TULIP FREDERICKSBURG — 5K & 10K Walk | Y3858 | Rated 1A

Start Point: Fredericksburg Visitor Center, 601 Caroline St., Fredericksburg, VA 22401

Restrooms: In the Visitor Center Building and at Hurkamp Park

An AVA Sanctioned Seasonal Event (Credit Only) – April 1, 2026 through May 31, 2026

This walk comprises 5 km and 10 km trails. With tulips, iris, daffodils and other beautiful blooming spring flowers, you will enjoy the outdoor beauty of Spring in Fredericksburg. Volunteers with TulipFXBG plant approximately 100,000 tulip bulbs each fall, and come Spring, they burst into bloom and bring enjoyment and happiness to residents and visitors alike. The walk start / finish point is the Fredericksburg Visitor Center (see Driving Directions below for details).

Walk Registration:

This walk has a Physical Start Box (PSB) inside the Visitor Center. If you register at the location, ask the center personnel for the walk box. Registration can also take place using the AVA Online Start Box (OSB), which is located on the website my.ava.org. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions (print if desired). The Point of Contact (POC) does not provide event directions or accept payments.

Driving Directions:

[Fredericksburg Visitor Center](#) is located at 601 Caroline St. Fredericksburg, VA 22401. They are typically open daily from 9-4, but you may wish to call ahead – (540) 373-1776.

From I-95 (either direction): Exit 130A E. Follow signs Historic Downtown Fredericksburg along Rt 3 (locally named William St.) to Princess Anne St. Right to Princess Anne St, follow to Wolfe St. Turn Left to Wolfe St., follow 1 block to Fredericksburg Visitor Center (ahead.) Free parking available in the lot at 1000 block of Sophia St., which is adjacent toward the river. There is 2-hour free parking on the street. There is a parking garage on Wolfe St. between Caroline St./Sophia St. (Currently, the first three hours are \$2, \$1/hour for each additional hour, up to a maximum charge of \$8 per day.)

Restrooms:

Restrooms are located at the start/finish point in the building housing the Visitor Center. Additional bathrooms available in Hurkamp Park.

Special Programs:

Grain Elevators; Monarchs of the Plains, Par-For-The-Course, Step to the Beat, Walking with America's Veterans, Walking With the Wild Things, and Washington-Rochambeau National Historic Trail

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Please use either the OSB or the PSB to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match. For example, do not register using the OSB and then complete your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB. Once you have completed the walk, either follow the instructions in the PSB and sign the log, stamp your books, and mail in your payment QR log in to your AVA OSB Account. If you are using the OSB, click on the "My Start Box" tab, click the "Finish Table" tab, and then click "Go to Finish Table" button for the event that you completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance for your walk, as well as selecting the applicable AVA Special Programs. This will generate the stamped virtual insert cards that you may choose to print out.

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

Continue on Caroline crossing William, Amelia, Lewis & Fauquier. 3. LEFT on Hawke St. 2 blocks (cross Princess Anne St.) 4. LEFT on Charles 2 blocks (cross Fauquier) 5. LEFT on Lewis 1 block 6. RIGHT on William 2 blocks (Cross Amelia) | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 7. RIGHT on William 2 blocks (Cross Charles) 8. RIGHT on Prince Edward (no sign - turn at Bank). Walk 3 blocks (Cross Amelia, Lewis). 9. LEFT on Fauquier 2 blocks (Cross Winchester) 10. RIGHT on Washington Ave. 3 blocks (Cross Hawke & Pitt) 11. 13. RIGHT on Prince Edward (no sign - look for large green electric box).
Walk 2 blocks -
Cross William

10K Continues:

14. Veer RIGHT on the brick sidewalk into Hurkamp Park toward the LOVE sign.

22. Continue straight on Caroline Street crossing under railroad bridge.

15. Continue past the fountain, veering right onto sidewalk on George St. walking toward the Veterans Memorial.
(Veterans Special Program)

23. Turn RIGHT on Frederick St. to Charles St.
(Purina Tower - Grain Elevators)

16. Circle Memorial, then turn back onto George St.

24. Cross Charles and turn LEFT, staying on Charles.

17. Continue on George, crossing Prince Edward.
(See Masonic Cemetery on left - Washington-Rochambeau Route).

25. Walk 2 blocks, turning RIGHT into the Downtown Greens gardens. Follow path to the left, circling around the gardens.

18. Continue on George, crossing Princess Anne.
(St. George's Church on corner - Washington-Rochambeau Route)

26. Exit gardens, turning RIGHT to stop light at Charles-Dixon intersection. At intersection, carefully cross Charles-Dixon St. Stay straight on Dixon 2 blocks (community vegetable garden and refrigerator will be on right)

19. RIGHT on Princess Anne
(715 Princess Anne on left - Town Hall/City Hall

(Downtown Greens promotes environmental care by preserving two urban garden areas, using sustainable gardening methods, teaching children through a weekly Garden Club, and raising bees with the Urban Bees program.)

20. LEFT onto Charlotte St., 1 block, then RIGHT crossing Charlotte (Our club's favorite Anita's Cafe on corner).

27. Stay on Dixon to RIGHT on Caroline St. Stay on Caroline to dead end, turn around, and walk on other side of Caroline to Frederick St.
(You will pass Sentry House historic marker)

5K-

21. Continue straight on Caroline Street to end of block, cross and finish at Visitors Center.

END 5K

28. Turn RIGHT on Frederick, walk 1 block then LEFT on Sophia St. (Par for the course)
29. Walk approximately 9 blocks to Hawke St. Turn LEFT onto Hawke.
30. Walk 1 block to Caroline St. and turn LEFT onto Caroline.
31. Walk 3 blocks turning RIGHT on Amelia St. then walking up hill 1 block.
32. At light, turn LEFT crossing Amelia, staying on Princess Anne. Walk 4 blocks.
33. LEFT onto Charlotte St., 1 block, then RIGHT crossing Charlotte (Our club's favorite Anita's Cafe on corner).
34. Continue straight on Caroline St. to end of block.
35. Turn left to cross Caroline and finish at Visitors Center.

These walk directions may be used only while walking a currently sanctioned IVV/AVA event.

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

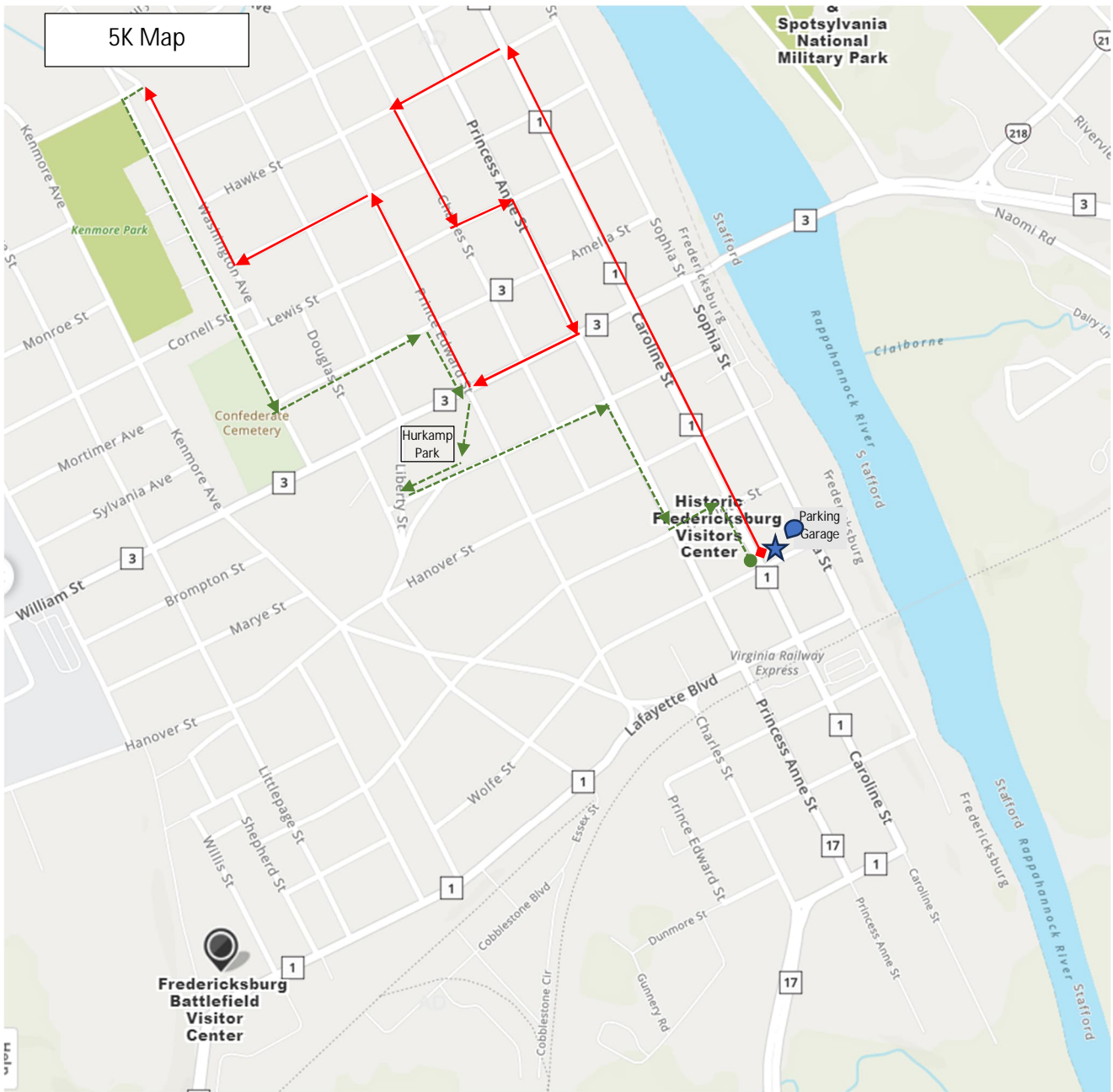
