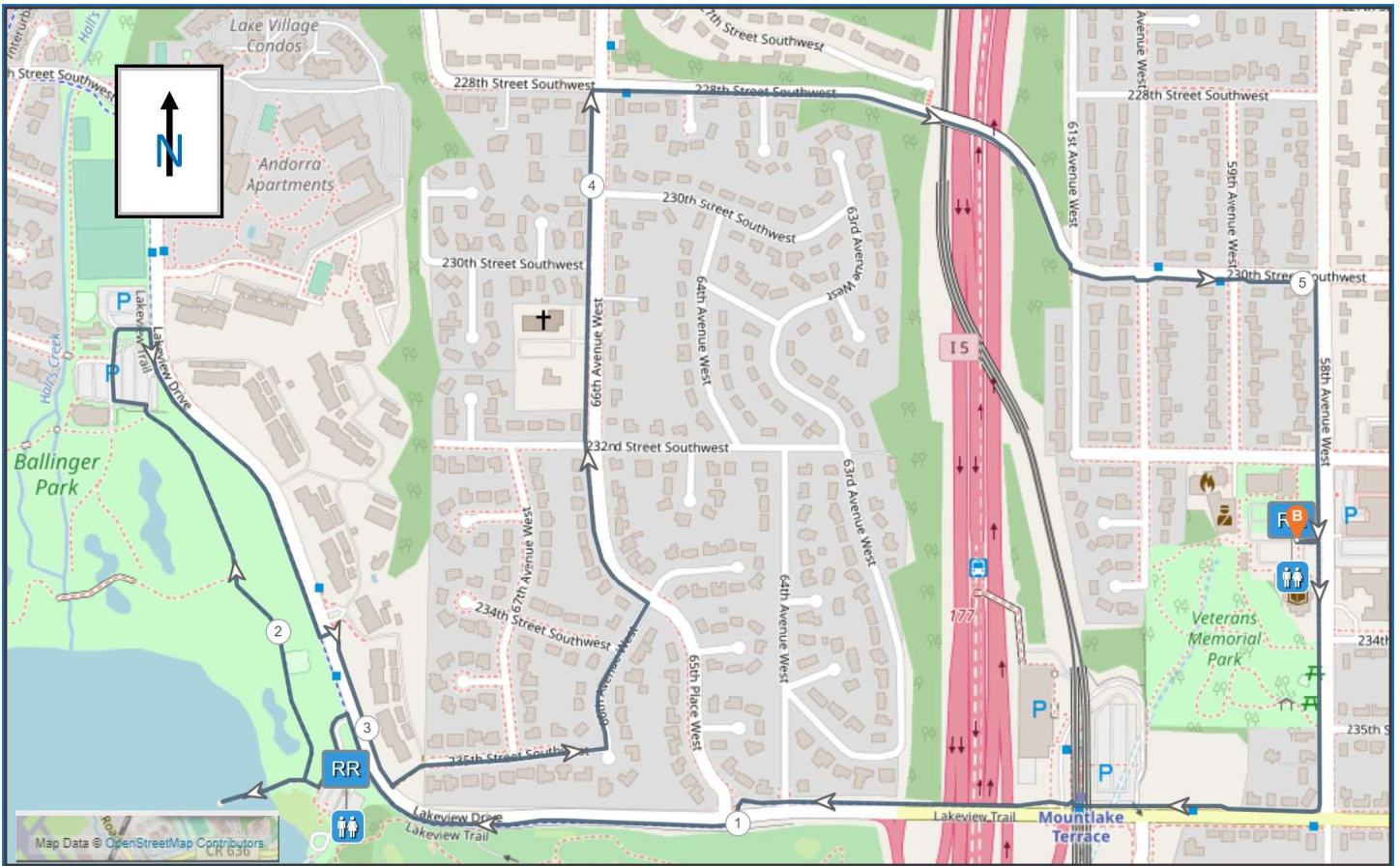

23300 58th Ave W, Mountlake Terrace, WA

10k rated 2B

Restrooms at Mountlake Terrace Library, Mountlake Terrace Rec Pavillion, and Ballinger Park

Note: To start from the Link Station, walk to 236th St SW, TURN RIGHT, and follow directions beginning at step 3.

1. From the Mountlake Terrace Library parking lot (RESTROOMS in the library during business hours), walk to 58th Ave W, **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk.

2. Continue on 58th Ave W passing Veterans Memorial Park on the right. **TURN RIGHT** on 236th St SW.

3. Continue past the Mountlake Terrace Link station (on the right) and over the freeway.

4. At the crosswalk at the intersection with 65th Pl W. **TURN LEFT** to cross 236th St SW.

5. Immediately **TURN RIGHT** to start walking on paved Lakeview Trail (unmarked).

6. Continue on Trail to the driveway entrance to Lake Ballinger Boat and Fishing Access, **TURN LEFT** on sidewalk and walk toward the lake. RESTROOMS are in the brown building next to the upper parking lot.

7. After leaving the restrooms, return to the sidewalk and walk toward Fishing Pier.

8. Walk to end of pier for view of Edmont Island.

9. Return to the sidewalk and **TURN LEFT** at the first Trail junction.

10.. Walk on paved path past the Hazel Miller Universally Accessible Playground and continue to parking lot.

11. Enter the parking lot through gate in the cyclone fence, **TURN LEFT** toward brown building.

12. **TURN RIGHT** onto the sidewalk parallel to the driveway.

13. Follow the sidewalk as it curves to the right and uphill to stop sign.

14. **TURN RIGHT** on Lakeview Trail (unmarked).

15. Continue on Trail to a crosswalk with pedestrian walk signal. **TURN LEFT** to cross Lakeview Dr in crosswalk. (If you reach the driveway to Lake Ballinger Boat and Fishing Access, you have gone too far).

16. **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk.

17. Look for a red & white "No Trespassing" sign next to a cyclone fence. On the other side of the cyclone fence is a paved trail. **TURN LEFT** onto the trail.

18. Follow paved trail and continue straight ahead onto sidewalk along 235th St SW (unmarked).

19. Street will **TURN LEFT** at 66th Ave W. Stay on street as it curves for two blocks. At stop sign, **TURN LEFT** again onto 66th Ave W.

20. **TURN RIGHT** on 228th St SW.

21. Crossing above I-5, the street will curve right and then change street number to 230th St SW.

22. Continue to 53rd Ave W, **TURN LEFT**.

23. Continue on 53rd Ave W, passing between the Mountlake Terrace Rec Pavillion and basketball courts (RESTROOMS in the Pavillion).

24. Look for the sign for Off Leash Dog Park and **TURN RIGHT** on paved trail parallel to cyclone fence.

25. Follow trail downhill as it becomes a dirt path and curves left to a metal and wood gate.

26. Walk through the gate and continue onto 52nd Ave W (unmarked).

27. **TURN RIGHT** onto 224th St SW.

28. Street will **TURN LEFT** onto 51st Ave W (unmarked).

29. Follow 51st Ave W, keeping right through several curves and ignoring streets to left.

30. One-half block before the stop sign at 48th Ave W, look for a wide paved trail on the right with sign "Dogs Must Be Leashed". **TURN RIGHT** onto trail.

31. Follow Lyon Creek trail down through valley.

32. At Tee intersection **TURN LEFT**, then use the middle trail of the three trails.

33. Continue on Lyon Creek Trail. **TURN RIGHT** at trail junction to walk around an open field.

34. Pass the Candy Cane play area to parking lot.

35. Cross parking lot to 48th Ave W, **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk.
36. After a short distance, **TURN RIGHT** at first paved path and continue into cul de sac.
37. Keep left onto 234th St SW (unmarked).
38. **TURN RIGHT** onto 56th Ave W.
39. **TURN LEFT** onto 232nd St SW.
40. Cross 58th Ave W, **TURN LEFT** and walk by Mountlake Terrace City Hall. Enjoy outdoor sculptures.

41. Return to the Library parking lot.

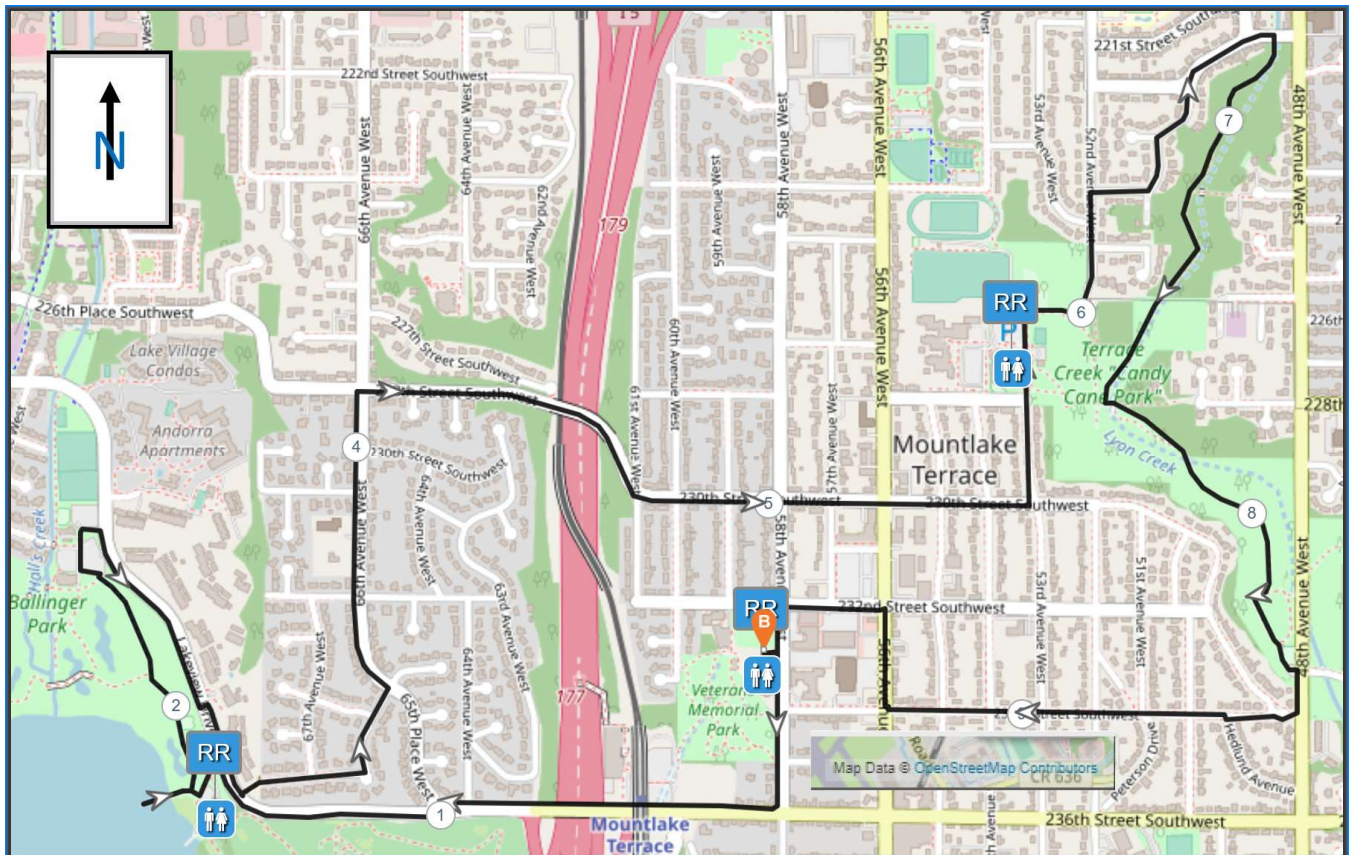
