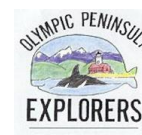

Gardiner is located on the Miller Peninsula, at the northern coast of the Olympic Peninsula on Discovery Bay, which enters the Strait of Juan de Fuca. Gardiner is primarily a rural-residential community, with mostly five- and 20-acre (81,000 m²) parcels, plus several large landholders. Gardiner also has a few retail establishments, a community center, and a church, all located on U.S. Route 101.

The Gardiner Community Center will be just off the highway. Start table will be manned only May 2 & 3 from 9:00-12:00. Event is available on OSB from April 24 to May 10.

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event. The sponsoring club only receives credit for OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.

1. Leave Gardiner Community Center towards Old Gardiner Rd.
2. **Right** on Old Gardiner Rd.
3. At US-101, stay **left** on the wide shoulder and turn immediately **left** on Old Gardiner Rd.
4. Continue **straight** on Old Gardiner Rd. for over 4.5 km to intersection with US-101.
5. **Turn around** and return to Gardiner Community Center (**10 km**).
6. Continue past Gardiner Community Center on Old Gardiner Rd. almost to intersection with US-101.
7. **Right** just before US-101 on paved bike trail (ODT).
8. Carefully cross Diamond Point Rd to trail by ODT parking area (restroom). [**13 km - turn around and return to Gardiner Community Center**]
9. Continue following signs for ODT (5.5 km). Bike route alternates between paved path and rural streets. **Follow ODT signs.**
10. Pass the Blyn S'Klallam campus (restroom at parking area above trail). Continue when trail joins road (Old Blyn Hwy) next to Sequim Bay.
11. When the ODT turns left on paved trail moving away from Sequim Bay (near end of Old Blyn Hwy), **turn around** and return to Gardiner Community Center. [**25 km**]

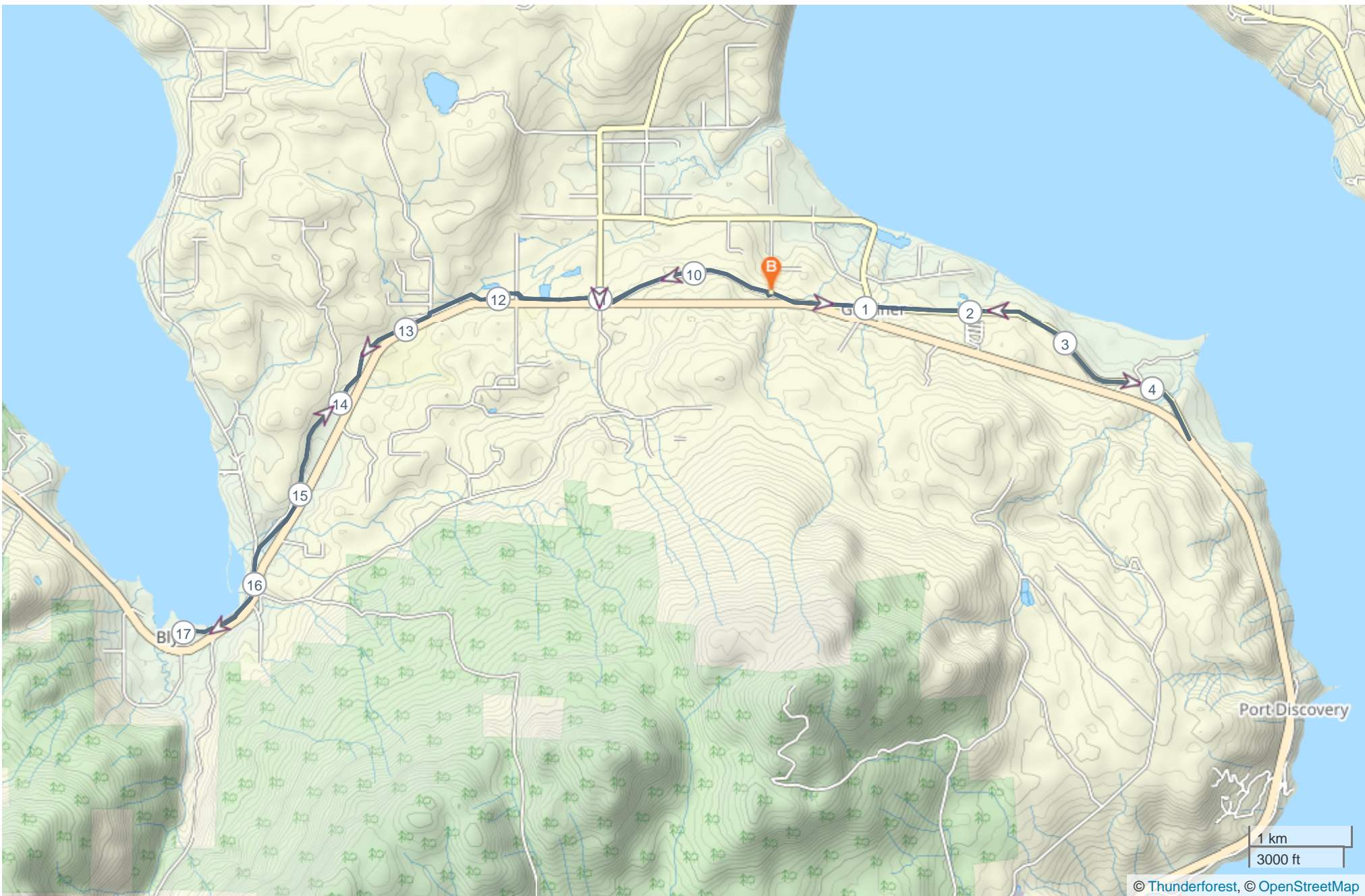
