**Start Time: 9:00 a.m. - Noon. Must finish walk by 3:00 p.m.**

**Trails:** There are 10 km and 6 km trails.  
Both the 10 km and 6 km trails go through historic Frederick and along Carroll Creek Park. The 10 km continues on tree-lined trails, over several types of bridges, through other Frederick Parks and on paths in Hood College.  
These are on sidewalks and roadsides. The trails are user friendly for wagons, wheelchairs and strollers, though some difficulty may be encountered where there are no curb cuts.

**Eligibility:** We welcome everyone to walk with us. All participants must register and sign a waiver of liability. Each participant must carry a start card throughout the walk. Please turn the card in at the end of your walk so we know that you are safely off the trail. An adult must accompany children 12 and under throughout the entire walk. Parents of minor children must sign a waiver of liability for the children.

**Refreshments:** Water and hard candy will be available at the start. Food and drink may be purchased at the "Oktoberfest."

### **DIRECTIONS TO VOLKSMARCH PARKING:**

**On I-70 West:** Take Exit 56 (East Patrick St.). Continue on East Patrick St. \*\*\*\* Turn LEFT on Franklin St.; then RIGHT into parking lot, which is across from Gate 1 of Fairground. Park and walk across E. Patrick St. to Gate 1 of Fairground. Look straight ahead for our Volksmarch START table. Parking is free, but you may make a donation to the Rotary Interact Club volunteers from local high schools !

**On I-70 East:** Take Exit 56 (East Patrick St.). Turn RIGHT at end of exit onto Rt. # 144. This will merge with East Patrick St. Continue on East Patrick St. Follow from \*\*\*\* above.
